*The applique instructions included in the design pack are general instructions for the collection. For demonstration purposes, a sample design that best represents the entire collection is shown. Fabric and thread requirements will vary by design, but the general technique will be the same.



STEP 1

 Prep the front and back applique fabrics with one layer of StabilStick CutAway.




STEP 2

- All designs are stitched with matching thread in the top and bobbin.
- Hoop one layer of OESD AquaMesh and one layer of OESD BadgeMaster in the hoop for all designs.



- Load selected design into the machine.
- Design in the example is 02.
- Thread the machine per the thread chart.
- Stitch Machine Step 1, Tan Fabric Placement Stitch.





STEP 4

- Remove the hoop from the machine, but NOT the project from the hoop.
- Lay the hoop on a flat surface.
- Place the fabric right side up, covering the placement line completely.
- Tape in place to secure with OESD Tape TearAway.



STEP 5

- Turn the hoop over and place the bottom fabric right side up covering the placement stitch.
- Carefully tape to secure. Avoid pushing too hard on the stabilizer to prevent it from dislodging from the hoop.



- Return the hoop to the machine.
- Stitch Machine Step 2, Cut Line and Tackdown.





STEP 7

- Remove the hoop from the machine, but NOT the project from the hoop.
- Trim the excess fabric as close to the tackdown stitching as possible. If the outermost stitches are cut, the inner stitches will still hold the applique in place.
- Tip: If the AquaMesh is cut or a hole is created while trimming the fabric. Use OESD Expert Embroidery Tape WashAway as a patch.




STEP 8

• Turn the hoop over and repeat step 7 on the back applique.



- Return the hoop to the machine and stitch the remaining steps according to the thread chart.
- Remember to match the bobbin thread to the upper thread colors.





STEP 10

• When design is complete, remove the project from the hoop and trim the stabilizer 1/4"- 1/2" outside the design.




- Rinse away stabilizer with warm running water. Lay flat face down on a non-stick surface to dry.
- Let dry completely. Press each piece, right side down, on OESD Perfect Embroidery Press Cloth.
- Set aside.






STEP 1

• Prep the front and back applique fabrics with one layer of StabilStick CutAway.



STEP 2

- All designs are stitched with matching thread in the top and bobbin.
- Hoop one piece of AquaMesh and one piece of BadgeMaster in the hoop for all designs.




- Load selected design into the machine.
- Design in the example is 12.
- Thread the machine per the thread chart.
- Stitch Machine Step 1, Green Fabric Placement Stitch.





STEP 4

- Remove the hoop from the machine, but NOT the project from the hoop. Lay the hoop on a flat surface.
- Cover the placement line completely with the prepared top fabric.
- Tape in place to secure.



STEP 5

- Turn the hoop over and place the bottom fabric right side up covering the placement stitch.
- Carefully tape to secure. Avoid pushing too hard on the stabilizer to prevent it from dislodging from the hoop.




- Return the hoop to the machine.
- Stitch Machine Step 2, Cut Line and Tackdown.





STEP 7

- Remove the hoop from the machine, but NOT the project from the hoop.
- Trim the excess fabric as close to the tackdown stitching as possible. If the outermost stitches are cut, the inner stitches will still hold the applique in place.



STEP 8

• Turn the hoop over and repeat step 7 on the back applique.



- Return the hoop to the machine and stitch the remaining machine steps according to the thread chart.
- Remember to match the bobbin thread to the upper thread colors.





STEP 10

• When design is complete, remove the project from the hoop and trim the stabilizer 1/4"- 1/2" outside the design.



ASSEMBLY



STEP 1

- Rinse each piece in warm running water until the design is only slightly sticky.
- Lay face down on a non-stick surface to dry. Parchment paper or a cooling rack work well. This prevents the piece from curling.



STEP 2

 Press each piece, right side down, on a Perfect Embroidery Press Cloth.



- Before assembly, take a utility knife and cut through all the layers of the 18 ribbon entry points on the 3 FSA handle pieces. Take care to not cut the satin stitching.
- Refer to the Cutting Tool Guides on page 23 for cutting guidelines.



ASSEMBLY




STEP 4

- Use the 3mm attachment, punch holes in the eyelets on both Basket Side 2 FSA pieces.
- Refer to the Cutting Tool Guides on page 23 for cutting guidelines.




STEP 5

- Lay the basket pieces out as shown with the sides face up and the floor face down. Make sure matching sides are opposite of each other.
- Load the sewing machine with matching thread in the top and bobbin. An open toe or edge stitch foot is helpful.
- Stitch together using a multi-step zigzag stitch or a zigzag stitch. Back stitch and the beginning and end to secure. Trim thread tails.



- Match the 12 eyelets and buttonettes as shown. Pull each buttonette
 through the corresponding eyelet, using button clips to temporarily
 hold them in place, as needed.
- The right side of the basket side pieces should show on the outside of the assembled basket.








STEP 7

- To assemble the handle, arrange the 3 handle pieces face up as shown with the 2 buttonettes on the ends.
- Zig-zag together as shown using a tighter zig-zag stitch, 3.5mm width and 1.25mm length.



STEP 8

- After stitching the 3 handle pieces together, weave the 20" ribbon through the handle openings as shown.
- Tip: Cut the ends of the ribbon with pinking shears to reduce fraying.



STEP 9

• Weave the 24" ribbon through the vertical openings along the basket brim, trim as shown in picture. Ribbon ends will be hidden by the handle in a later step.



ASSEMBLY



STEP 10

- With the right side facing outwards, weave the handle through the 2 horizontal openings on one of the basket sides with an eyelet.
- Connect the button and curl the handle over and repeat on the other side. Your ribbon ends should now be hidden under the handle.








- Each freestanding accent piece in the collection has 2 buttonettes.
- To attach these accent pieces, use tweezers or alligator clamps and pull one of the buttonettes through the inside of the basket as shown. Repeat this process for the other buttonette.

Isacord Thread Colors

- All OESD designs are digitized with Isacord 40 wt. polyester thread as the top thread and in the bobbin.
- Refer to the thread chart for color specifications.
- Match bobbin thread color to the top thread.

Instructions

Step 1 - Hoop

For FSL structures, hoop one layer of OESD AquaMesh and one layer of OESD BadgeMaster. BadgeMaster contains more starch so, combined with the AquaMesh, the lace is more rigid. For other FSL, where a softer lace is desired, hoop two layers of AquaMesh.

Step 2 - Embroider

Stitch the design per the thread chart with matching thread in the bobbin at each color change.

When complete, remove from the hoop and trim away excess stabilizer about 1/4"-1/2" from the stitching.

Step 3 - Rinse

Rinse remaining stabilizer out in warm running water.

For stiffer lace and FSL structures, DO NOT rinse away all of the stabilizer. The lace should be just slightly tacky. For softer lace, rinse until all traces of the stabilizer is removed.

Step 4 - Dry

Lay right side down flat on a nonstick surface, such as a cookie rack, parchment paper or Teflon sheet. This minimizes the tendency for the lace to curl.

Let the pieces dry completely before proceeding with any assembly.

Step 5 - Press

Once completely dry, press right side down on a OESD Perfect Embroidery Press Cloth.

Step 6 - Assemble Structure

Note: Specific assembly instructions for a design/collection may be found in the thread chart pdf following the individual design color charts.

Lace must be COMPLETELY DRY before assembly. Wetting the buttonettes or eyelets to assemble is not recommended and may result in them stretching and coming "unbuttoned" when dry.

Use a pair of OESD Alligator Clamps to insert the buttonettes into the eyelets. Insert the tip of the OESD Alligator Clamps into the eyelet, grasp the buttonette and pull through the eyelet. Alternatively, use a stiletto or tweezers to push the buttonette through the eyelet.

Helpful Tips

Limp Lace

If the design is not stiff enough, press the lace pieces on the wrong side while applying spray starch. After ironing, spray again with starch and allow to dry completely. This will stiffen the lace pieces nicely and aid in construction. Or easily restiffen by diluting some stabilizer scraps in water (or use liquid starch) and dipping the item in the solution. Lay flat to dry.

Eyelets Too Small

If any of the eyelets appear closed or too small to penetrate with Alligator Clamps, they may be stretched by inserting the small end of the OESD Perfect Point and Press Tool into the eyelet opening and stretching it open wide enough to accommodate the OESD Alligator Clamps.

Button Clips

During the assembly process, some structures pull on buttonettes that have already been inserted and could pull them out altogether. Putting a Button Clip on the assembled buttonette will keep it in position during the assembly process. Remove the Button Clips when the assembly is complete.

Alternative Construction Option

In some cases, the buttonettes may be pulled to the inside of a project, instead of being visible on the outside. Insert the OESD Alligator Clamps through the eyelet from the wrong, or inside, of the lace and grasp the corresponding buttonette. Pull the buttonette to the wrong side of the lace.

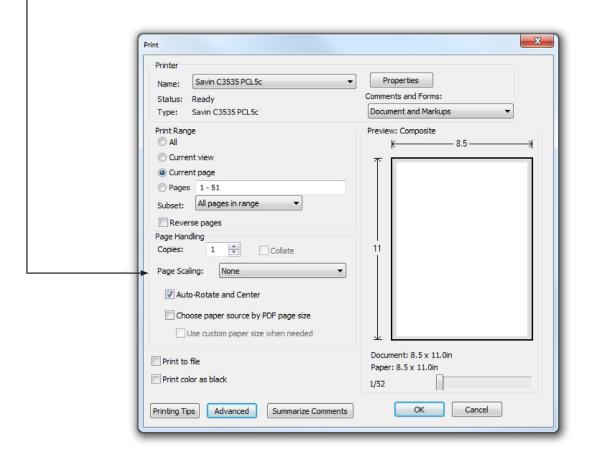
Pulling the buttonettes to the inside may cause stress on the ones already done. Button clips may be place on the completed buttonette(s) to prevent them from pulling out of the eyelet.
