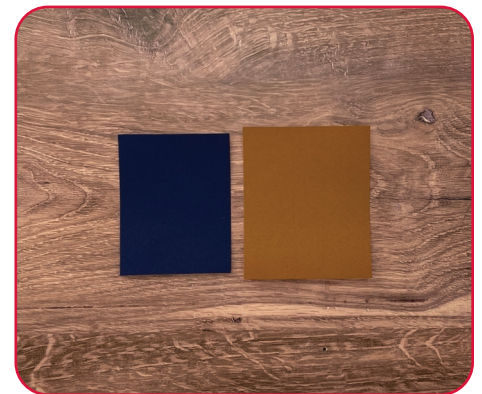
General Instructions

The patch instructions, included in the collection, are general instructions. For demonstration purposes, a sample design that best demonstrates the technique is shown. Design 13035-13 is shown here. Fabric and thread requirements will vary by design, but the general technique is the same. Applique technique shown is cut in place. Pre-cut applique patterns are included at the end of the instructions.

Note: Some thread colors in the instructions have been changed or digitally enhanced for better visibility.

Step 1

- Cut the Poly Patch Twill Fabric 1/4" - 1/2" larger than the applique patterns. The applique patterns are included at the end of the instructions.

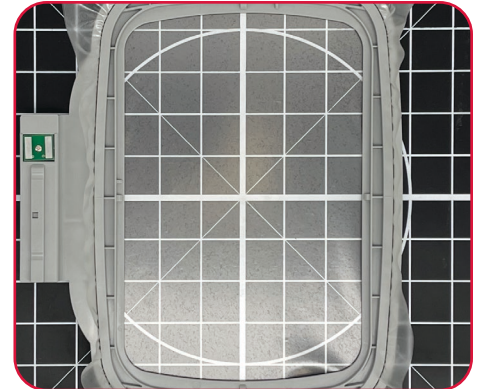


EMBROIDERY- PATCH



Step 2

- Using the OESD Grippy Grid, hoop two layers of BadgeMaster.



Step 3

- Load the selected design into the machine.
- Example design is 13035-13.
- Thread the machine per the thread chart.
- Place the hoop on the machine.
- Stitch Machine Step 1, Dark Blue Fabric Placement Stitch.



Step 4

- Remove the hoop from the machine, but NOT the project from the hoop.
- Completely cover the placement stitch with the dark blue Poly Patch Twill applique fabric.
- Tape in place with OESD Expert Embroidery Tape TearAway to secure.

□ Step 5

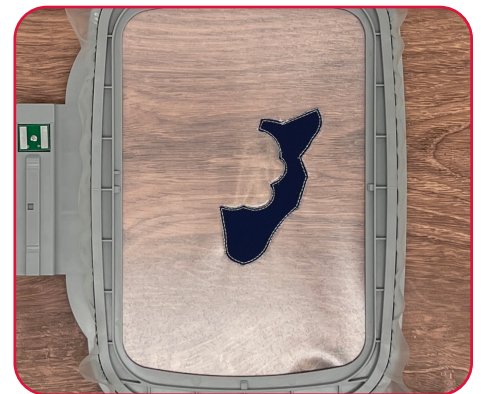
- Return the hoop to the machine.
- Stitch Machine Step 2, Cut Line and Tackdown.



□ Step 6

- Remove the hoop from the machine, but NOT the project from the hoop.
- Trim the excess fabric as close to the cut line as possible. If the outermost stitches (cut line) are cut, the inner stitches (tackdown) will hold the applique in place.

 **Tip: If the stabilizer is cut or a hole is created while trimming the fabric, use OEESD Expert Embroidery Tape WashAway as a patch.**



EMBROIDERY- PATCH



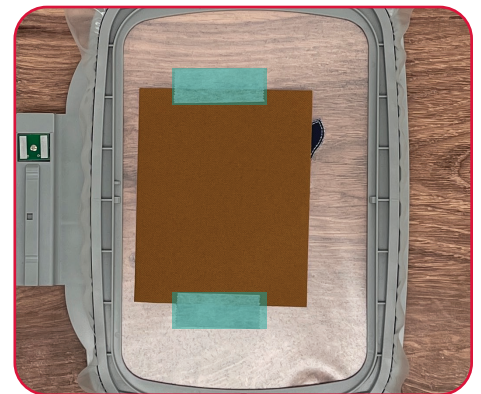
Step 7

- Return the hoop to the machine.
- Stitch Machine Step 2, Brown Fabric Placement Stitch.



Step 8

- Remove the hoop from the machine, but NOT the project from the hoop.
- Completely cover the placement stitch with the brown Poly Patch Twill applique fabric.
- Tape in place to secure.



Step 9

- Return the hoop to the machine.
- Stitch Machine Step 4, Cut Line and Tackdown.



EMBROIDERY- PATCH



Step 10

- Remove the hoop from the machine, but NOT the project from the hoop.
- Trim the excess fabric as close to the cut line as possible.



Step 11

- Return the hoop to the machine.
- Stitch Machine Steps 5 – 8, **stopping before the last machine step.**



Step 12

- Stitch Machine Step 9, Cover Stitch **with matching bobbin thread.**



EMBROIDERY- PATCH



□ Step 13

- When the design is complete, remove the project from the hoop.
- Trim the stabilizer 1/4" - 1/2" outside the design or if perforated enough, BadgeMaster can be gently torn away from the design, one layer at a time.



FINISHING TOUCHES



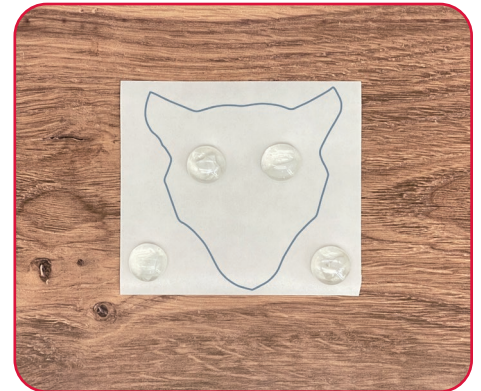
□ Step 14

- Rinse the patch in warm running water until the design is only slightly tacky.
- Place right side down on a non-stick surface to dry. Parchment paper or a cooling rack work well. Dry completely.
- Once dry, press right side down on an OEESD Perfect Embroidery Press Cloth.



□ Step 15

- Trace the outline of the patch or print the mirrored version of the applique pattern on the paper side of Fuse and Seal.



FINISHING TOUCHES

Step 16

- Trim the Fuse and Seal just inside the outline.
- Iron the Fuse and Seal to the wrong side of the patch, following the package instructions.
- Cool completely.



Step 17

- When ready to apply the patch, remove the paper backing from the Fuse and Seal.
- Place the patch on the project and press to adhere.

Step 18

- The project is complete. Enjoy!

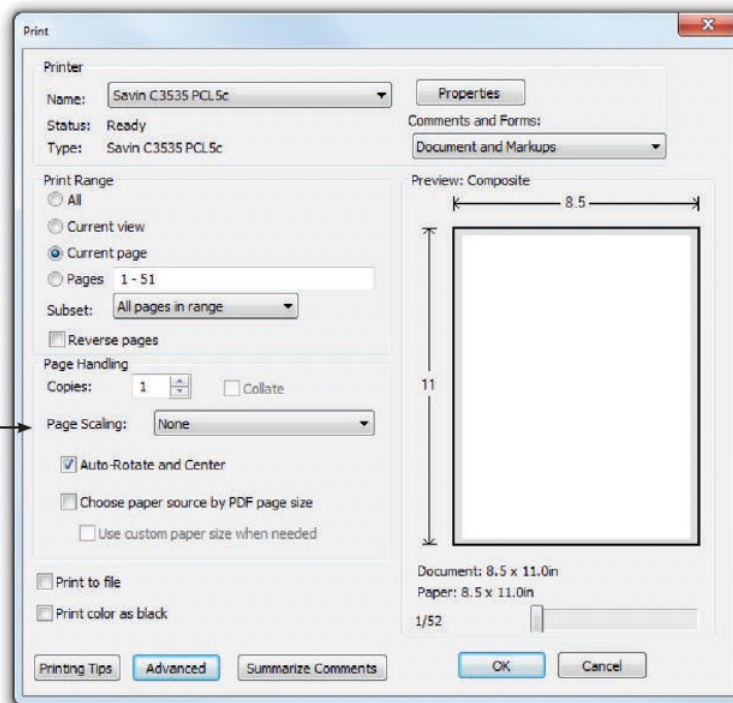

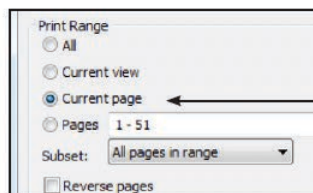

TO SAVE PAPER

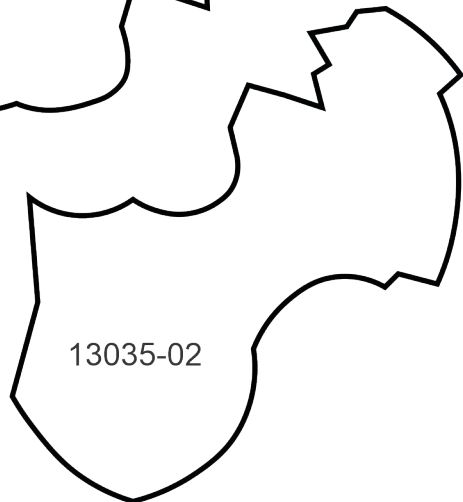
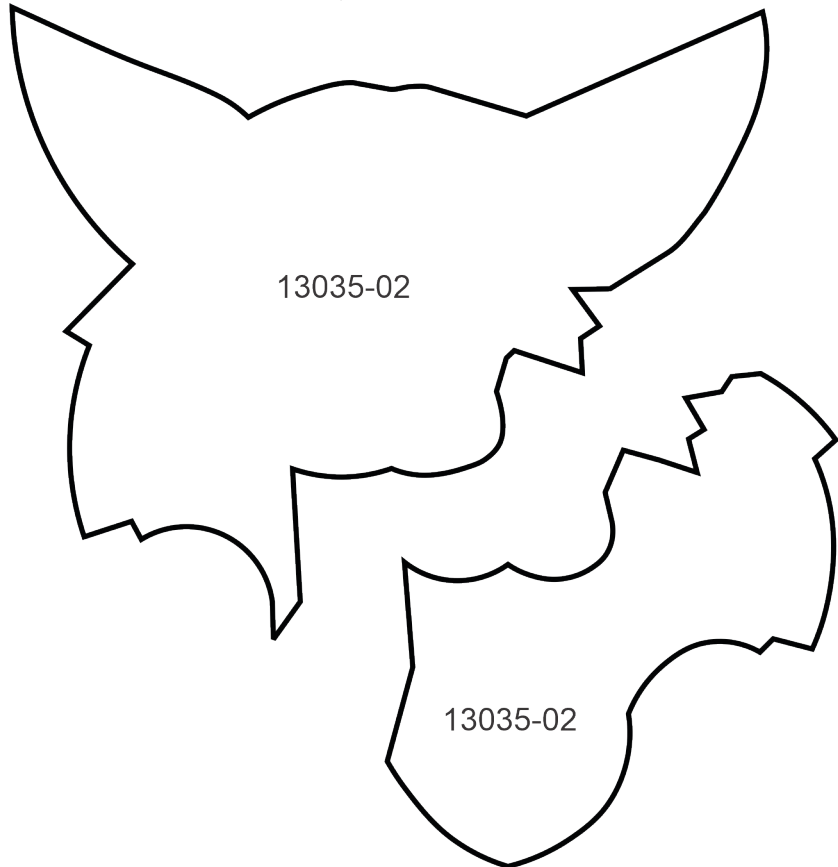
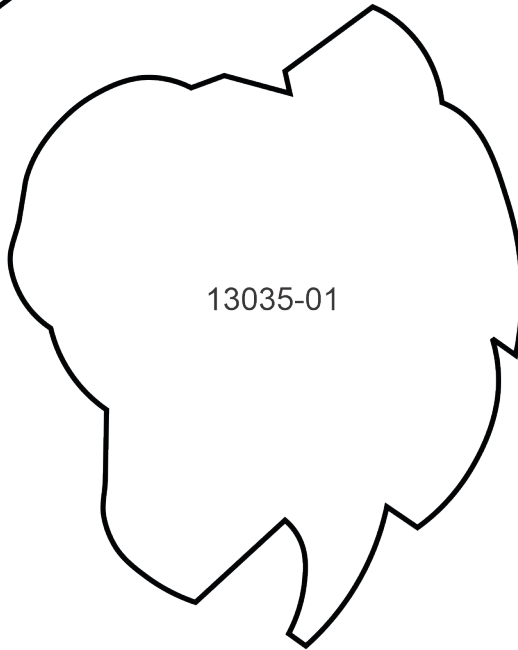
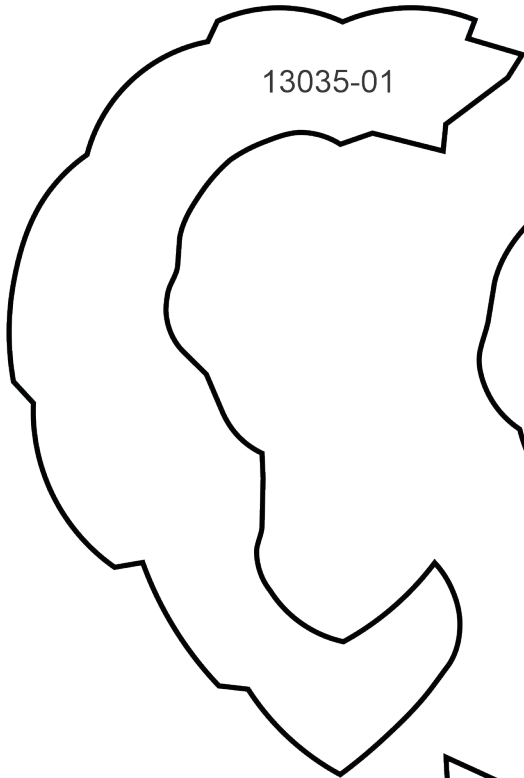
Only print the desired image by navigating to the image's page, go to File > Print and select "Current page" in the print dialog box. Repeat for each desired image.
