

## Supplies

- StabilStick Template Sheets
- 40 wt. Isacord thread in machine and bobbin
- 80/12 Embroidery Ballpoint Titanium needle for extended needle life
- OESD Tea Towel in White
- OESD Expert Embroidery Press Cloth
- Optional: Expert Embroidery Tape WashAway





## STEP 1

## **Continuous Borders**

- Hoop 1 layer of AquaMesh Plus paper(shiny) side up.
- Score with a needle or pin and remove the paper to reveal the adhesive surface.
- Attach the hoop and select the desired design.
- Design used in instructions is 12866-06.



## STEP 2


• Stitch Machine Step 1, The Placement Stitch.





## STEP 3

- Remove the hoop from the machine, but NOT the project from the hoop.
- Lay on a flat surface.
- Mark the center lower edge of the towel.
- Place the towel edge along the placement stitch, matching the center mark with the center of the towel.
- Finger press in place.



- Return the hoop to the machine.
- Remember to check that the towel is not under the hoop!
- Stitch Machine Step 2, Lace and Cover Stitch.





## STEP 5

• Stitch Machine Step 3, Cut Line and Tackdown.



- Remove the hoop from the machine, but NOT the project from the hoop.
- Lay on a flat surface.
- Carefully trim the inner circle of fabric away from the towel.
- Tip: If the AquaMesh Plus is cut or a hole is created while trimming the fabric. Simply use OESD Expert Embroidery Tape WashAway or AquaMesh Plus as a patch.






## STEP 7

- Return the hoop to the machine.
- Remember to check that the towel is not under the hoop!
- Stitch machine Step 4, Lace and Cover Stitch.
- Remove the hoop from the machine and the project from the hoop.
- Trim excess stabilizer 1/4"-1/2" from the design.



- Use software to print a template onto a sheet of StabilStick Template material. Print at 100% (1:1), following the package instructions. Each template includes a 1" square to ensure the printed size is correct.
- Trim most of the excess paper from around the template.
- Peel the paper backing from the template.
- Place the template next to the first stitch out.
- Tip: Save the paper backing as this template is reusable.







## STEP 9

- Hoop 1 layer of AquaMesh Plus paper(shiny) side up.
- Score with a needle or pin and remove the paper to reveal the adhesive surface.
- Attach the hoop and continue using design 12866-06.



## STEP 10

• Stitch Machine Step 1, The Placement Stitch.





## STEP 11

- Remove the hoop from the machine, but NOT the project from the hoop.
- Lay on a flat surface.
- Place the towel edge along the placement stitch, matching the center mark with the center of the template.
- Finger press in place.
- Remove the template from the towel.





- Return the hoop to the machine.
- Remember to check that the towel is not under the hoop!
- Stitch Machine Step 2, Lace and Cover Stitch.





## STEP 13

• Stitch Machine Step 3, Cut Line and Tackdown.



- Remove the hoop from the machine, but NOT the project from the hoop.
- Lay on a flat surface.
- Carefully trim away the inner circle of fabric from the towel.
- Tip: If the AquaMesh Plus is cut or a hole is created while trimming the fabric. Simply use OESD Expert Embroidery Tape WashAway or AquaMesh Plus as a patch.





## STEP 15

- Return the hoop to the machine.
- Remember to check that the towel is not under the hoop!
- Stitch machine Step 4, Lace and Cover Stitch.



- Remove the hoop from the machine and the design from the hoop. Trim excess stabilizer 1/4"-1/2" from the design.
- Follow the previous instructions until all the borders are sewn.
- Rinse remaining stabilizer under warm running water.
- For very soft lace, rinse under warm running water until all traces of the stabilizer are gone and the item is no longer sticky.
- Lay flat, right side down on a non-stick surface, such as a cooling rack, parchment paper or Teflon sheet. This minimizes the tendency for the lace to curl. Flatten the piece out entirely and allow ample time to dry.
- Once dry, press right side down on a Perfect Embroidery Press Cloth.







## STEP 1


## **Border Medallions Construction**

- Hoop 1 layer of AquaMesh Plus paper(shiny) side up.
- Score with a needle or pin and remove the paper to reveal the adhesive surface.
- Attach the hoop and continue using design 12866-12.



## STEP 2

• Stitch Machine Step 1, The Placement Stitch.





## STEP 3

- Remove the hoop from the machine, but NOT the project from the hoop.
- Lay on a flat surface.
- Mark the center edge of the towel. Fold towel in half lengthwise, right sides together.
- Place the towel edge along the placement stitch, matching the center mark with the center of the towel.
- Unfold the towel and finger press in place.





- Return the hoop to the machine.
- Remember to check that the towel is not under the hoop!
- Stitch Machine Step 2, the Cut Line and Tackdown stitch.





## STEP 5

- Remove the hoop from the machine, but NOT the project from the hoop.
- Lay on a flat surface.
- Carefully trim away the lower edge of the towel.
- Tip: If the AquaMesh Plus is cut or a hole is created while trimming the fabric. Simply use OESD Expert Embroidery Tape WashAway or AquaMesh Plus as a patch.



- Return the hoop to the machine.
- Remember to check that the towel is not under the hoop!
- Stitch machine Step 4, Lace and Cover Stitch.





## STEP 7

• Remove the hoop from the machine and the design from the hoop. Trim excess stabilizer 1/4"-1/2" from the design.



- Rinse remaining stabilizer under warm running water.
- For very soft lace, rinse under warm running water until all traces of the stabilizer are gone and the item is no longer sticky.
- Lay flat, right side down, on a non-stick surface, such as a cooling rack, parchment paper or Teflon sheet.
   This minimizes the tendency for the lace to curl. Flatten the piece out entirely and allow ample time to dry.
- Once dry, press right side down on a Perfect Embroidery Press Cloth.
