




Notes

- The freestanding applique instructions, included in the collection, are general instructions. For demonstration purposes, a sample design (12666-01) that best demonstrates the technique is shown.
- Fabric and thread requirements will vary by design, but the general technique is the same.
- · All designs are stitched with matching thread in the top and bobbin.
- Note: Some thread colors in instructions have been changed or digitally enhanced for better visibility.

Double Sided Applique Technique

For Turkey Tail pieces 12666-01 and 12666-02








STEP 1

• Hoop one layer of AquaMesh and one layer of BadgeMaster for all designs.



STEP 2

- Adhere one layer of StabilStick CutAway to the wrong side of all fabrics as shown. This provides stiffness to the finished structure.
- Cut the prepared applique fabrics 1/4"-1/2" larger than the templates that are included at the end of the instructions.



- · Load selected design into the machine.
- Design in the example is 12666-01.
- Thread the machine per the thread chart, matching bobbin thread to the top thread throughout.
- Stitch Machine Step 1, Number 1 3 5 Feathers Placement Stitch.





STEP 4

- Remove the hoop from the machine, but NOT the project from the hoop.
- Lay the hoop on a flat surface.
- Place the prepared brown applique fabric, right side up, completely covering the placement stitch closest to you.
- Place the prepared rust applique fabric, right side up, completely covering the middle placement stitch.
- Place the prepared beige applique fabric, right side up, completely covering the last placement stitch.
- Tape in place to secure.
- Note: Be sure none of the fabrics overlap each other.



- · Return the hoop to the machine.
- Stitch Machine Step 2, Number 1 3 5 Feathers Cut Line & Tackdown.





STEP 6

- Remove the hoop from the machine, but NOT the project from the hoop.
- · Place the hoop on a flat surface.
- Trim the excess fabric as close to the cut line as possible. If the outermost stitches (cut line) are cut, the inner stitches (tackdown) will hold the applique in place.
- Tip: If the AquaMesh is cut or a hole is created while trimming the fabric, use OESD Expert Embroidery Tape WashAway as a patch.
- Helpful Hint: If it is difficult to trim the applique fabric for the buttonette connections, leave it and once the project pieces have been stitched, rinsed, dried, and pressed, used the OESD Perfect Punch Tool with the 2mm cutting tip to punch out the eyelets.



- · Return the hoop to the machine.
- Stitch Machine Step 3, Number 2 4 Feathers Placement Stitch.





STEP 8

- Remove the hoop from the machine, but NOT the project from the hoop.
- Lay the hoop on a flat surface.
- Place the prepared yellow applique fabric, right side up, completely covering the placement stitch closest to you.
- Place the prepared orange applique fabric, right side up, completely covering the last placement stitch.
- Tape in place to secure.
- Note: Be sure the yellow and orange applique fabrics do not overlap.



STEP 9

- Return the hoop to the machine.
- Stitch Machine Step 4, Number 2 4 Feathers Cut Line & Tackdown.



- Remove the hoop from the machine, but NOT the project from the hoop.
- Lay the hoop on a flat surface.
- Trim the excess fabric as close to the cut line as possible.





STEP 11

- Return the hoop to the machine.
- Stitch Machine Step 5, Body & Feather 6 Placement Stitch.



STEP 12

- Remove the hoop from the machine, but NOT the project from the hoop.
- · Lay the hoop on a flat surface.
- Place the prepared tan applique fabric, right side up, completely covering the placement stitch.
- Tape in place to secure.
- Return the hoop to the machine.
- Stitch Machine Step 6, Body & Feather 6 Cut Line & Tackdown.



- Remove the hoop from the machine, but NOT the project from the hoop.
- Lay the hoop on a flat surface.
- Trim the excess fabric as close to the cut line as possible.





STEP 14

- Return the hoop to the machine.
- Stitch Machine Steps 7 12, per thread chart.



STEP 15

- Before stitching Machine Step 13, remove the hoop from the machine, but NOT the project from the hoop.
- Turn the hoop over and place the prepared applique fabrics for feathers 1, 3 and 5, right side up, completely covering the placement stitch.
- Note: Match the bottom fabrics to the fabrics already placed on the top side of the hoop.
- Carefully tape to secure. Avoid pushing too hard on the stabilizer to prevent it from dislodging from the hoop.



- Return the hoop to the machine, be careful not to dislodge the fabric.
- Stitch Machine Step 13; Number 1 3 5 Feathers Back Cut Line & Tackdown.





STEP 17

- Remove the hoop from the machine, but NOT the project from the hoop.
- Turn the hoop over and carefully trim the excess fabric as close to the cut line as possible.



STEP 18

- Place the prepared applique fabrics for Feathers 2 and 4, right side up, completely covering the placement stitch.
- Note: Match the bottom fabrics to the fabrics already placed on the top side of the hoop.
- Carefully tape to secure. Avoid pushing too hard on the stabilizer to prevent it from dislodging from the hoop.



- Return the hoop to the machine, be careful not to dislodge the fabric.
- Stitch Machine Step 14, Number 2 4 Feathers Back Cut Line & Tackdown.





STEP 20

- Remove the hoop from the machine, but NOT the project from the hoop.
- Turn the hoop over and carefully trim the excess fabric as close to the cut line as possible.



STEP 21

- Place the prepared applique fabrics for the Body, right side up, completely covering the placement stitch.
- Note: Match the bottom fabric to the fabric already placed on the top side of the hoop.
- Carefully tape to secure. Avoid pushing too hard on the stabilizer to prevent it from dislodging from the hoop.



STEP 22

 Stitch Machine Step 15, Body & Feather 6 Back Cut Line and Tackdown.





STEP 23

- Remove the hoop from the machine, but NOT the project from the hoop.
- Turn the hoop over and carefully trim the excess fabric as close to the cut line as possible.



STEP 24

- Return the hoop to the machine.
- Stitch Machine Steps 16-18, matching bobbin to top threads.



STEP 25

• When the design is complete, remove the project from the hoop and trim the stabilizer 1/4"- 1/2" outside the design.








STEP 26

• Hoop one layer of AquaMesh and one layer of BadgeMaster for all designs.



STEP 27

- Adhere two layers of StabilStick CutAway to the wrong side of all applique fabrics, to provide stiffness to the finished structure.
- Cut the prepared applique fabrics 1/4"-1/2" larger than the templates that are included at the end of the instructions.



- · Load selected design into the machine.
- Design in the example is 12666-03.
- Thread the machine per the thread chart, matching bobbin thread to the top thread throughout.
- Stitch Machine Step 1, Center Placement Stitch.





STEP 29

- Remove the hoop from the machine, but NOT the project from the hoop.
- · Lay the hoop on a flat surface.
- Place the prepared applique fabric, right side up, completely covering the placement stitch.
- Tape in place to secure.



STEP 30

- Return the hoop to the machine.
- Stitch Machine Step 2, Center Cut Line & Tackdown.



- Remove the hoop from the machine, but NOT the project from the hoop.
- Place the hoop on a flat surface.
- Trim the excess fabric as close to the cut line as possible. If the outermost stitches (cut line) are cut, the inner stitches (tackdown) will hold the applique in place.
- Tip: If the AquaMesh is cut or a hole is created while trimming the fabric, use OESD Expert Embroidery Tape WashAway as a patch.





STEP 32

- Return the hoop to the machine.
- Stitch Machine Step 3, Top & Bottom Placement Stitch.



STEP 33

- Remove the hoop from the machine, but NOT the project from the hoop.
- · Lay the hoop on a flat surface.
- Place the prepared applique fabric, right side up, completely covering the placement stitch.
- Tape in place to secure.



- Return the hoop to the machine.
- Stitch Machine Step 2, Top & Bottom Cut Line & Tackdown.





STEP 35

- Remove the hoop from the machine, but NOT the project from the hoop.
- · Place the hoop on a flat surface.
- Trim the excess fabric as close to the cut line as possible.



STEP 36

- Return the hoop to the machine.
- Stitch Machine Steps 5 and 6, matching bobbin to top threads.



STEP 37

• When the design is complete, remove the project from the hoop and trim the stabilizer 1/4"- 1/2" outside the design.



ASSEMBLY



STEP 38

- Rinse each piece in warm running water until the design is only slightly tacky.
- Place right side down on a non-stick surface to dry.
 Parchment paper or a cooling rack will prevent curling. Dry completely.
- Once dry, press right side down on a Perfect Embroidery Press Cloth.



STEP 39

• If the eyelets need to be punched, using the OESD Perfect Punch Tool fitted with the 2mm tip, punch out the eyelets on all Freestanding Dresden Turkey sections, designs number 12666-01, 12666-02, 12666-03, and 12666-04.



STEP 40

 Before assembly, use a utility knife to cut through all the layers of the tab entry for Turkey Body Left FSA (12666-03) and Turkey Body Right FSA (12666-04). Take care to not cut the satin stitching.



ASSEMBLY



STEP 41

 Assemble Turkey Tail Left FSA (12666-01) to Turkey Tail Right FSA (12666-02). Match the eyelets to the buttonettes. Pull each buttonette through the corresponding eyelet to the backside. Attach a button clip to hold the eyelet in place temporarily when needed.



STEP 42

 Assemble Turkey Wings FSA (12666-05) to Turkey Body Left and Right FSA (12666-03 & 12666-04). Match the four buttonettes on each wing to the four eyelets on each body. Pull each buttonette through the corresponding eyelet to the backside.



STEP 43

 Attach Turkey Body Left FSA (12666-03) to Turkey Body Right FSA (12666-04). Match the eyelets to the buttonettes. Pull each buttonette through the corresponding eyelet. Attach a button clip to hold the eyelet in place temporarily when needed.



ASSEMBLY



STEP 44

Attach Turkey Base FSA (12666-07) Turkey Body. Match the
eyelets to the buttonettes. Pull each buttonette through the
corresponding eyelet. Attach a button clip to hold the eyelet
in place temporarily when needed. Be sure the pointed ends
of the base face to the back of the turkey.



STEP 45

 Assemble the Turkey Head FSA (12666-06), pull each buttonette through the corresponding eyelet.



- Attach the Turkey Head FSA (12666-06) by pulling the tabs through the slits on the top of the Turkey Body.
- Note: After putting the tabs into the slots, twist them slightly to help them stay in place, or use Button Clips for a temporary hold.







STEP 47

• Attach the body and base to the tail. Match the eyelets to the buttonettes. Pull each buttonette through the corresponding eyelet.











Finishing Touches

- · Add tea lights or pixie lights to create a glow.
- Enjoy!





GENERAL FREESTANDING LACE GUIDE



Stabilizer

- OESD AquaMesh
- OESD BadgeMaster

Notions/Tools

- 80/12 Embroidery
 Ballpoint Titanium needle for extended needle life
- OESD Alligator Clamps
- OESD Button Clips
- OESD Perfect Point and Press Tool

Isacord Thread Colors

- All OESD designs are digitized with Isacord 40 wt. polyester thread as the top thread and in the bobbin.
- Refer to the thread chart for color specifications.
- Match bobbin thread color to the top thread.

Instructions

Step 1 - Hoop

For FSL structures, hoop one layer of OESD AquaMesh and one layer of OESD BadgeMaster. BadgeMaster contains more starch so, combined with the AquaMesh, the lace is more rigid. For other FSL, where a softer lace is desired, hoop two layers of AquaMesh.

Step 2 - Embroider

Stitch the design per the thread chart with matching thread in the bobbin at each color change.

When complete, remove from the hoop and trim away excess stabilizer about 1/4"-1/2" from the stitching.

Step 3 - Rinse

Rinse remaining stabilizer out in warm running water.

For stiffer lace and FSL structures, DO NOT rinse away all of the stabilizer. The lace should be just slightly tacky. For softer lace, rinse until all traces of the stabilizer are removed.

Step 4 - Dry

Lay right side down flat on a nonstick surface, such as a cooling rack, parchment paper or Teflon sheet. This minimizes the tendency for the lace to curl.

Let the pieces dry completely before proceeding with any assembly.

Step 5 - Press

Once completely dry, press right side down on a OESD Perfect Embroidery Press Cloth.

Step 6 - Assemble Structure

Note: Specific assembly instructions for a design/collection may be found in the thread chart pdf following the individual design color charts.

Lace must be COMPLETELY DRY before assembly. Wetting the buttonettes or eyelets to assemble is not recommended and may result in them stretching and coming "unbuttoned" when dry.

Use a pair of OESD Alligator Clamps to insert the buttonettes into the eyelets. Insert the tip of the OESD Alligator Clamps into the eyelet, grasp the buttonette and pull through the eyelet. Alternatively, use a stiletto or tweezers to push the buttonette through the eyelet.

Helpful Tips

Limp Lace

If the design is not stiff enough, press the lace pieces on the wrong side while applying spray starch. After ironing, spray again with starch and allow to dry completely. This will stiffen the lace pieces nicely and aid in construction. Or easily restiffen by diluting some stabilizer scraps in water (or use liquid starch) and dipping the item in the solution. Lay flat to dry.

Eyelets Too Small

If any of the eyelets appear closed or too small to penetrate with Alligator Clamps, they may be stretched by inserting the small end of the OESD Perfect Point and Press Tool into the eyelet opening and stretching it open wide enough to accommodate the OESD Alligator Clamps.

Button Clips


During the assembly process, some structures pull on buttonettes that have already been inserted and could pull them out altogether. Putting a Button Clip on the assembled buttonette will keep it in position during the assembly process. Remove the Button Clips when the assembly is complete.

Alternative Construction Option


In some cases, the buttonettes may be pulled to the inside of a project, instead of being visible on the outside. Insert the OESD Alligator Clamps through the eyelet from the wrong, or inside, of the lace and grasp the corresponding buttonette. Pull the buttonette to the wrong side of the lace.

Pulling the buttonettes to the inside may cause stress on the ones already done. Button clips may be placed on the completed buttonette(s) to prevent them from pulling out of the eyelet during construction.


























