#12741 / 3 Designs

Note: Some designs in this collection may have been created using unique special stitches and/or techniques. To preserve design integrity when rescaling or rotating designs in your software, always rescale or rotate designs using the handles directly on-screen.



Beat egg yolks until they lighten in coton.

Gaodvally add 1/3 cup sugan and beat until dissolved.

Add milk, cnean, boundon and nutneg. Stin to combine.

Beat egg whites until soft peaks form.

With mixen still nunning, gradually add 1 tosp sugan
and beat until stiff peaks form.

Whish egg whites into mixtune. Chill and sente.



12741-01 Eggnog Recipe Towel 5.53 X 8.28 in. 140.46 X 210.31 mm 32.763 St.



In a bowl combine powdered sugar, butter, vanilla, almond extract and egg. Stir in all-purpose flour, baking soda and cream of tartar. Cotter and refrigerate for 2 hours. Heat over to 375 degrees. Roll dough to 1/4" thick on a lightly floured surface. Cut out shapes using cookie criters and place on lightly greased cookie sheet. Bake for 7-8 minutes or until edges are a light brown. Cool and serve.



12741-02 Sugar Cookie Recipe Towel

5.50 X 8.61 in. 139.70 X 218.69 mm 37.928 St.



In a heavy saucepan, on low heat, melt chocolate chips with sweetened condensed milk and salt. Remove from heat; stir in nuts and vanilla. Spread evenly into wax paper-lined 9" square pan. Chill 2 hours or until firm. Lift fudge out of pan and place onto cutting board. Remove paper and cut into squares.

Store covered in refrigerator.

Tea Towel Instructions

Supplies

- Tea towel
- Accent fabric
- OESD Ultra Clean and Tear stabilizer

Instructions

- 1. Prep towel. Wash, dry, and iron tea towel. Trim towel to 25" long, be sure to trim from the bottom to preserve your hanging loop at the top.
- 2. Prep accent fabric. Measure the width of your tea towel, add 1" to that measurement (a), cut a 6" x (measurement a). Fold fabric's short sides in 1/2" and press, now match raw edges of the long sides (wrong sides together), press well. Sew short sides closed (1/8" - 1/4" from the folded edge). PHOTOS 1 & 2
- 3. Sew fabric. Match raw edges of accent fabric to the right side of tea towel, sew using a ½" seam allowance. Finish edges with a zigzag, overlock, etc., press and topstitch on the towel. PHOTOS 3 & 4
- 4. Embroider towel. For this example, fold the towel in half and press to make a crease. I measured 3" from the bottom of the tea towel (not the accent fabric) to allow for fingertip/hand drying. Hoop using OESD Ultra Clean and Tear. After trimming threads, give your towel a final press using our Perfect Embroidery Press Cloth.

Tip: Use Ultra Clean & Tear instead of regular TearAway on woven fabrics with designs that have open spaces or lettering. Ultra Clean & Tear is partially water soluble and will fall apart when washing, leaving the supportive fibers under the design area.
