MATERIALS



Stabilizer

- BadgeMaster AquaFilm
- AquaMesh WashAway
- StabilStick CutAway
- StitcH20 Topper
- StabilStick CutAway (for backing Applique Pieces)

Fabric/Notions

- White Fleece type fabric such as Minkee or Cuddle Brands (Beard and Hair)- 1/8 yd
- White Fabric- 1/8 yd
- Pink Fabric- 1/8 yd
- Aqua Fabric- 1/8 yd
- Gray Fabric- 1/8 yd
- Peach Fabric- 1/8 yd
- Expert Embroidery Tape WashAway
- 3/16" wooden dowel 10" long (requires painting)
- Alligator Clamps
- Optional: Button Clips
- Tweezers
- Perfect Punch Tool
- Utility knife
- Glitz crystals (optional)



Step 1 Applique Instructions

- · Match bobbin to top thread for all designs.
- Prep all applique fabric with 2 layers of StabilStick CutAway. Apply both pieces to the wrong side of the fabric.
- **Note:** The StabilStick adds stability to the applique, keeping the pieces stiff once the project is complete.





Step 2

• Hoop 1 layer of BadgeMaster and 1 layer of AquaMesh.



Step 3

• Sew Machine Step 1, Green Fabric Placement Stitch.





Step 4

- Spray temporary adhesive to the wrong side of the green applique piece and lay directly over the placement stitch, covering it entirely.
- Optional: Tape in place.



Step 5

• Sew Machine Step 2, Cut Line and Tackdown.



- Remove the hoop from the machine but do NOT remove the project from the hoop.
- Trim along the cut line of the green applique.





Step 7

• **Note:** If the stabilizer gets cut while trimming between the fabric pieces, place a piece of Expert Tape WashAway over the area.




Step 8

· Return the hoop to the machine and sew the remaining colors.



- Remove the design from the hoop and trim stabilizer ¼" from the design and wash away the remaining stabilizer with warm running water.
- **TIP:** To keep the lace stiff avoid washing ALL the stabilizer away.





Step 1 Double Applique Instructions (51231-02)

- Prep 1 piece of Minkee and 1 piece of white cotton with 2 layers of StabilStick CutAway to the wrong side of the fabrics.
- Hoop one layer of AquaMesh with one layer of BadgeMaster.



Step 2

- Sew Machine Step 1, Front and Back Fleece Fabric Placement Stitch.
- Remove the hoop from the machine but do NOT remove the project from the hoop.




- Lay the front fleece applique, right side up, directly over the placement stitch, covering it entirely.
- Tape in place.
- Apply 1 layer of StitcH2O topper directly over the applique.
- Tape in place.





Step 4

- Flip the hoop over and place the cotton fabric, right side up, over the placement line.
- Tape in place.



Step 5

- Return the hoop to the machine and sew Machine Step 2, Cut Line and Tackdown.
- Remove the hoop from the machine but do NOT remove the project from the hoop.
- Note: Dark thread used in photo for visibilty.



Step 6

• Trim next to the cut line of the front fleece applique.





Step 7

• Flip the hoop over and repeat this step for the back applique.



Step 8

• Return the hoop to the machine and sew Machine Step 3, Cover Stitch.



Step 9

• Remove the design from the hoop and trim stabilizer $\frac{1}{4}$ " from the design.





- · Wash away the remaining stabilizer with warm running water.
- Lay flat to dry.





Step 1

• Use the Expert Punch Tool with the 3 mm tip to remove the fabric from the two eyelets on the face.





Step 2

· Bend the head and button the 2 buttonettes to their corresponding eyelets.



Step 3

• Button to the inside to create a more rounded head as shown.







Step 4

- Button one end of the hair (51231-01) to the head and bend the hair behind the back of the head and attach the other buttonette as shown.
- · Minkee should be facing to the outside.





Step 5

- Use the Expert Punch Tool to remove the fabric from four eyelets in 51231-03 as shown.
- Next, use a craft knife to gently slice open the tufted satins. Be careful not to slice all the way through the fabric.
- Optional: Crystals can be added to the design by placing them inside any of the stitched circles.
- **Optional:** To put the tufted satin edge on the bottom of the hat just use the Expert Punch Tool to remove the fabric from the four eyelets on the opposite side.



Step 6

• Pull the two buttonettes through the two eyelets to form the hat.






Step 7

• With the right side facing up, pull the 4 buttonettes on 51231-04 through the eyelets on the hat.




Step 8

• Use a craft knife to slice open the tab entry points.



- To form the body, bend 51231-O4 to attach one side only to the body (51231-O5).
- Pull the buttonettes on 51231-06 through the eyelets on 51231-05.






Step 10

• Leave one side open to help in later assembly steps.



Step 11

- Lay the two arms flat and use a craft knife to slice open the tufted satins on each arm.
- **Tip:** Use a small brush to 'fluff' the tufted satins after slicing open.



Step 12

• Pull the buttonettes through the eyelets on each arm.





Step 13

• Attach the Nutcracker's left arm to the shoulder by pulling the 3 buttonettes through the 3 corresponding eyelets.

Step 14

 Attach the Nutcracker's right arm to the shoulder by pulling the 3 buttonettes through the 3 corresponding eyelets.







Step 15


• Use a craft knife to slice open the tab entry point on 51231-10.





Step 16

• To form the legs, bend at the feet of 51231-09. Insert the tab on the feet into the tab entry point on the front legs 51231-10, pulling the tab from the back.



Step 17

• Attach the 4 buttonettes on the leg front to the 4 corresponding eyelets on the leg sides.



Step 18

• Attach the leg back by connecting the 4 buttonettes to the remaining 4 eyelets on the leg assembly. Be sure to have the pink applique on the bottom.













Step 19

Insert the 4 tabs from the leg assembly into the 4 tab entry points on the bottom of the body assembly.
 Pull up through the open body.



Step 20

• To attach the head, insert the 2 tabs on the head into the 2 tab entry points on the body. Pull the tabs down through the open body.



Step 21

• Button the remaining 6 buttonettes on the body to the corresponding eyelets. Use button clips if needed to temporarily hold the buttonettes in place while you build.











Step 22

- Use the punch tool to remove the fabric from the 5 eyelets in the base. (51231-12)
- Use a Utility knife to slice open the 4 tab entry points.



Step 23

Fold the base at the hinged areas and connect the 4 buttonettes at each corner to the corresponding
eyelets.




- Insert the 4 tabs on the legs into the 4 tab entry points on the base top, pulling through to the back. The Nutcracker's right arm should be on the side with the hole in the base.
- Tip: Bend the tabs toward the outside. It will make the Nutcracker more stable.





Step 25

• Carefully turn the Nutcracker over and attach the bottom of the base by connecting the remaining 4 buttonettes to their corresponding eyelets. The right side of the base bottom should be to the outside.




Step 26

Set hat on the head of the Nutcracker.



Step 27

• Button the 8 buttonettes on the staff topper as shown.





Step 28

• Place the wooden dowel through the staff topper.



Step 29

Place the dowel through the hand.




Place the dowel through the eyelet in the base.



































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











































TUFTED SATIN GUIDES Cissortail STITCHES

- 1. Lay embroidered design flat.
- 2. Refer to the Tufted Satin Guide on the following page to determine which satins are to be cut.
- 3. With a craft knife, lightly slice through the satins. You may need to repeat slicing the satins until you have achieved the desired look while being careful not to cut the fabric.





Solid pink areas denote tufted satin cut areas.
