Instructions

Supplies


- OESD Fusible Tear Away
- Small appliqué iron
- Removable tape
- Fabric scraps (see fabric guides for sizes)
- 10" of ribbon for each bunting piece
- Point turner
- OESD Fuse & Seal or hand needle to close seam openings

Patchwork Bunting

Use these instructions for designs 12624-01, 12624-04, 12624-07, 12624-10, 12624-13, and 12624-16

- Print the fabric guide for your selected design.
 Photo 01
- 2. Hoop a piece of OESD Fusible Tear Away with the fusible side UP. Photo 02
- 3. Select the desired design.
- Stitch color change 1 on the stabilizer (no fabric).
 This will stitch the fabric placement lines. Photo
 03
- 5. Cut a scrap of fabric that is at least ¹/₄" larger than area 1 on your fabric placement guide.

- 6. Place the fabric right side up over area 1 on the stabilizer. **Photo 05**
- 7. Press the fabric to the stabilizer with a small appliqué iron. If desired, use a Teflon pressing sheet to prevent touching the fusible area of the stabilizer to the sole of the iron. **Photo 06.**
- 8. Stitch color change 2, which will stitch a placement line for fabric 2. **Photo 07**
- 9. Trim fabric 1 to a 1/4" seam allowance from the placement line on the side that overlaps area 2. See your fabric placement guide for reference. **Photo 08**
- 10. Cut a scrap of fabric that is at least 1/4" larger than area 2 on all sides. This will be fabric 2. Use the fabric placement guide for reference for size and shape. **Photo 09**
- 11. Place fabric 2 right sides together with fabric 1, aligning the raw edge with the seam allowance you trimmed in step 9. **Photo 10**
- **12.** Stitch color change 3, which will stitch a seam line for fabric 2. **Photo 11**
- Remove the hoop from the machine. Fold back fabric 2 so it covers area 2. Press into place.

Instructions

- **14.** Replace the hoop on the machine. Stitch color change 4, which is the placement stitch for fabric 3. **Photo 13**
- 15. Trim fabric 1 & 2 to a ¹/₄" seam allowance from the placement line you just stitched. **Photo 14**
- Cut a scrap of fabric that is at least ¹/₄" larger than area 3 on your fabric placement guide.

- 17. Place fabric 3 right sides together with fabric 1 and 2, aligning the raw edges with the seam allowance you trimmed in step 15. **Photo 16**
- **18.** Stitch color change 5, which is the seam stitch for fabric 3. **Photo 17**
- Remove the hoop from the machine. Fold back fabric 3 so it covers area 3. Press into place.
 Photo 18
 - For Design 12624-10, repeat steps 14-19 for the fourth fabric. Color change 6 will stitch the placement stitch for fabric 4. Color change 7 will stitch the seam line for fabric 4.
- 20. Replace the hoop on the machine. Stitch color change 6 (color change 8 for design 12624-10), which will stitch decorative stitches over the seams. **Photo 19**
- 21. Stitch color change 7 (color change 9 for design 12624-10), which will baste the fabrics to the stabilizer and provide a placement for the ribbons and the back of the bunting. **Photo 20**
- 22. Cut a length of ribbon approximately 10" long. Place each end of the ribbon so the cut end of the ribbon aligns with the ribbon tabs stitched in Step 21. Tape the ends of the ribbon in place. Tape the excess ribbon in place so it is entirely within the bunting making sure it will not be caught by the seam. Photo 21 and 22
- 23. Cut a scrap of fabric at least 1/4" larger than the bunting placement line on all sides. Refer to the fabric placement guide for size and shape reference. This will be the backing fabric. **Photo** 23
- 24. Place the backing fabric right sides together with the hooped project, being sure to cover the entire placement line. Tape the edges of the backing in place to secure temporarily. Photo 24


- **25.** Stitch color change 8 (color change 10 for design 12624-10). This will be the seam stitch for the project. **Photo 25**
- 26. Remove the project from the hoop. Tear away the excess stabilizer. Trim the entire project to 1/4" from the seam line on all sides. Clip corners and grade curves. **Photo 26**
- 27. Turn the project through the opening in the seam. **Photo 27**
- 28. Use a point turner to smooth out corners. Photo 28
- 29. Press well. Seal the opening closed a small scrap of OESD Fuse & Seal or whipstitch closed with needle and thread. **Photo 29**
- 30. To tie bunting to the next bunting piece, clip the ribbon loop in half. Tie bunting pieces end to end as desired. **Photo 30** and **31**


















Instructions

Bordered Bunting

Use these instructions for designs 12624-02, 12624-05, 12624-08, 12624-11, 12624-14, and 12624-17

- 1. Hoop a piece of OESD Fusible Tear Away with the fusible side UP. **Photo 01**
- Stitch color change 1 on the stabilizer (no fabric).
 Photo 02
- 3. Place a piece of fabric right side up over the placement line. Fabric should be larger than the placement line by at least 1/4" on all sides. Press into place with a small appliqué iron. **Photo 03**
- Stitch color change 2, which will stitch the decorative border. Photo 04
- 5. Stitch color change 3, which will stitch the ribbon and back placement stitch. **Photo 05**
- 6. Cut a length of ribbon approximately 10" long. Place each end of the ribbon so the cut end of the ribbon aligns with the ribbon tabs stitched in Step 5. Tape the ends of the ribbon in place. Tape the excess ribbon in place so it is entirely within the bunting making sure it will not be caught by the seam. **Photo 6**
- 7. Cut a scrap of fabric at least 1/4" larger than the bunting placement line on all sides. This will be the backing fabric. Place the backing fabric right sides together with the hooped project, being sure to cover the entire placement line. Tape the edges of the backing in place to secure temporarily. Photo 7
- 8. Stitch color change 4. This will be the seam stitch for the project. **Photo 8**
- 9. Remove the project from the hoop. Tear away the excess stabilizer. Trim the entire project to ½" from the seam line on all sides. Clip corners and grade curves. **Photo 9**
- Turn the project through the opening in the seam.
 Photo 10
- 11. Use a point turner to smooth out corners. Photo 11
- 12. Press well. Seal the opening closed a small scrap of OESD Fuse & Seal or whipstitch closed with needle and thread. Photo 12
- 13. To tie bunting to the next bunting piece, clip the ribbon loop in half. Tie bunting pieces end to end as desired. Photo 13 and 14






Instructions

Solid Bunting

Use these instructions for designs 12624-03, 12624-06, 12624-09, 12624-12, 12624-15, and 12624-18

- 1. Hoop a piece of OESD Fusible Tear Away with the fusible side UP. **Photo 01**
- Stitch color change 1 on the stabilizer (no fabric).
 Photo 02
- 3. Place a piece of fabric right side up over the placement line. Fabric should be larger than the placement line by at least 1/4" on all sides. Press into place with a small appliqué iron. **Photo 03**
- 4. Stitch color change 2, which will stitch the ribbon and back placement stitch. **Photo 04**
- 5. Cut a length of ribbon approximately 10" long. Place each end of the ribbon so the cut end of the ribbon aligns with the ribbon tabs stitched in Step 4. Tape the ends of the ribbon in place. Tape the excess ribbon in place so it is entirely within the bunting making sure it will not be caught by the seam. **Photos 5** and 6
- 6. Cut a scrap of fabric at least 1/4" larger than the bunting placement line on all sides. This will be the backing fabric. Place the backing fabric right sides together with the hooped project, being sure to cover the entire placement line. Tape the edges of the backing in place to secure temporarily. Photo 7
- 7. Stitch color change 3. This will be the seam stitch for the project. **Photo 8**
- 8. Remove the project from the hoop. Tear away the excess stabilizer. Trim the entire project to ½" from the seam line on all sides. Clip corners and grade curves. **Photo 9**
- Turn the project through the opening in the seam.
 Photo 10
- 10. Use a point turner to smooth out corners. Photo 11
- **11.** Press well. Seal the opening closed a small scrap of OESD Fuse & Seal or whipstitch closed with needle and thread. **Photo 12**
- 12. To tie bunting to the next bunting piece, clip the ribbon loop in half. Tie bunting pieces end to end as desired. Photo 13 and 14






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
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
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







