



- OESD Fiber Form 8 pieces 7½" x 6 ½"
- Note: Fabric sizes are estimates and may result in overage.




This wreath can be sewn in any variation of 8 sections. The wreath shown requires the following designs.

- Requires 1 Big Flower Wreath Section FSA- 12876-01
- Requires 1 Daisy Wreath Section FSA- 12876-02
- Requires 1 Damask Wreath Section FSA- 12876-03
- Requires 1 Stipple Wreath Section FSA- 12876-04
- Requires 1 Swirl Floral Wreath Section FSA- 12876-05
- Requires 1 Butterfly Wreath Section FSA- 12876-06
- Requires 1 Vine Wreath Section FSA- 12876-07
- Requires 1 Plaid Wreath Section FSA- 12876-08

Final Dimensions: Approx. 17 ¾" x 17 ¾"







## NOTE

- The applique instructions included in the design pack are general instructions for the collection. For demonstration purposes, a sample design that best represents the entire collection is shown. Example design is 12876-01. Fabric and thread requirements will vary by design, but the general technique will be the same.
- All designs are stitched with matching thread in the top and bobbin.
- Note: Some thread colors in instructions have been changed or digitally enhanced for better visibility.

### STEP 1

 Hoop one layer of AquaMesh Plus, paper side up. Score the paper and remove to expose the adhesive surface.



- Print the template provided (100% or 1:1 ratio).
- Roughly cut around the printed applique template.






### STEP 3

- Attach the template to the Fiber Form using temporary spray adhesive.
- Cut out the Fiber Form piece on the outer edge of the black outline and set aside.



### STEP 4

- Load selected design into the machine.
- Design in the example is 12876-01.
- Thread the machine per the thread chart matching top and bobbin.
- Stitch Machine Step 1, Fiber Form/Front and Back Fabric Placement Stitch.



- Remove the hoop from the machine, but NOT the project from the hoop. Lay the hoop on a flat surface.
- Place the Fiber Form piece directly over the placement line.
- Finger press to secure to the adhesive surface.





## STEP 6

- Place the front applique fabric on top of the Fiber Form covering it completely.
- Smooth fabric over the Fiber Form and finger press to secure it to the adhesive surface.



### STEP 7

- Turn the hoop over and place the back applique fabric right side up covering the placement stitch.
- Carefully tape to secure. Avoid pushing too hard on the stabilizer to prevent it from dislodging from the hoop.



- Return the hoop to the machine.
- Stitch Machine Step 2, Cut Line and Tackdown.





## STEP 9

- Remove the hoop from the machine, but NOT the project from the hoop.
- Trim the excess fabric as close to the tackdown stitching as possible.
  If the outermost stitches are cut, the inner stitches will still hold the applique in place.
- Tip: If the AquaMesh is cut or a hole is created while trimming the fabric, simply use OESD Expert Embroidery Tape WashAway or AquaMesh Plus as a patch.



## **STEP 10**

• Turn the hoop over and trim the excess fabric as close to the tackdown stitching as possible. If the outermost stitches are cut, the inner stitches will still hold the applique in place.



#### STEP 11

• Finger press OESD BadgeMaster to the OESD AquaMesh Plus to secure to AquaMesh Plus or tape to secure.





## STEP 12

- Return the hoop to the machine and stitch the remaining colors according to the thread chart.
- Remember to match the bobbin thread to the upper thread colors throughout.



## **STEP 13**

• When design is complete, remove the project from the hoop and trim the stabilizer 1/4"- 1/2" outside the design.




## **ASSEMBLY**



#### STEP 1

- Rinse each piece in warm running water until the design is only slightly sticky.
- Lay face down on a non-stick surface to dry. Parchment paper or a cooling rack work well. This prevents the piece from curling.




## STEP 2

 Press each piece, right side down, on a Perfect Embroidery Press Cloth.



### STEP 3

• Connect an adjacent piece by lining up the sides of the connecting parts of the design right side face down. Finger press WashAway tape to secure the two together.



## **ASSEMBLY**



#### STEP 4

• Continue taping two sections together until there are four sections.



### STEP 5

- Thread the sewing machine with matching thread or monofilament (invisible) thread in the top and bobbin.
- With right sides up, stitch together using a multi-step zigzag stitch (also known as a serpentine stitch). Set the stitch width to 3.5 mm. Set the stitch length to 2.5 mm.
- Back stitch at the beginning and end to secure.
- Trim thread tails.
- Tip: An open toe or edge stitch foot is helpful.



- Continue sewing wreath sections until the wreath is complete.
- For quick removal of the tape, dip a cotton swab in water and apply to the back of the stitches. Simply lift the tape away from the design parts. There is no need to rinse the entire wreath.
- Lay flat to allow any damp parts to dry.




## ATTENTION

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#### **TO SAVE PAPER**


Only print the desired image by navigating to the image's page, go to File > Print and select "Current page" in the print dialog box. Repeat for each desired image.
