Cutting Summary

FOR EACH DESIGN CUT THE FOLLOWING:

- (1) Background 7" x 5"
- (1) Front Top $5" \times 5"$ folded to $2 \frac{1}{2}" \times 5"$
- (1) Back Top 7" x 5" folded to 3 1/2" x 5"
- (1) Back Bottom 7" \times 5" folded to 3 1/2" \times 5"
- (1) OESD Fusible Woven CutAway 7" x 5"
 - (1) OESD Fuse and Fleece 5" x 5" (1) 1/4" ribbon 5"

- OESD Grippy Grid
- OESD Expert Embroidery Tape TearAway
- OESD Expert Point & Press Tool
- OESD Perfect Embroidery Press Cloth
- 1/4" ribbon


General Instructions

The instructions included in the collection are general instructions. For demonstration purposes, a sample design that best demonstrates the technique is shown. Design 21025-07 is shown here. Fabric and thread requirements will vary by design, but the general technique is the same.

Note: Some thread colors in instructions have been changed or digitally enhanced for better visibility.

Step 1

- Fuse a layer of Fusible Woven to the wrong side of the 7" x 5" Background fabric.
- At the bottom of the 7" \times 5" prepared Background fabric, fuse the 5" \times 5" piece of Fuse and Fleece.







Step 2

- Fold the 5" x 5" Front Top fabric in half to measure 2 1/2" x 5".
- Fold the 2, 7" x 5" back pieces in half to measure 3 1/2" x 5".




Step 3

• Using the OESD Grippy Grid, hoop one layer of Ultra Clean and Tear for all designs.



Step 4


- Load the selected design into the machine.
- Example design is 21025-07.
- Thread the machine per the thread chart.
- Place the hoop on the machine.
- Stitch Machine Step 1, Ribbon and Fold Placement Lines.






Step 5

- Remove the hoop from the machine, but NOT the project from the hoop.
- Place the hoop on a flat surface.
- Position the prepared Background Fabric right side up with the Fuse and Fleece at the bottom, completely covering the placement stitch.
- Tape in place with OESD Expert Embroidery Tape TearAway to secure.



Step 6

- Return the hoop to the machine.
- Stitch Machine Step 2, Background Fabric Tackdown.



Step 7

- Stitch Machine Steps 3 4, changing thread per the thread chart.
- Stitch Machine Step 5, Folded Top Fabric Placement.





Step 8

- Remove the hoop from the machine, but NOT the project from the hoop.
- Position the folded Top Front fabric over the top of the design, aligning the folded edge with the top fabric placement line.
- Tape in place to secure.



Step 9

- Return the hoop to the machine.
- Stitch Machine Step 8, Folded Top Fabric Tackdown.



Step 10

• Stitch Machine Steps 9 and 10, if the number at the top is desired.





Step 11

- Remove the hoop from the machine, but NOT the project from the hoop.
- Fold the 5" ribbon in half to measure 2 1/2".
- Align the fold of the ribbon with the Folded Top Fabric Tackdown.
- Align the edges of the ribbon between the ribbon placement lines at the top of the design.
- Tape in place to secure.



Step 12

- Position the folded Back Bottom (3 1/2" x 5") over the bottom of the design, aligning the fold with the middle placement line.
- Tape in place to secure.





Step 13

- Position the folded Back Top (3 1/2" x 5") over the top of the design, aligning the fold with the bottom placement line.
- Tape in place to secure, making sure to cover where the sides overlap.
- Tip: By overlapping the two pieces in the listed order, a pocket is formed on the back where something small like a gift card can be placed inside.



Step 14

- Return the hoop to the machine.
- · Stitch Machine Step 9, Ribbon Tackdown and Seam.



ASSEMBLY



Step 15

- Remove the hoop from the machine and the project from the hoop.
- Trim the outer edges 1/4" from the seam stitch on all sides.
- Clip each corner diagonally.



Step 16

- Turn the project right side out.
- Use the large end of the Expert Point and Press Tool to push out the corners and side seams.
- Gently tug on the ribbon to help pull the top edge out.
- Press right side down on a Perfect Embroidery Press Cloth.







ASSEMBLY



Step 17

 Place a gift card in the back, use it as a gift tag or ornament, or stitch all 31 designs and create a Holiday Calendar bunting!



Step 18

• The project is complete. Enjoy!
