



Instructions

General Freestanding Lace Guidelines

Supplies:

Embroidery Thread:

- Use the same embroidery thread in the bobbin as the needle. **Needles:**
- Use an Organ 80/12 Titanium needle for extended needle life. **Stabilizer:**
- Use water-soluble stabilizer or film water-soluble stabilizer.

Handy Hints:

For Stiffer Lace:

- DO NOT rinse away all of the stabilizer for a "stiffer" lace.
 Note that the thread may appear a shade darker if stabilizer is not removed completely.
- If you happen to wash too much out, easily re-stiffen by diluting some stabilizer scraps in water and dipping the item in the solution.


For Very Soft Lace:

 Cut away excess stabilizer. Remove remaining stabilizer by rinsing under warm running water until all traces of the stabilizer are gone. Note: If lace should become too limp to work with, dissolve stabilizer scraps in warm water and apply to the lace.

Drying Lace:

The lace looks best when left to dry completely. Lay lace
piece with right side down to dry. This will minimize the
tendency for the lace to curl. Be sure to flatten the piece out
entirely and allow ample time to dry.

General Instructions

- 1. Hoop two layers of water-soluble stabilizer.
- Attach the hoop to the machine and select the design of your choice.
- 3. Stitch the design.
- 4. Remove the hoop from the machine and the design from the hoop. Trim excess stabilizer from the design.
- 5. Rinse away remaining stabilizer and allow it to dry.

Handy Hints:

For 3D Lace Projects:

- Rinsing out lace with very hot water can cause wrinkles in some fabrics after it has been embroidered. To prevent this, pre-shrink cotton fabric by washing it in warm water and drying it in a dryer.
- If item becomes too limp to work with, iron the appliqué pieces on the wrong side while applying spray starch. After ironing, spray again with starch and allow to dry completely. This will stiffen the lace pieces nicely and aid in construction.
- A pair of tweezers, hemostats, stiletto or a tiny crochet hook can be extremely helpful when inserting the buttonettes into the eyelets. (Please see **Diagram 1** for explanation of "buttonette" and "eyelet".)
- Insert the tip of the tweezers, hemostats or crochet hook into the eyelet, grasp the buttonette and pull through the eyelet.
 Or a stiletto could be used to push the buttonette through the eyelet.

General Freestanding Appliqué Guidelines

Supplies:

Embroidery Thread:

- Use the same embroidery thread in the bobbin as the needle.
 Needles:
- Use an Organ 80/12 Titanium needle for extended needle life. **Stabilizer:**
- Use water-soluble stabilizer or film water-soluble stabilizer.

General Appliqué Instructions

- 1. Hoop two layers of OESD AquaMesh Stabilizer.
- Attach the hoop to the machine and select the design of your choice.
- 3. Stitch the Placement Stitch. Photo 1
- 4. Place a piece of appliqué fabric over the Placement Stitch so that it is completely covered.
- 5. Stitch the Cut Line & Tackdown stitch.
- 6. Carefully cut away the excess appliqué fabric. Photo 2
- 7. Stitch the remainder of the design and repeat for any remaining pieces. **Photo 3**
- 8. Remove the hoop from the machine and the design from the hoop.
- 9. Trim excess stabilizer from the design.
- 10. Rinse away remaining stabilizer and allow it to dry face down to prevernt curling.


Handy Hints


Drying:

• Freestanding pieces look best when left to dry with right side down. This will minimize the tendency for a piece to curl. Be sure to flatten the piece out entirely and allow ample time to dry.

For 3D Appliqué Projects:

- Adhere 1 layer of OESD StabilStick TearAway to the back of appliqué fabrics with temporary adhesive spray BEFORE hooping or placing down for tackdown and cut in place. This gives fabric a more rigid structure.
- A pair of tweezers, hemostats, stiletto or a tiny crochet hook can be extremely helpful when inserting the buttonettes into the eyelets. (See **Diagram 1** for explanation of "buttonette" and "eyelet".)
- Insert the tip of the tweezers, hemostats or crochet hook into the eyelet, grasp the buttonette and pull through the eyelet. Or a stiletto could be used to push the buttonette through the eyelet.

Freestanding Bulb - Summary


Requires 5 Bulb Slice FSL – 12701-11 Requires 1 Bulb Base FSL – 12701-12 Requires 1 Bulb Inner Base FSL – 12701-13

Basic Instructions for Building a Bulb

- Assemble the Bulb Slice 12701-11 by connecting the six buttonettes to the six eyelets on the opposite side of each slice. Repeat this process five times to complete the bulb leaving the last two slices open and leaving the bottom 4 buttonettes undone. PHOTOS 1-6
- Next assemble the Bulb Base FSL 12701-12 and Bulb Inner Base FSL 12701-13 by pulling the Inner Base buttonettes 12701-13 through the eyelets of the Bulb Base 12701-12. Once completed close the Bulb Base 12701-12 with the two buttonettes and eyelets. PHOTOS 7-10
- Attach the completed Bulb Base to the Bulb. Using the Alligator Clamps go
 through the opening through the inside and pull the buttonettes through the eyelets of the bulb. Once completed close bulb on the four remaining buttonettes
 and eyelets. PHOTOS 11-12
- Bulb is complete.

- Requires 1 Box 1 Bottom FSA –12701-03
- Requires 2 Box 1 Bow Side FSA –12701-04
- Requires 1 Box 1 Bow Center FSA –12701-05

Basic Instructions for Building a Box

- Assemble two Box 1 Bow Side FSA 12701-04 by connecting the one buttonette through the one eyelet for each Bow Side. **Photo 13**
- Connect both Box 1 Bow Side FSA 12701-04 buttonettes to Box 1 Top FSA 12701-02 eyelets as show on Photos 14-15
- Connect Box 1 Bow Center FSA 12701-05 buttonettes into Box 1 Top FSA 12701-02 eyelets and going over both Box 1 Bow Sides 12701-04 into the other two eyelets on Box 1 Top FSA 12701-02 eyelets. **Photos 16-17**
- Insert buttonettes from one Box 1 Side FSA 12701-01 to the next eyelets of Box 1 Side. Continue in this manner until all four sides are connected to one another. **Photos 18-19**
- Connect Box 1 Top FSA 12701-02 buttonettes to top of Box 1 Side FSA 12701-01 eyelets and work around, connecting all four sides to the top. **Photos 20-23**
- Connect Box 1 Bottom FSA 12701-03 buttonettes to the bottom of the four sides of Box 1 Side FSA 12701-01 eyelets.

- Your Holiday Box is complete. Repeat identical format for creating Holiday Box 2.
