

Listings below indicate color sample, stitching order and suggested thread color number. Most numbers indicate Isacord thread. Colors beginning with 20501 refer to YLI Fine Metallics, 7 refer to Yenmet Metallic, 8 refer to YLI Variations Variegated Thread and 9 refer to Isacord Multicolor Variegated.

- 2. Rose Tackdown..... 2532
- 3. Rose Shading..... 2532
- 4. Leaf Placement Stitch..... 5944
- 5. Leaf Cut Line & Tackdown..... 5944
- 6. Leaf Cover Stitch & Shading..... 5944
- 7. Rose Detail..... 2520
- 8. Back Panel Placement Stitch..... 0020
- 9. Seam..... 0020

In the Hoop Flower Zipper Pouch

Instructions

Now you can create a rose shaped zippered pouch in the hoop of your embroidery machine. Use pink fabric for the rose and green fabric for the leaves. The zipper is on the back of the pouch. It is another quick and fun in the hoop project. Enjoy making the Flower Zipper Pouch as a gift!

Supplies

- OESD embroidery collection In the Hoop Flower Zipper Pouch #12578
- Medium tear away stabilizer
- ¼ yd. pink fabric (back panel, rose and inner panel)
- 2" x 5 ½" piece green fabric (leaves applique)
- (5") ½" pink ribbon (ring tab)
- Metal key ring
- 7" pink zipper
- Isacord embroidery threads
- Temporary spray adhesive






Cut

- (1) 6 ½" x 5" piece pink fabric (fold in half to measure 6 ½" x 2 ½") (top panel)
- (1) 6 ½" x 9" piece pink fabric (fold in half to measure 6 ½" x 4 ½") (bottom panel)
- (2) 6 ½" x 7" piece pink fabric (rose and inner panel)
- (1) 1" x 5" piece pink fabric (zipper pull strip)

Back Panel Instructions (#12578-01)

- Hoop tear away stabilizer.
- Stitch first stitch of embroidery design which is the Zipper Placement Stitch. **PHOTO 1**
- Using temporary spray adhesive, spray the zipper placement stitch. Center and place zipper over the stitching lines. Stitch the second stitch of embroidery design called Zipper Tackdown. **PHOTO 2**
- Using top panel and bottom panel fabric pieces, fold in half, wrong sides together. Press. Center and place top panel fabric with folded edge to top teeth of zipper, leaving at least a ¼" on either end. Center and place bottom panel fabric with folded edge to bottom teeth of zipper, leaving at least a ¼" on either end. Stitch the third stitch called Panel Placement & Tackdown. **PHOTO 3**
- Stitch the next color which is the Cut Guide. Remove hoop from the embroidery machine and the fabric from the hoop. Trim ¼" away from the Cut Guide. Unzip the zipper half way. Set aside. **PHOTO 4**



Rose Panel and Assembly Instructions (#12578-02)

- Hoop tear away stabilizer.
- Stitch the first stitch of the embroidery design which is the Rose Placement Stitch. **PHOTO 5**
- Center and place the rose fabric piece over the Rose Placement Stitch. Stitch

the second stitch of the embroidery design called Rose Tackdown. **PHOTO 6**

- Stitch the Rose Shading. Change colors of thread and stitch the Leaf Placement Stitch. **PHOTO 7**
- Center and place the leaves applique fabric over the Leaf Placement Stitch. Stitch the next color called Leaf Tackdown. **PHOTO 8**
- Take the hoop off the embroidery machine and trim away the fabric. Put the embroidery hoop back on the embroidery machine. Stitch the next color called Leaf Cover Stitch. **PHOTO 9**
- Stitch the next color called Rose.
- Take hoop off the embroidery machine and spray the back of the hoop with temporary spray adhesive. Center and place inner panel fabric over the back lining up with the front fabric piece. **PHOTO 10**
- Place hoop back on the embroidery machine. Stitch the next color called Back Panel Placement Stitch. **PHOTO 11**
- Using the ribbon, fold in half and place the metal key ring on the ribbon. Place the ring tab at the upper left center. **PHOTO 12**
- Center and place the back panel wrong side up over the rose.
- Stitch the final color which is the Seam Stitch. **PHOTO 13**
- Remove hoop from the embroidery machine and the fabric from the hoop. Trim 1/4" away from the Seam Stitch. **PHOTO 14**
- Using 1" x 5" piece fabric (zipper pull strip), fold and press in half, wrong sides together. Fold raw edges in to meet fold line. Press. Topstitch. Cut one end at an angle to insert into the end of the zipper pull. Fold the strip over onto itself, and stitch the two pieces together. Trim other end of strip at an angle.
- Have fun making the In the Hoop Flower Zipper Pouch.
