




Instructions

Supplies

- Gift Jar Collection #12606
- OESD Stabil-Stick Tear Away
- OESD Aqua Mesh
- Isacord Embroidery Thread
- Applique Fabric Scraps
- In the Hoop Applique Scissors
- Ribbons for tags and labels
- Mason jar wide or standard size

Tags

- 1. Thread the machine with the same color Isacord thread in the needle and the bobbin.
- 2. Hoop two layers of OESD Aqua Mesh Stabilizer. **Photo 1**
- 3. Stitch the first color change, which will be a placement line. **Photo 2**
- 4. Remove the hoop from the machine but do not remove the project from the hoop.
- 5. Cut two pieces of appliqué fabric slightly larger than the placement line. **Photo 3**
- 6. Adhere a scrap of stabil-stick tear away to the back of one of the pieces of appliqué fabric. **Photo 4**
- 7. Place the other fabric wrong sides together with the first appliqué fabric. The stabil-stick will be sandwiched between the appliqué layers. The stabil-stick serves as an interfacing to stiffen the finished project. **Photo 5**
- Place the appliqué fabrics as a unit onto the hoop over the placement line.
 Photo 6
- 9. Return the hoop to the machine and stitch the next color change, which will be a Tackdown/cut line. **Photo 7**
- **10.** Remove the hoop from the machine but do not remove the project from the hoop.
- 11. Using a pair of in-the hoop appliqué scissors, trim as close as possible to the cut line. **Photo 8**
- **12.** Return the hoop to the machine and stitch the remaining color changes. **Photo 9**





Instructions

- **13.** Remove the hoop from the machine and the project from the hoop. Cut away most of the excess stabilizer. **Photo 10**
- 14. Rinse the project under warm running water to remove remaining stabilizer.Photo 11
- 15. Allow the project to dry. Photo 12
- 16. Thread a ribbon or cording through the tag eyelet and tie to your jar or package.


Instructions

Labels

- 1. Thread the machine with the same color Isacord thread in the needle and the bobbin.
- 2. Hoop two layers of OESD Aqua Mesh Stabilizer. **Photo 1**
- 3. Stitch the first color change, which will be a placement line. **Photo 2**
- 4. Remove the hoop from the machine but do not remove the project from the hoop.
- 5. Cut a piece of appliqué fabric slightly larger than the placement line. **Photo 3**
- 6. Adhere a scrap of stabil-stick tear away to the back of the appliqué fabric. The Stabil-Stick will serve as an interfacing to help stiffen the project. **Photo 4**
- 7. Place the appliqué fabric right side up onto the placement stitch. **Photo 5**
- 8. Return the hoop to the machine and stitch the next color change, which will be a Tackdown/cut line. **Photo 6**
- 9. Remove the hoop from the machine but do not remove the project from the hoop.
- **10.** Using a pair of in-the hoop appliqué scissors, trim as close as possible to the cut line. **Photo 7**
- 11. Return the hoop to the machine and stitch the remaining color changes.Photo 8
- **12.** Remove the hoop from the machine and the project from the hoop. Cut away most of the excess stabilizer.

- **13.** Rinse the project under warm running water to remove remaining stabilizer.
- **14**. Allow the project to dry.
- **15.** Wrap the label around the mason jar. **Photo 10**



- **16.** Thread a ribbon through the eyelets on both ends of the wrap. **Photo 11**
- 17. Tie the loose ends of the ribbon to form a bow and hold the wrap around the jar. Photo 12



Instructions

Mason Jar Top

- 1. Thread the machine with the same color Isacord thread in the needle and the bobbin.
- 2. Hoop two layers of OESD Aqua Mesh Stabilizer. **Photo 1**
- 3. Stitch the first color change, which will be a placement line. **Photo 2**
- 4. Remove the hoop from the machine but do not remove the project from the hoop.
- 5. Cut a piece of appliqué fabric slightly larger than the placement line. **Photo 3**
- 6. Adhere a scrap of stabil-stick tear away to the back of the appliqué fabric. The Stabil-Stick will serve as an interfacing to help stiffen the project. **Photo 4**
- 7. Place the appliqué fabric right side up onto the placement stitch. **Photo 5**
- 8. Return the hoop to the machine and stitch the next color change, which will be a Tackdown/cut line. **Photo 6**
- 9. Remove the hoop from the machine but do not remove the project from the hoop.
- **10.** Using a pair of in-the hoop appliqué scissors, trim as close as possible to the cut line. **Photo 7**
- 11. Return the hoop to the machine and stitch the remaining color changes.Photo 8
- 12. Remove the hoop from the machine and the project from the hoop. Cut away most of the excess stabilizer.

- **13.** Rinse the project under warm running water to remove remaining stabilizer.
- 14. Allow the project to dry. Photo 10
- 15. Place the label into the ring portion of the mason jar lid. Tack in place with a small amount of hot glue if desired. **Photo 11 and 12**

16. OPTIONAL: Use the seal portion of the mason jar lid to trace and cut two layers of lightweight batting. Glue the batting circles to the top of the jar lid before adding the jar top and ring. This will give the finished jar top a slight "puff". Photo 13, 14, and 15










Instructions

Mason Jar Cover

- 1. Thread the machine with the same color Isacord thread in the needle and the bobbin.
- 2. Hoop two layers of OESD Aqua Mesh Stabilizer. **Photo 1**
- 3. Stitch the first color change, which will be a placement line. **Photo 2**
- 4. Remove the hoop from the machine but do not remove the project from the hoop.
- 5. Cut a piece of appliqué fabric slightly larger than the placement line. **Photo 3**
- 6. Do not use Stabil-Stick to interface the appliqué fabrics for the cover designs. The outside edge of the cover will overhang the jar and needs to "drape" slightly.
- 7. Place the appliqué fabric right side up onto the placement stitch. **Photo 4**
- 8. Return the hoop to the machine and stitch the next color change, which will be a Tackdown/cut line. **Photo 5**
- 9. Remove the hoop from the machine but do not remove the project from the hoop.
- **10.** Using a pair of in-the hoop appliqué scissors, trim as close as possible to the cut line. **Photo 6**
- 11. Return the hoop to the machine and stitch the remaining color changes.Photo 7
- 12. Remove the hoop from the machine and the project from the hoop. Cut away most of the excess stabilizer.Photo 8
- **13.** Rinse the project under warm running water to remove remaining stabilizer.
- 14. Allow the project to dry.
- **15.** Place the seal portion of the lid onto the jar, and then center the jar cover over the seal. **Photo 9**
- **16.** Screw the ring over the jar cover, allowing the excess to hang from underneath the ring. **Photo 10**

17. OPTIONAL: Use the seal portion of the mason jar lid to trace and cut two layers of lightweight batting. Glue the batting circles to the top of the jar lid before adding the jar cover and ring. This will give the finished jar top a slight "puff". Photo 11, 12, and 13

Charms

1. Refer to General Freestanding Lace Guidelines below

General Freestanding Lace Guidelines

Supplies:

Embroidery Thread:

- Use the same embroidery thread in the bobbin as the needle.
- Use an Organ 80/12 Titanium needle for extended needle life. **Stabilizer:**
- Use water-soluble stabilizer or film water-soluble stabilizer.

Handy Hints:

For Stiffer Lace:

- DO NOT rinse away all of the stabilizer for a "stiffer" lace.
 Note that the thread may appear a shade darker if stabilizer is not removed completely.
- If you happen to wash too much out, easily re-stiffen by diluting some stabilizer scraps in water and dipping the item in the solution.


For Very Soft Lace:

 Cut away excess stabilizer. Remove remaining stabilizer by rinsing under warm running water until all traces of the stabilizer are gone. Note: If lace should become too limp to work with, dissolve stabilizer scraps in warm water and apply to the lace.

Drying Lace:

 The lace looks best when left to dry completely. Lay lace piece with right side down to dry. This will minimize the tendency for the lace to curl. Be sure to flatten the piece out entirely and allow ample time to dry.

General Instructions

- 1. Hoop two layers of water-soluble stabilizer.
- 2. Attach the hoop to the machine and select the design of your choice
- 3. Stitch the design.
- 4. Remove the hoop from the machine and the design from the hoop. Trim excess stabilizer from the design.
- 5. Rinse away remaining stabilizer and allow it to dry.

Handy Hints:

For 3D Lace Projects:

- Rinsing out lace with very hot water can cause wrinkles in some fabrics after it has been embroidered. To prevent this, pre-shrink cotton fabric by washing it in warm water and drying it in a dryer.
- If item becomes too limp to work with, iron the appliqué pieces on the wrong side while applying spray starch. After ironing, spray again with starch and allow to dry completely. This will stiffen the lace pieces nicely and aid in construction.
- A pair of tweezers, hemostats, stiletto or a tiny crochet hook can be extremely helpful when inserting the buttonettes into the eyelets. (Please see **Diagram 1** for explanation of "buttonette" and "eyelet".)
- Insert the tip of the tweezers, hemostats or crochet hook into the eyelet, grasp the buttonette and pull through the eyelet.
 Or a stiletto could be used to push the buttonette through the eyelet.
