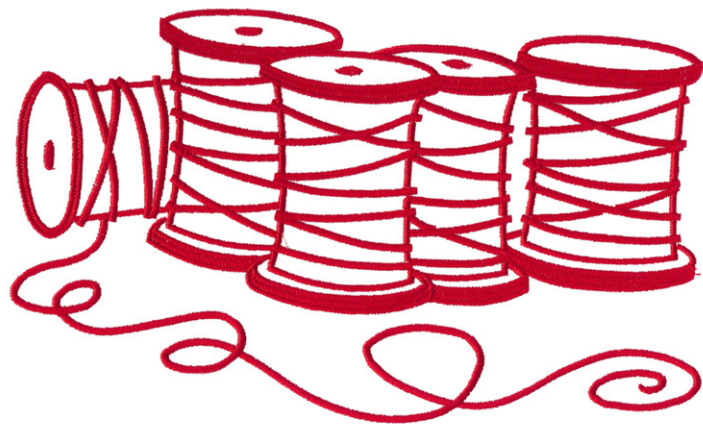

MATERIALS



Stabilizer

- OESD StabilStick Cutaway large enough for hoop
- OESD Fusible Woven - 23" x 11"

Fabric/Notions

- Cork – 23 ½" x 11"
- Fabric – 23" x 11" for lining
- Isacord Embroidery thread for design and construction
- OESD Bobbin Thread
- Chalk marker
- 505 Temporary Spray Adhesive
- Pinking blade rotary cutter or Pinking shears
- OESD Loop and Tail Wand (optional)
- **Note:** All supply measurements are for a standard composition notebook. Instructions on how to measure for another size of book are included.

Cork Journal Cover



INSTRUCTIONS



STEP 1

- Prepare the fabric by fusing Fusible Woven stabilizer to wrong side of lining fabric. Due to the permanent fuse, it will prevent fraying after project is complete.



STEP 2

- Fold cork in half to find center. This measurement should be approximately $11 \frac{3}{4}$ " from each side (if using the measurements from the supply list). There is a $\frac{1}{2}$ " seam on the edge and a $3 \frac{1}{2}$ " fold inside the cover to hold the notebook in place. The design should be centered between the middle mark of the cork and the mark for the fold.



STEP 3

- Use the marks to find the center of the journal front and mark on right side of cork fabric.

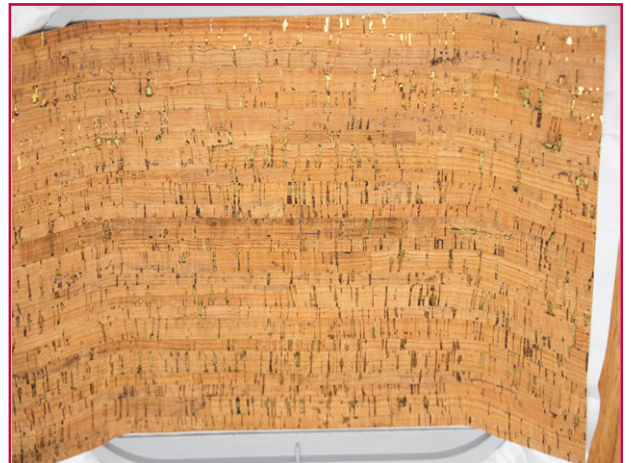
STEP 4

- Hoop StabilStick Cutaway paper side up. Score the paper with the Loop and Tail Wand. Remove protective paper to expose the adhesive surface.



STEP 5

- Position the cork onto the hooped stabilizer using centering marks and finger press into place.



STEP 6

- Embroider the design.

STEP 7

- Remove from hoop and trim cutaway stabilizer.



STEP 8

- Using spray adhesive, attach wrong side of lining fabric to wrong side of cork. Lining fabric will be about ¼" short on each side.



STEP 9

- Fold each short edges over ½".

STEP 10

- Next, sew to secure.



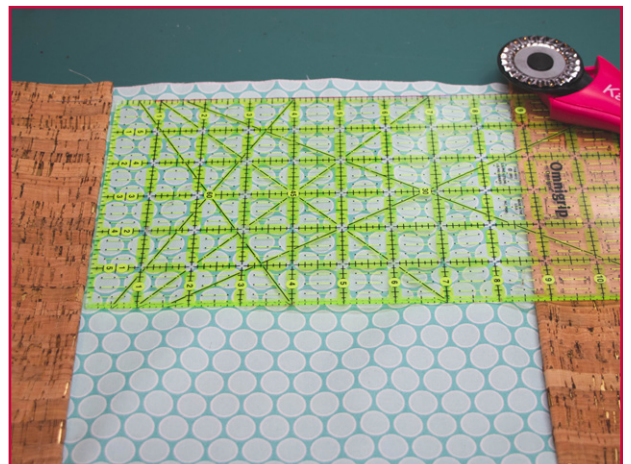
STEP 11

- Fold each short edge over 3 ½". Sew ½" across the top and bottom to secure in to place. The two lines of stitching should measure 10" apart.



STEP 12

- Line up ruler with ¼" marking on stitching line.

STEP 13

- Cut with rotary cutter using a pinking blade. If not available, use pinking shears.



STEP 14

- Slip notebook covers inside the flap. The journal cover is complete.



MEASUREMENTS



STEP 1

- Measure from one side of book to the other side with book closed. Add 8 inches for $\frac{1}{2}$ " inside hem and $3 \frac{1}{2}$ " folds on each side to hold book.



STEP 2

- Measure the notebook from top to bottom. Add 1" to allow for seam and space to trim with pinking blade.
