Create your own calendar for the New Year using the Ombre Numerals #12554 embroidery collection. Included is a 2015 calendar to print onto an iron-on transfer. It is a simple project to start the New Year.

Supplies

- OESD embroidery collection Ombre Numerals #12554
- 18" x 29" or ½ yd. off-white linen fabric
- ½" diameter dowel rod
- 2 dowel caps with ½" hole
- Iron-on Transfer paper
- Embroidery threads
- Medium Tear Away Stabilizer
- Temporary Spray Adhesive

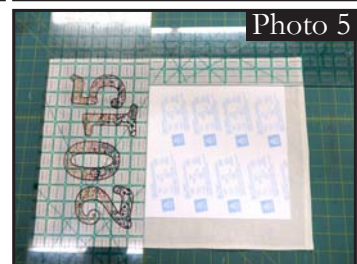
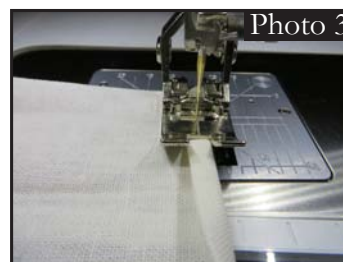
Instructions

NOTE: Designs used in sample are #12554-01, #12554-02, #12554-10, and #12554-05. They are combined in embroidery software and stitched in the maxi hoop. The final size of the calendar is approximately 12" x 16 ¾".

- Using temporary spray adhesive, spray between two layers of medium tear away stabilizer and adhere to each other and to the wrong side of the off-white linen fabric leaving approximately 4" above the top of the numerals. Hoop the fabric and stabilizer. **PHOTO 1**
- Embroider the numerals. Remove hoop and the stabilizer.
- Trim the embroidered piece to 13" x 19", centering the numerals and leaving 3" from the top of the numerals. **PHOTO 2**
- Create a narrow hem on the long edges by folding and pressing ¼" and again ¼". Edgestitch. **PHOTO 3**
- To create the top rod pocket, fold and press ½" and then 1". Pin in place. Edgestitch. **PHOTO 4**
- To create the hem, fold and press ¼" and again ¼". Edgestitch. Press.
- Carefully follow manufacturer's directions, print the calendar onto an iron-on transfer.

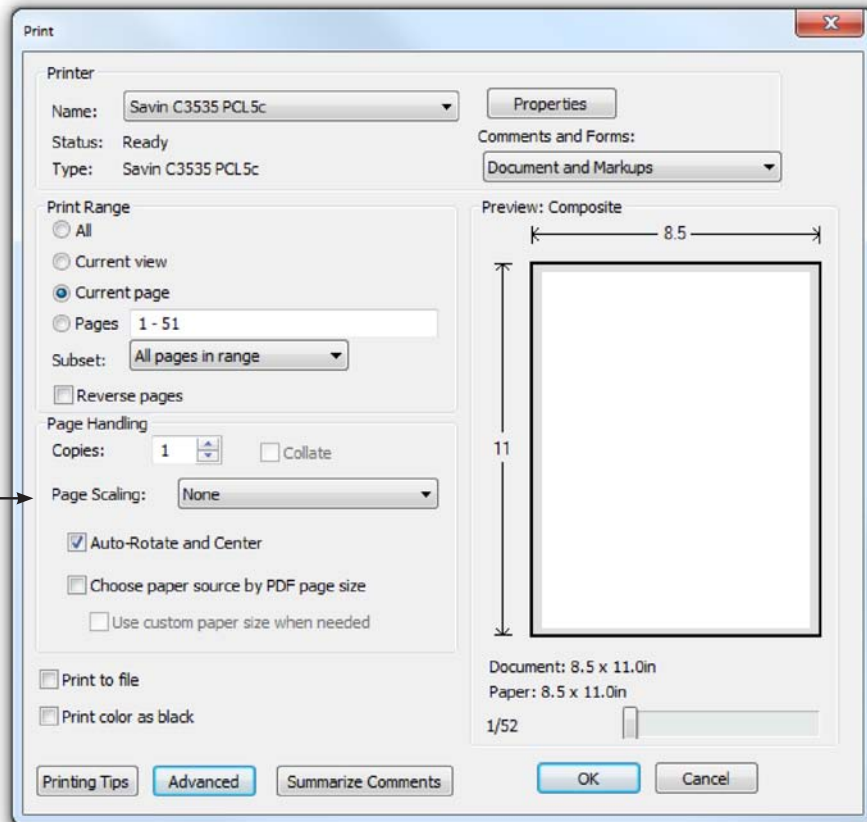
NOTE: The calendar provided is already reversed.

- Measure ¾" from the bottom of the lower numbers of the calendar and cut off the blank iron-on transfer. Measure with a clear ruler ¾" from the bottom of the numerals and 1¾" from the sides to center and place the iron-on transfer. **PHOTO 5**
- Tape the calendar in place to move to the ironing board. Remove the tape. Press in place according to manufacturer's directions.
- Insert the dowel rod into the rod pocket. Add end caps to either end of the dowel rod.
- Hang and enjoy.



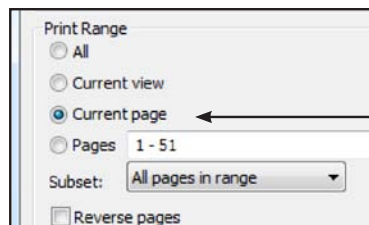
