



### Notes

The Hot Handle Wrap instructions, included in the collection, are general instructions. For demonstration purposes, a sample design that best demonstrates the technique is shown.

Fabric and thread requirements will vary by design, but the general technique is the same.

All designs are stitched with matching thread, top and bobbin.

Note: Some thread colors in instructions have been changed or digitally enhanced for better visibility.

#### STEP 1

- Load Hot Handle Wrap Back 2, 12918-03, onto the machine.
- · Note: Two design files, back and front.
- The back design file is stitched first.



- Hoop one layer of Fuse and Fleece with the shiny (fusible) side down.
- Place hoop on the machine.






### STEP 3

• Stitch Machine Step 1, Insul-Bright and Fabric Placement Stitch.



- Lay one piece of Insul-Bright over the placement stitch, line up one short edge with the two small placement stitches.
- Place one piece of quilter's cotton, right side up, over the Insul-Bright, covering all stitching, including the bottom stitched line.
- Tip: Place quilter's cotton at least an inch past the Insul-Bright Placement Stitch.
- Tape in place to secure.







### STEP 5

- Stitch Machine Step 2, Tackdown.
- Remove the hoop from the machine, but NOT the project from the hoop.
- · Lay hoop on a flat surface.
- Trim the excess Insul-Bright and fabric close to the stitching.
- Return the hoop to the machine.





## STEP 6

• Stitch Machine Step 3, Details.





## STEP 7

- Place (1) 10" x 5" lining right side down, covering the stitching completely.
- Tape in place to secure.



## STEP 8

• Stitch Machine Step 3, Fold Stitch.





### STEP 9

- Remove the hoop from the machine and the project from the hoop.
- Trim excess Fusible Fleece following the cut edge of the lining fabric.
- Note: Do not trim the lining fabric.





- Fold the lining fabric away from the quilted piece.
- · Turn the lining fabric to the back of the project.





### STEP 11

- Press the lining to the project.
- Trim near the outside edges of the design.
- Set aside.
- Note: The fusible on the stabilizer will adhere the lining to the Handle Wrap.





### STEP 12

• Load design, Hot Handle Wrap 2 Front, (12918-04), onto the machine.






## STEP 13

- Hoop one layer of Fuse and Fleece with the shiny (fusible) side down.
- · Place hoop on the machine.



## STEP 14

• Stitch Machine Step 1, Insul-Bright Placement Stitch.




- Place Insul-Bright over the placement stitch, covering completely.
- Tape in place to secure.





## STEP 16


- Stitch Machine Step 2, Cut Line and Tackdown.
- Remove the hoop from the machine, but NOT the project from the hoop.
- Lay on a flat surface.
- Trim Insul-Bright close to the stitching.
- Return the hoop to the machine.





### **STEP 17**

• Stitch Machine Step 3, Fabric 1 Placement Stitch.





### **STEP 18**

- Remove the hoop from the machine, but NOT the project from the hoop.
- Place one piece of  $4'' \times 7.5''$  cotton fabric, right side up, over the placement stitch.
- Tape in place to secure.
- Return hoop to the machine.



### **STEP 19**

• Stitch Machine Step 4, Fabric 1 Cut Line and Tackdown.



- Remove the hoop from the machine, but NOT the project from the hoop.
- Lay on a flat surface.
- Trim approximately 1/2" from the stitching line.
- Return the hoop to the machine.





### **STEP 21**

- Stitch Machine Step 5, Fabric 2 Placement Stitch.
- Remove the hoop from the machine, but NOT the project from the hoop.
- Place one 3.5" x 4.5" cotton fabric, right side down, onto the first piece, lining up one edge with the cut edge of the first piece as shown.
- Tape in place to secure.





- Return hoop to machine.
- Stitch Machine Step 6, Fabric 2 Fold Stitch.
- Remove the hoop from the machine, but NOT the project from the hoop.
- Lay hoop on a flat surface.
- Flip fabric towards the top of the design and finger press in place.
- Tape in place to secure.







### **STEP 23**

- · Return hoop to machine.
- Stitch Machine Step 7, Fabric 3 Placement Stitch.
- · Remove hoop from the machine.
- Place one  $4.5'' \times 7.5''$  cotton fabric, right side down, onto the first piece, lining up one edge with the cut edge of the first piece as shown.
- Tape in place to secure.





- Return hoop to the machine.
- Stitch Machine Step 8, Fold Stitch.
- Remove the hoop from the machine, but NOT the project from the hoop.
- Lay hoop on a flat surface.
- Flip fabric away from the design and finger press in place.
- · Tape in place to secure.







### STEP 25

- · Return hoop to machine.
- Stitch Machine Step 9, Fabric 4 Placement Stitch.
- Trim excess fabric
- Place (1) 3" x 5" cotton fabric, right side down, lining up one edge with the cut edge of the previous piece as shown.
- Tape in place to secure.





- · Return hoop to machine.
- Stitch Machine Step 10, Fabric 4 Fold Stitch.
- Remove the hoop from the machine, but NOT the project from the hoop.
- Lay hoop on a flat surface.
- Flip fabric towards the bottom of the design and finger press in place.
- Tape in place to secure.







### STEP 27

- Return hoop to the machine.
- Stitch Machine Step 11, Tackdown/Detail and Lining Placement Guide.



### **STEP 28**

- Place the Hot Handle Wrap Back 2 (12918-03), right side down centering over the stitching, lining up the folded edge with the two small placement lines.
- Tape in place to secure.
- Note: The Wrap Back (12918-03) is slightly larger than the Wrap Front (12918-04). This is to ensure accuracy when placing the two pieces together.



- · Return hoop to machine.
- Stitch Machine Step 12, Back Tackdown.






## STEP 30

- Remove the hoop from the machine, but NOT the project from the hoop.
- Lay hoop on a flat surface.
- Place the lining right side down, over the entire project.
- Tape in place to secure.



### **STEP 31**

- Return hoop to machine.
- Stitch Machine Step 13, Seam Stitch Match Fabric.



- Remove the hoop from the machine and the project from the hoop.
- Trim the seams approximately 1/4" from the seam line.
- Clip into, but not through the inside corners.
- Trim the outer corners at a 45 degree angle.
- Note: Be sure to leave the seam allowance in the "neck" area.





## STEP 33

- · Separate the lining fabric from the rest of the project.
- Turn right side out through the side opening.
- Use a Point and Press Tool to push out the edges.
- Note: this will create a finished seam at the bottom of the Hot Handle Wrap.





- Inside the neck, remove the bulk by trimming the Insul-Bright to the tackdown line.
- · Note: Do not trim away the fabric.





## STEP 35

- · Press the seam allowance into the opening.
- Place a small piece of Fuse and Seal inside and press to seal the opening, following the manufacturer's instructions.
- Press the complete lining to fuse.



### **STEP 36**

Turn Handle Wrap right side out and press.





## **STEP 37**

• The project is complete. Enjoy.
