Supplies

- OESD embroidery collection Stitch 'N' Turn Easter #12681
- Fabric: (2) 8" x 9" fabrics for each object
- OESD Polymesh Cut Away stabilizer
- Temporary spray adhesive
- Embroidery thread
- Embroidery machine
- Polyester fiberfill
- Hand needle



Stitch 'N' Turn Instructions

- Lightly spray together two layers of OESD Polymesh Cut Away stabilizer.
- Hoop two layers of OESD Polymesh Cut Away stabilizer. **Photo 1**
- Stitch the first color called *Placement Stitch*. Use a thread color that blends with your fabric choice. **Photo 2**
- Place the fabric (8" x 9") right side up onto the stabilizer, being sure that the *Placement Stitch* is covered by the fabric. Stitch the second color called the *Tackdown Stitch*. **Photo 3**
- Stitch the next few colors. **Photos 4 - 6**
- Place the second piece of fabric right side down directly over the first piece.
- Stitch the final color, again using the first thread color, called *Seam - Match Top Fabric*. **Photo 7**
- Remove the hoop from the machine and the fabric from the hoop.
- Using pinking shears, carefully cut out the stitch 'n' turn project close to the stitching line. Cut around the stitches at the opening to create a tab. **Photo 8**
- Clip corners as needed.
- Turn the project right side out. Use a point turner or chopstick to turn out corners and curves. **Photo 9**
- Stuff with polyester fiberfill.
 - NOTE:** For a smooth project, use small amounts of fiberfill instead of large pieces. The larger pieces appear lumpy.
- Fold tabs in and slip stitch the slit closed with a hand needle and small stitches.
