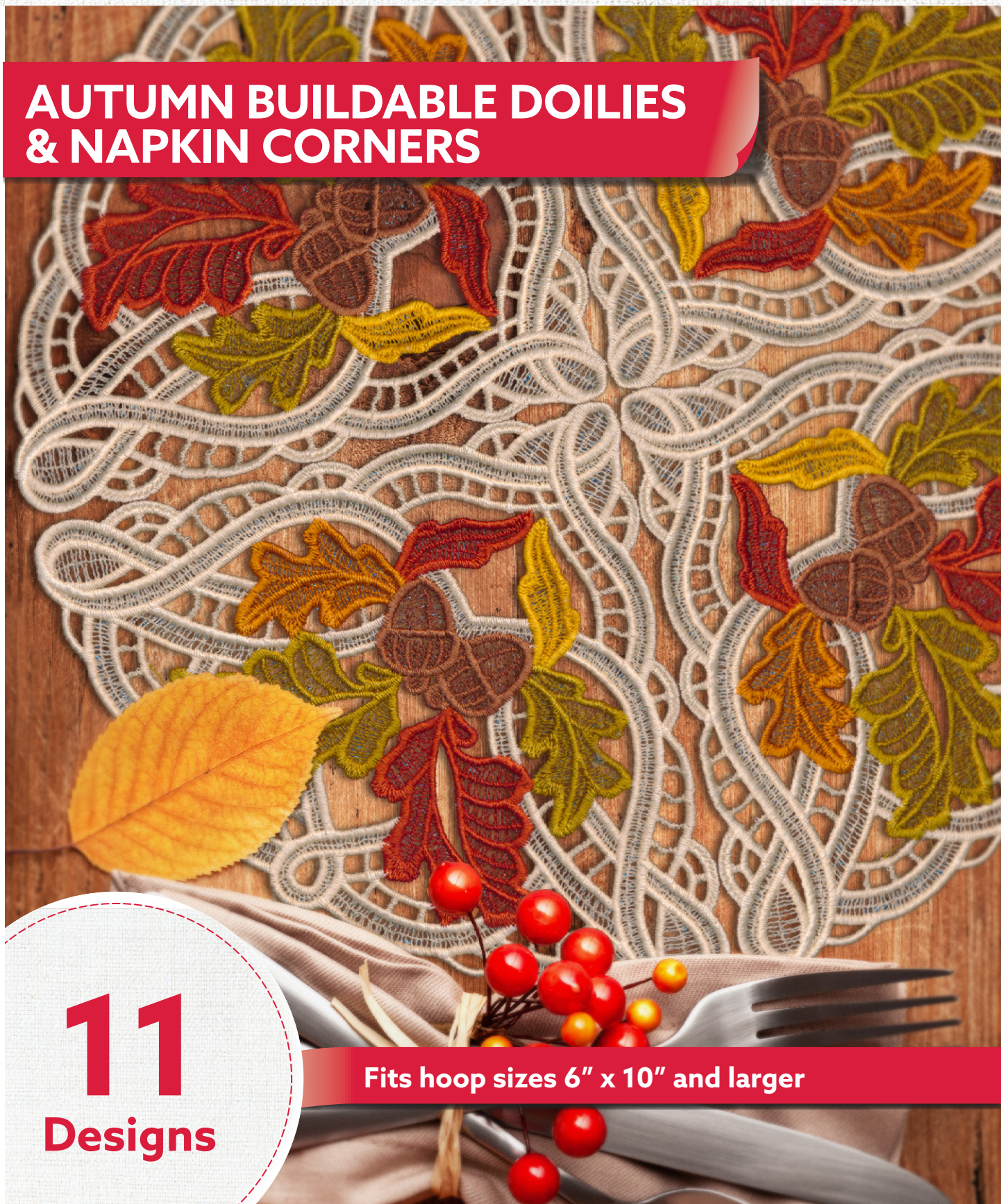



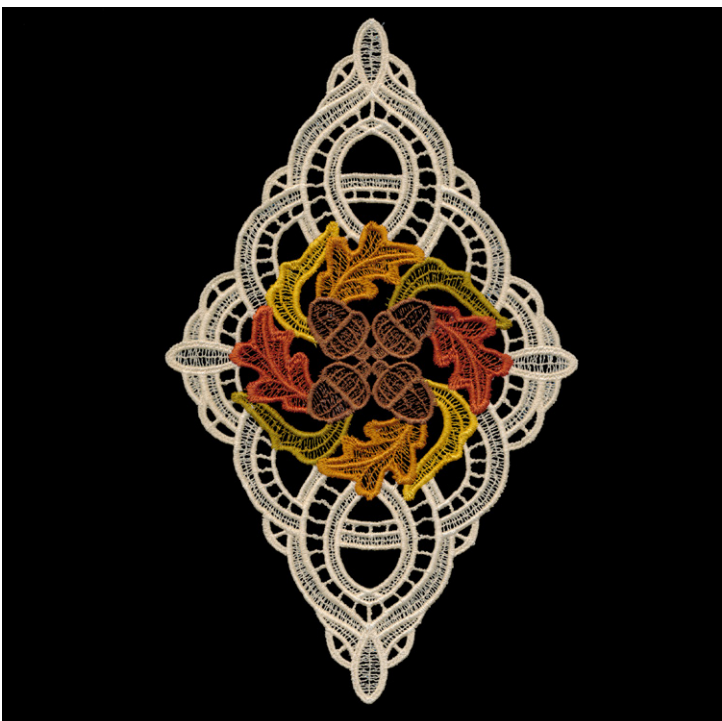

# COLLECTION SUPPLIES



## Stabilizer

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- OESD AquaMesh WashAway

## Supplies

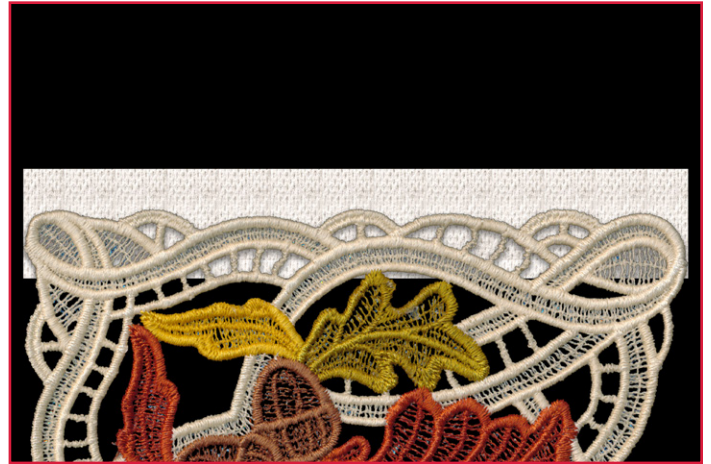
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- Isacord thread per thread chart
- Bobbin with matching Isacord thread
- OESD Expert Embroidery Tape WashAway (optional)
- OESD Perfect Embroidery Press Cloth
- Prepared lace pieces; rinsed, dried and pressed
- Napkins
- Tablecloths



## STEP 1

- Determine the right and wrong side of the lace shapes. Arrange the lace pieces in the desired shape.
- Place a piece of WashAway Tape under the edge of the connecting part of the design. Finger press to secure.



## STEP 2

- Connect an adjacent piece by lining up the “spokes” of the connecting parts of the design. Finger press to secure to the tape.



## STEP 3

- Continue assembling with tape until all pieces are placed.



## TIP

- For large, multi-piece assemblies, stitch the pieces together in small assemblies before joining all together.



## STEP 4

- Set the machine to a multi-step zig-zag stitch. This is often called a serpentine stitch, where the needle drops into the fabric multiple times while traveling from side to side. Set the stitch width to 4.0 mm. Set the stitch length to .25 mm. Install an open toe or clear foot to be able to see the stitches as they are sewn.



## STEP 5

- At the machine, begin the stitching just before the spoke, and stitch until it is connected to just past the spoke, approximately 1/8".
- **Note** – If using a knee lifter to raise the presser foot and don't use the automatic thread trimmer, it is a very quick process to go from one connecting stitch to the next. Thread will need to be trimmed if cut by a thread trimmer.

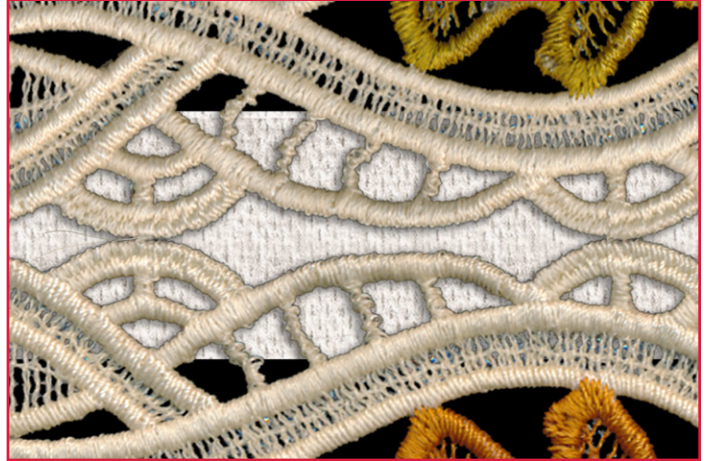


# EMBROIDERY



## STEP 6

- Once the connections have been sewn, trim excess threads on top and bottom.



## STEP 7

- For quick removal of the tape, dip a cotton swab in water and apply to the back of the stitches. Simply lift the tape away from the doily. There is no need to rinse the entire lace creation.

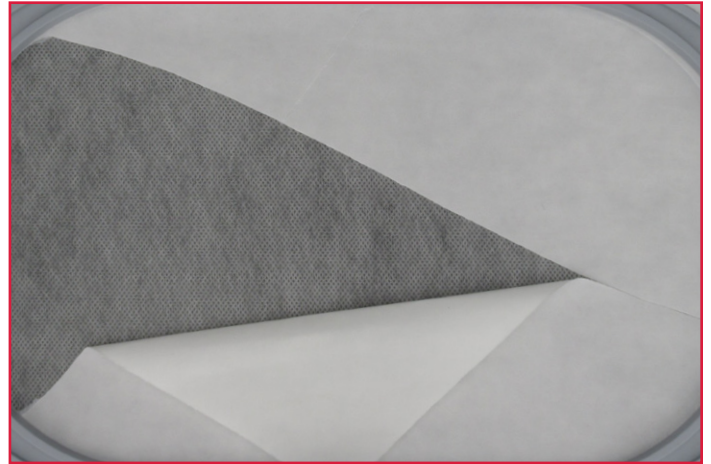


# NAPKINS



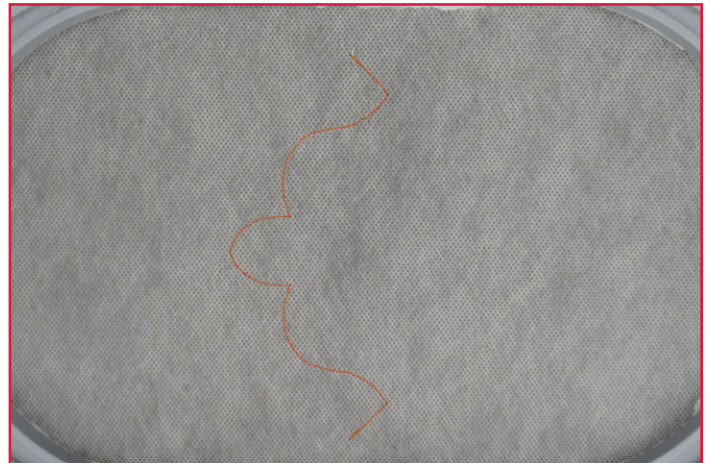
## STEP 1

- **Note:** Match bobbins to top threads.
- Hoop 1 sheet of AquaMesh Plus with the paper side up. Score and remove the paper from the hoop.



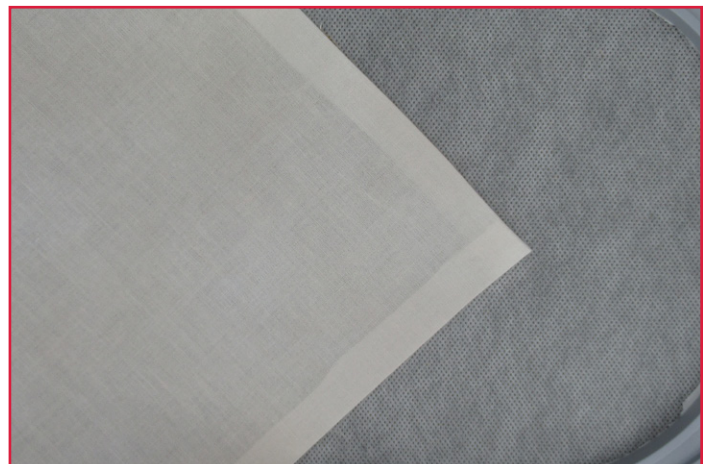
## STEP 2

- Stitch color 1, Fabric Corner Placement Stitch.



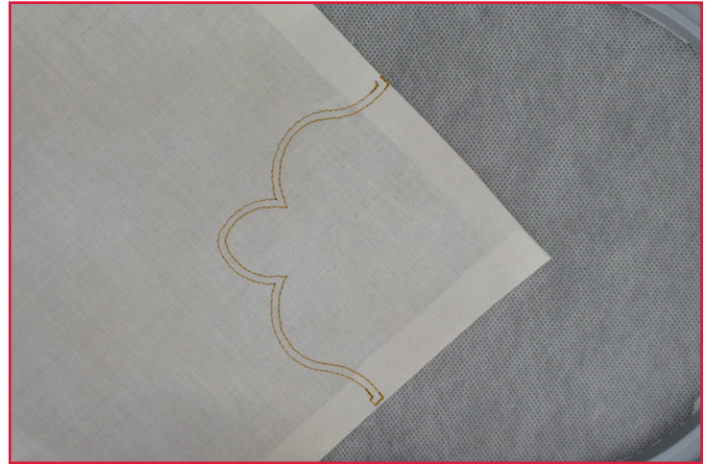
## STEP 3

- Place the napkin or tablecloth so the edges of one corner align with the placement line.



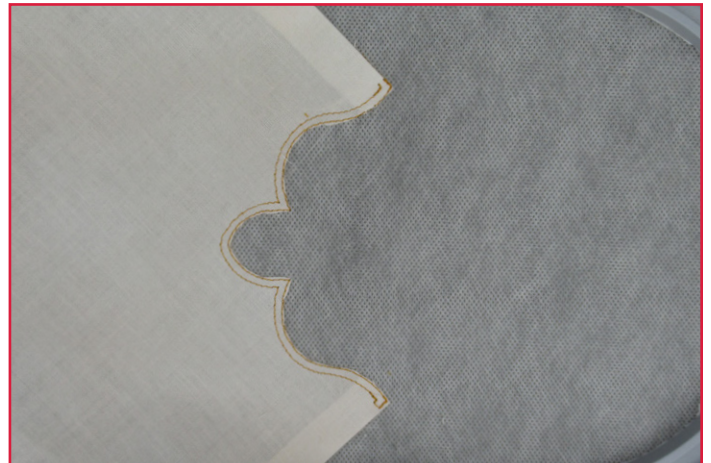
## STEP 4

- Stitch color 2, Cut Line and Tackdown.



## STEP 5

- Trim the corner of the napkin or tablecloth as closely as possible to the cut line. Be sure to trim on the side that will cut away the corner and leave the body intact.



## STEP 6

- Continue to match the bobbin to the top thread, sew the remaining colors of the design.

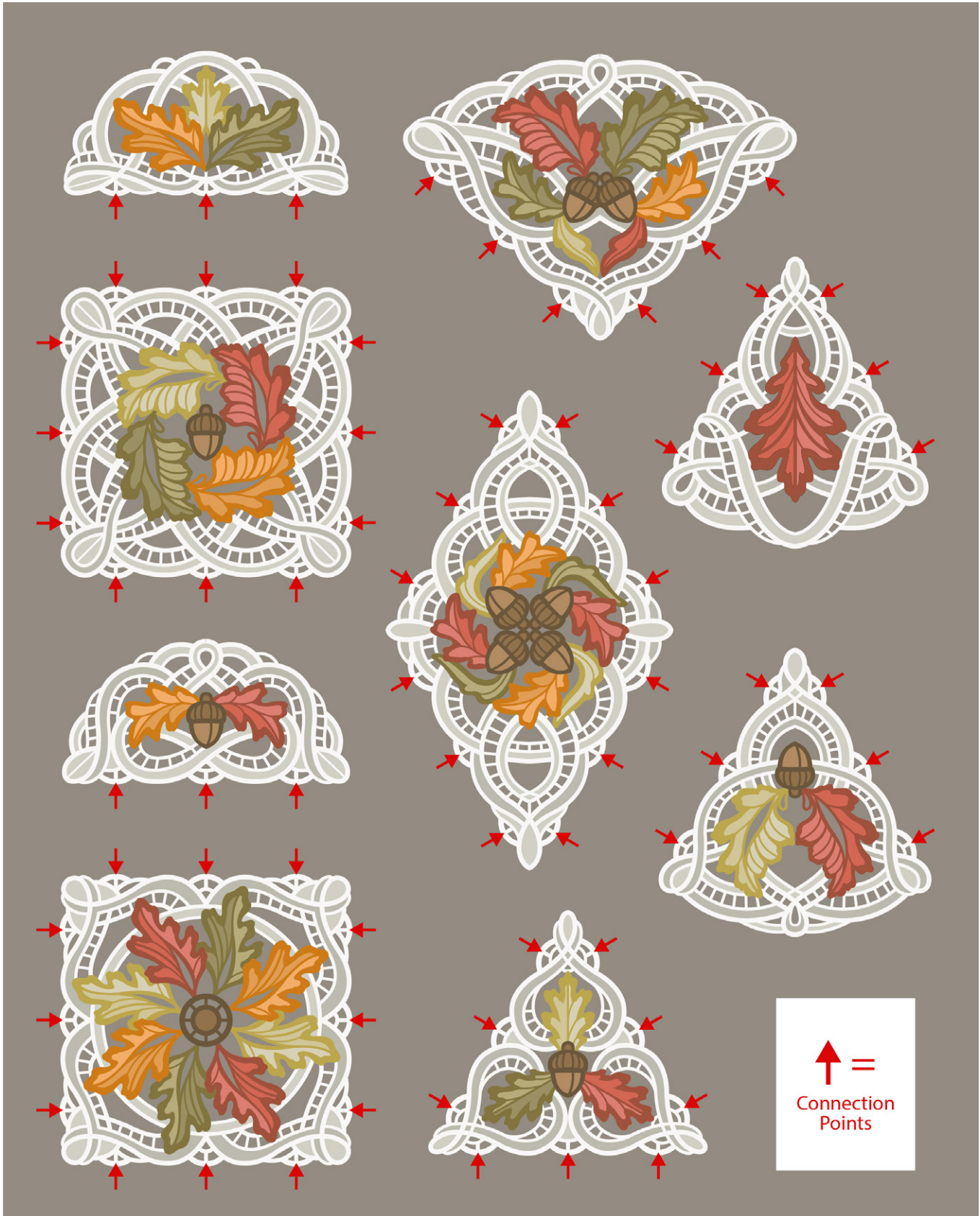


## STEP 7

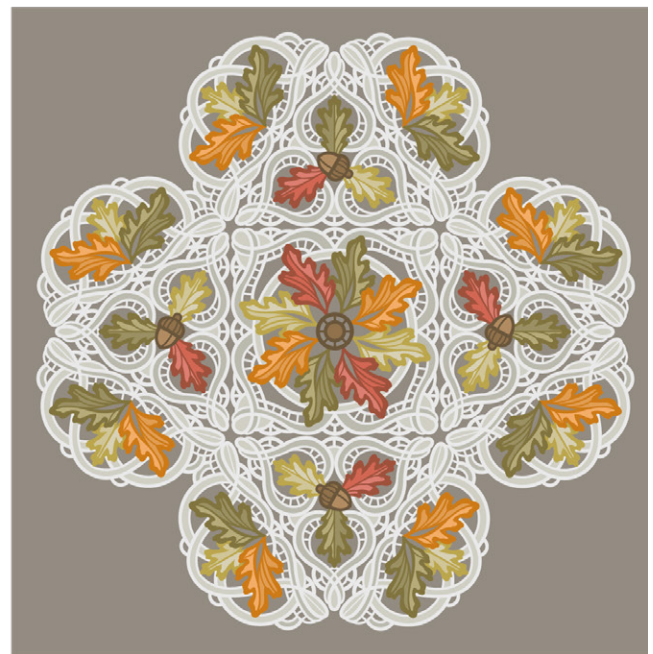
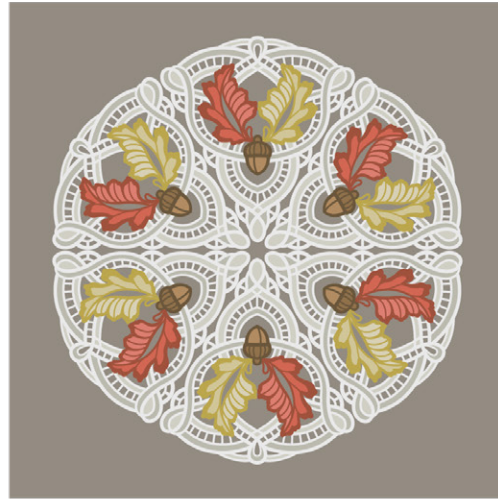
- Remove from hoop and trim the excess AquaMesh to ¼" from the outside of the design.
- Rinse away the remaining AquaMesh.
- Allow to dry, press and use.



# CONNECTION POINTS



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## General Freestanding Lace Guidelines

### Supplies:

#### Embroidery Thread:

- Use the same embroidery thread in the bobbin as the needle.

#### Needles:

- Use an Organ 80/12 Titanium needle for extended needle life.

#### Stabilizer:

- Use OESD AquaMesh stabilizer.

### Handy Hints:

#### For Stiffer Lace:

- DO NOT rinse away all of the stabilizer for a “stiffer” lace. Note that the thread may appear a shade darker if stabilizer is not removed completely.
- If you happen to wash too much out, easily re-stiffen by diluting some stabilizer scraps in water and dipping the item in the solution.

#### For Very Soft Lace:

- Cut away excess stabilizer. Remove remaining stabilizer by rinsing under warm running water until all traces of the stabilizer are gone. **NOTE:** If lace should become too limp to work with, dissolve stabilizer scraps in warm water and apply to the lace.

#### Drying Lace:

- The lace looks best when left to dry completely. Lay lace piece with right side down to dry. This will minimize the tendency for the lace to curl. Be sure to flatten the piece out entirely and allow ample time to dry.

### General Instructions

1. Hoop two layers of OESD AquaMesh Stabilizer.
2. Attach the hoop to the machine and select the design of your choice.
3. Stitch the design.
4. Remove the hoop from the machine and the design from the hoop. Trim excess stabilizer from the design.
5. Rinse away remaining stabilizer and allow it to dry.
