


Pre-Cut Appliqué Instructions

- 1. Print out the necessary pages from the PDF of the applique pattern(s).
- 2. Mark the right side of the pattern pieces so you'll know which direction to lay the pattern on the fabric.
- 3. Lightly spray the wrong side of the pattern pieces with temporary adhesive spray and allow it to set for a few minutes.
- 4. Place the pattern pieces on the right side of the fabric and carefully cut them out. **PHOTO 1**
- 5. Sew the placement stitch on your hooped fabric. **PHOTO 2**
- 6. With the paper still stuck to the right side of the appliqué fabric, spray the wrong side of the fabric with temporary spray adhesive.
- 7. Place the fabric inside the placement stitch, so that it completely covers the placement stitch and then remove the paper pattern. **PHOTO 3**
- 8. Sew the tackdown. PHOTO 4
- 9. Sew the remainder of the design and repeat for any remaining pieces. PHOTO 5

NOTE: The patterns are sized for the designs as they were made. If you resize the design, you will need to resize the pattern the same amount. You can print out the pattern at the normal size then copy it on a copy machine at the changed size. For example, resize the designs to 80%, resize the printed pattern to 80%.

TIP: When Printing the patterns, make sure that the "Fit to page" option is UNCHECKED in the Print Dialog Box. If this option is checked the printed patterns will not be actual size.





Instructions

#### Supplies

- OESD embroidery collection Quotable Wraps #12630
- Heavy weight wash away stabilizer
- 1/4 yd. OR 9" x 10" fabric
- 9" x 4" piece Insul-Bright
- 1 1/4" piece 3/4" Velcro®
- Appliqué fabrics
- Isacord embroidery threads
- Temporary spray adhesive

### Cut

- (1) Insul-Bright using pattern
- (2) 4 ½" x 10" pieces fabric (back and top fabrics)

#### Instructions


- Hoop two layers heavy weight wash away stabilizer.
- Stitch first stitch of embroidery design which is the Wrap Back Placement Stitch. **PHOTO** 1
- Center and place back fabric wrong side up. Stitch the second stitch of embroidery design called Wrap Back Cut Line & Tackdown and Hook & Loop Placement Stitch. PHOTO 2
- Trim fabric along cut line. PHOTO 3
- Place and tape in place hook side of Velcro® on the top of Wrap wrong side up over the Hook & Loop Placement Stitch. Place and tape in place loop side of Velcro® on the bottom of Wrap right side up over the Hook & Loop Placement Stitch.
   PHOTO 4
- Stitch the Hook and Loop Tackdown, making sure the Velcro® pieces don't move. **PHOTO 5**
- Using temporary spray adhesive, spray both sides of the Insul-Bright. Center and place Insul-Bright over back. Center and place fabric top right side up over Insul-Bright. Stitch the Insulation and Wrap Front Basting Stitch. PHOTO 6
- Stitch the Wrap Front Cut Line & Tackdown. Trim fabric along cut line, being careful not to cut the Velcro® pieces. **PHOTO 7**
- Stitch the next colors for the design on the cup Wrap according to the thread chart. Follow the basic *Pre-Cut Appliqué Instructions* when stitching Placement Stitch(s) during the embroidery process if applicable.


**NOTE:** You may want to change the bobbin thread now to match the last color.

- The last color is the Match Bobbin and Cover Stitch. If you haven't already changed out your bobbin thread now is the time. PHOTO 8
- Remove hoop from the machine and Wrap from the
- Place the cup Wrap around your cup and Velcro® in place. Enjoy the different ones!






### **ATTENTION**
