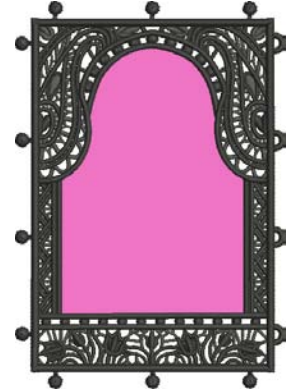

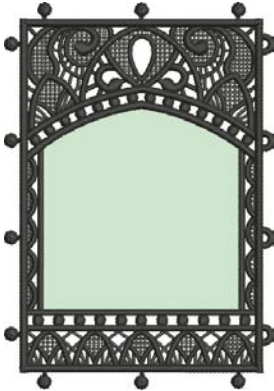

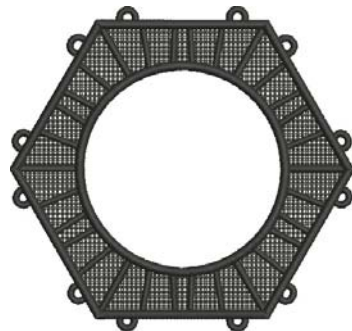

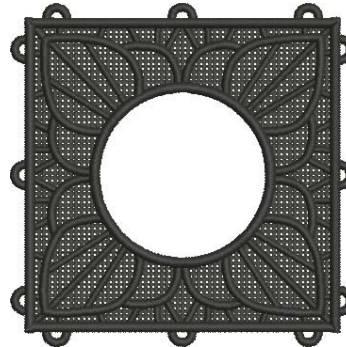

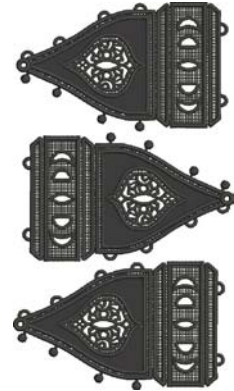

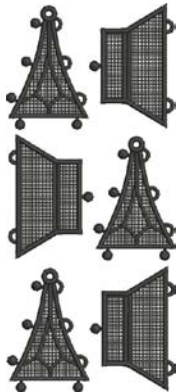

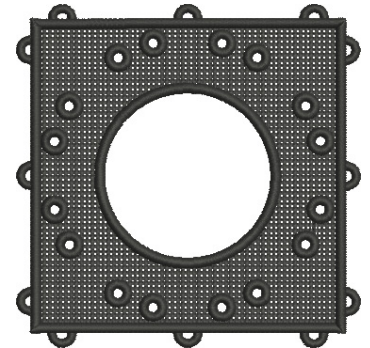

Cut-In-Place Appliqué Instructions

1. Hoop your fabric and backing.
2. Sew the pattern/placement. **PHOTO 1**
3. Place a piece of appliqué fabric over the pattern/placement so that it is completely covered.
4. Sew the trim stitch/tackdown.
5. Carefully cut away the excess appliqué fabric. **PHOTO 2**
6. Sew the remainder of the design and repeat for any remaining pieces. **PHOTO 3**



General Freestanding Lace Guidelines

Supplies:

Embroidery Thread:

- Use the same embroidery thread in the bobbin as the needle.

Needles:

- Use an Organ 80/12 Titanium needle for extended needle life.

Stabilizer:

- Use water-soluble stabilizer or film water-soluble stabilizer.

Handy Hints:

For Stiffer Lace:

- DO NOT rinse away all of the stabilizer for a “stiffer” lace. Note that the thread may appear a shade darker if stabilizer is not removed completely.
- If you happen to wash too much out, easily re-stiffen by diluting some stabilizer scraps in water and dipping the item in the solution.

For Very Soft Lace:

- Cut away excess stabilizer. Remove remaining stabilizer by rinsing under warm running water until all traces of the stabilizer are gone. **Note:** If lace should become too limp to work with, dissolve stabilizer scraps in warm water and apply to the lace.

Drying Lace:

- The lace looks best when left to dry completely. Lay lace piece with right side down to dry. This will minimize the tendency for the lace to curl. Be sure to flatten the piece out entirely and allow ample time to dry.

General Instructions

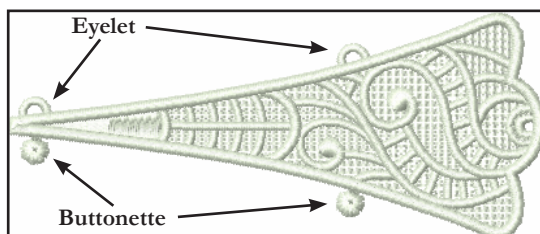
1. Hoop two layers of water-soluble stabilizer.
2. Attach the hoop to the machine and select the design of your choice.
3. Stitch the design.
4. Remove the hoop from the machine and the design from the hoop. Trim excess stabilizer from the design.
5. Rinse away remaining stabilizer and allow it to dry.

Handy Hints:

For 3D Lace Projects:

- Rinsing out lace with very hot water can cause wrinkles in some fabrics after it has been embroidered. To prevent this, pre-shrink cotton fabric by washing it in warm water and drying it in a dryer.
- If item becomes too limp to work with, iron the appliqué pieces on the wrong side while applying spray starch. After ironing, spray again with starch and allow to dry completely. This will stiffen the lace pieces nicely and aid in construction.
- A pair of tweezers, hemostats, stiletto or a tiny crochet hook can be extremely helpful when inserting the buttonettes into the eyelets. (Please see **Diagram 1** for explanation of “buttonette” and “eyelet”.)
- Insert the tip of the tweezers, hemostats or crochet hook into the eyelet, grasp the buttonette and pull through the eyelet. Or a stiletto could be used to push the buttonette through the eyelet.

Hexagon Lantern – Summary

Requires 6 Hexagon sides – choose from:

- Hexagon Lantern Side 1 FSA – 12549-01,
- Hexagon Lantern Side 2 FSA – 12549-02
- or Hexagon Lantern Side 3 FSA – 12549-03

Requires Bottom – choose from:

- Hexagon Lantern Bottom FSL – 12549-06
- or (2) Hexagon Lantern Top 2A FSL – 12549-09 and (1) Hexagon Lantern Top 2B FSL – 12549-10

Requires Top – choose from:

- (2) Hexagon Lantern Top 1 FSA – 12549-08
- or (2) Hexagon Lantern Top 2A FSL – 12549-09 and (1) Hexagon Lantern Top 2B FSL – 12549-10

Square Lantern – Summary

Requires 4 Square sides – choose from:

- Square Lantern Side 1 FSA – 12549-04
- or Square Lantern Side 2 FSA – 12549-05

Requires Bottom – choose from:

- Square Lantern Bottom FSL – 12549-07
- or Square Lantern Top A FSL – 12549-11 and Square Lantern Top B FSL – 12549-12

Requires Top –

- Square Lantern Top A FSL – 12549-11 and Square Lantern Top B FSL – 12549-12

Supplies

- Embroidery thread
- Organza fabric for appliqué
- Mesh wash away stabilizer
- LED tea light
- Embroidery machine
- Alligator clamps, tweezers, hemostats, stiletto or a tiny crochet hook

Follow the *General Freestanding Lace Guidelines* and *Cut-in-Place Appliqué Instructions* and stitch the required pieces as listed in the summary above for the style and shape of your lantern.



Build Hexagon Lantern

NOTE: It is easier to reach in from the inside with a pair of alligator clamps and pull the buttonettes through the eyelets.

Sides

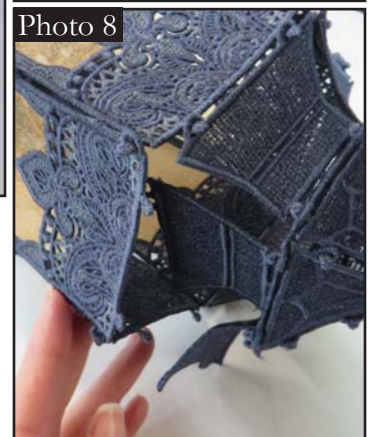
- Attach a hexagon side to another hexagon side by inserting the four buttonettes along the left side into the four eyelets on the right side. **PHOTO 1**
- Repeat this process until all but the last side is attached.

Bottom

- For the Hexagon Lantern Bottom FSL (12549-06) connect it to all sides by inserting the side buttonettes into the eyelets of the bottom. **PHOTO 2**
- For the Hexagon Lantern Top 2 then follow the instructions below.

Top

- For the Hexagon Lantern Top 1 FSA (12549-08) connect the six pieces together by inserting the four buttonettes along the left side into the four eyelets on the right side. **PHOTO 3**
 - Attach the Hexagon Lantern Top 1 to the sides by inserting the buttonettes from the sides into the corresponding eyelets in the top. The buttonettes will be pulled through the inside of the top. **PHOTO 4**
- For the Hexagon Lantern Top 2A FSL (12549-09) and Hexagon Lantern Top 2B FSL (12549-10) being used as a top or bottom, follow these instructions:
 - Attach the 6 triangle pieces together by inserting the three buttonettes into the corresponding eyelets to form a circle. **PHOTO 5**
 - Attach the circle from above to the Hexagon Lantern Top 2B piece by inserting the buttonettes from the circle into the eyelets. **PHOTO 6**
 - Attach the remaining 6 single pieces to the circle and flat piece by inserting the single buttonette into the eyelet. **PHOTO 7**
 - Connect the top section to the bottom or top of the hexagon sides by inserting the buttonettes from the sides into the eyelets of the top section. **PHOTO 8**
- Your Hexagon Lantern is complete.



Build Square Lantern

Sides

- Attach a square side to another square side by inserting the four buttonettes along the left side into the four eyelets on the right side. **PHOTO 9**
- Repeat this process with the remaining square sides to form a square.

Bottom

- For the Square Lantern Bottom FSL (12549-07) connect it to all sides by inserting the side buttonettes into the eyelets of the bottom. **PHOTO 10**
- For the Square Lantern Top A & B then follow the instructions below.

Top

- For the Square Lantern Top A & B as the bottom or the top, follow these instructions:
 - Attach Square Lantern Top A to Square Lantern Top B by inserting the buttonettes into the eyelets. The smaller pieces attach square and the larger open pieces attach on point. **PHOTO 11**
 - Attach the Top A/B to the bottom or top by inserting the buttonettes along the top side pieces into the eyelets of the Top A/B. **PHOTO 12**
- Your Square Lantern is complete.
