Notes

The freestanding applique instructions, included in the collection, are general instructions. For demonstration purposes, a sample design that best demonstrates the technique is shown. Fabric and thread requirements will vary by design, but the general technique is the same.

All designs are stitched with matching thread, top and bobbin.

Note: Some thread colors in instructions have been changed or digitally enhanced for better visibility.


STEP 1

 Hoop one layer of AquaMesh and one layer of BadgeMaster for all designs.



STEP 2


- Adhere one layer of StabilStick CutAway to the wrong side of all applique fabrics, to provide stiffness to the finished structure.
- Note: The structure interior is finished with an interior lining fabric. Since this is a double-sided applique only 1 layer of StabilStick per applique fabric is needed to provide stiffness to the structure.






STEP 3

- · Load selected design into the machine.
- Example design is 12899-09.
- Thread the machine per the thread chart.
- Stitch Machine Step 1, Front and Back Fabric Placement Stitch.



STEP 4

- Remove the hoop from the machine, but NOT the project from the hoop.
- · Lay the hoop on a flat surface.
- Completely cover the placement stitch with the prepared fabric.
- Tape in place to secure.



STEP 5


- Turn the hoop over and place the prepared fabric, right side up, completely covering the placement stitch.
- Carefully tape to secure. Avoid pushing too hard on the stabilizer to prevent it from dislodging from the hoop.





STEP 6

- · Return the hoop to the machine.
- Stitch Machine Step 2, Cut Line and Tackdown.



STEP 7

- Remove the hoop from the machine, but NOT the project from the hoop.
- Trim the excess fabric as close to the cut line as possible. If the outermost stitches (cut line) are cut, the inner stitches (tackdown) will still hold the applique in place.
- Tip: If the AquaMesh is cut or a hole is created while trimming the fabric, use OESD Expert Embroidery Tape WashAway as a patch.



STEP 8


 Turn the hoop over and trim the excess fabric as close to the cut line as possible. If the outermost stitches (cut line) are cut, the inner stitches (tackdown) will still hold the applique in place.





STEP 9

- · Return the hoop to the machine.
- Stitch Machine Step 3, Cover Stitch.



STEP 10

• When the design is complete, remove the project from the hoop and trim the stabilizer 1/4"- 1/2" outside the design.


STEP 11

- Rinse each piece in warm running water until the design is only slightly tacky.
- Lay right side down on a non-stick surface to dry. Parchment paper or a cooling rack work well to prevent curling. Dry completely.
- Once dry, press right side down on a Perfect Embroidery Press Cloth.



STEP 12

- To connect, line up the pieces, right sides up.
- Thread the sewing machine with matching thread in the top and bobbin.
- Stitch together using a multi-step zigzag stitch (also known as a serpentine stitch). Back stitch at the beginning and end to secure. Trim thread tails.
- TIP: An open toe or edge stitch foot is helpful.






ASSEMBLY



STEP 13

• Match the eyelets to the buttonettes. Pull each buttonette through the corresponding eyelet. If needed, attach a button clip to temporarily hold the buttonette in place.



STEP 14

• To close the lid, fold the two rounded tops inward.







STEP 15

• Fold the two half heart lids inward, bending slightly to slide the pair together.

• The Freestanding Heart Gift Boxes are complete. Enjoy!





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


TO SAVE PAPER

Only print the desired image by navigating to the image's page, go to File > Print and select "Current page" in the print dialog box. Repeat for each desired image.












Print at 100%. No scaling. This box measures 1" x 1". Use the box as an accuracy guide when printing templates.
