Stitch 'n' Turn with Appliqué Instructions


Use for stitch 'n' turn designs 12445-01 through 12445-05

- 1. Hoop a single layer of Mesh Cut-Away stabilizer.
- 2. Stitch the Placement Guide Stitch. Be sure to use a thread color that blends with your fabric choice.
- 3. Spray the stabilizer lightly with Temporary Adhesive Spray. Place a square of fabric over the Placement Guide Stitch, right side up. Be sure there is a generous allowance of fabric overlapping the Placement Guide Stitch. This will become the seam allowance later. See Photo A
- 4. Attach the hoop to the machine and embroider until the next placement stitch for the appliqué. See Photo B
- 5. Stitch the placement stitch for the appliqué. Place the pre-cut appliqué appropriately, right side up. Stitch the tack down stitch. See Photo C
- 6. Continue to embroider all but the last color of the design.
- 7. Remove hoop from the machine but DO NOT remove fabric from the hoop.
- 8. Clip all jump threads.
- 9. Place another piece of fabric, right side down directly over the first piece with embroidery. (It is not recommended that Temporary Adhesive Spray is used at this step. Using Temporary Adhesive Spray may leave your embroidery slightly sticky. If desired, pin or tack down the corners only.) See Photo D
- 10. Reattach the hoop and stitch the final "seam stitch" through both layers of fabric. This will create the seam for the stuffed doll. Use a thread that blends well with your fabric. Remove the hoop from the machine and the fabric from the hoop.
- 11. Using embroidery scissors, carefully cut out the stitch 'n' turn project, leaving an appropriate amount of fabric as a seam allowance. As this project will be turned, the seam allowances will be fully hidden. (If this particular project may need to endure more use such as a pet toy or child's toy, it is advisable to leave a more substantial seam allowance. Cutting too close to the stitch line may compromise the integrity of the project over time.) See Photo E
- **12.** Turn the project right side out. Use a chopstick to turn out corners and curves.
- 13. Stuff with polyester stuffing to the desired fullness. See Photo F
- fusible webbing and fuse closed.

14. Fold tabs in and slip stitch the slit closed with a hand needle or insert a piece of

For Extra Fun:

- Attach buttons, beads, ribbons or embellishments prior to Step 9. Be extra sure any dimensional embellishments are not too close to the edge where the final joining stitch will be.
- Adding a ribbon loop to the top of the item can turn your stitch 'n' turn projects into door hangings or ornaments. Be sure to place the ribbon loop of the desired length just prior to Step 9 with the loop pointing inward toward the center of the embroidery. Leave approximately a ½" of ribbon tail at the top. This will ensure the ribbon loop is secured by the joining stitch and oriented correctly after turning.
- For sharper edges on an appliqué piece, affix a self-adhesive stabilizer like Stabil-Stick to the fabric before cutting the appliqué according to pattern. This will help prevent fraying and puckering.









Pre-Cut Appliqué

- 1. Print out the necessary pages from the PDF of the applique pattern(s).
- 2. Mark the right side of the pattern pieces so you'll know which direction to lay the pattern on the fabric.
- 3. Lightly spray the wrong side of the pattern pieces with temporary adhesive spray and allow it to set for a few minutes.
- 4. Place the pattern pieces on the right side of the fabric and carefully cut them out. PHOTO 1
- 5. Sew the placement stitch on your hooped fabric. **PHOTO 2**
- 6. With the paper still stuck to the right side of the appliqué fabric, spray the wrong side of the fabric with temporary spray adhesive.
- 7. Place the fabric inside the sewing placement stitch so that it matches the stitching line, and then remove the paper pattern. **PHOTO 3**
- 3. Sew the tackdown. **PHOTO 4**
- 9. Sew the remainder of the design and repeat for any remaining pieces. **PHOTO 5**

NOTE: The patterns are sized for the designs as they were made. If you resize the design, you will need to resize the pattern the same amount. You can print out the pattern at the normal size then copy it on a copy machine at the changed size. For example, resize the designs to 80%, resize the printed pattern to 80%.

TIP: When Printing the patterns, make sure that the "Fit to page" option is UNCHECKED in the Print Dialog Box. If this option is checked the printed patterns will not be actual size.












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
ATTENTION


TO SAVE PAPER






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


Russian Nesting Dolls Pre-Cut Appliqué
