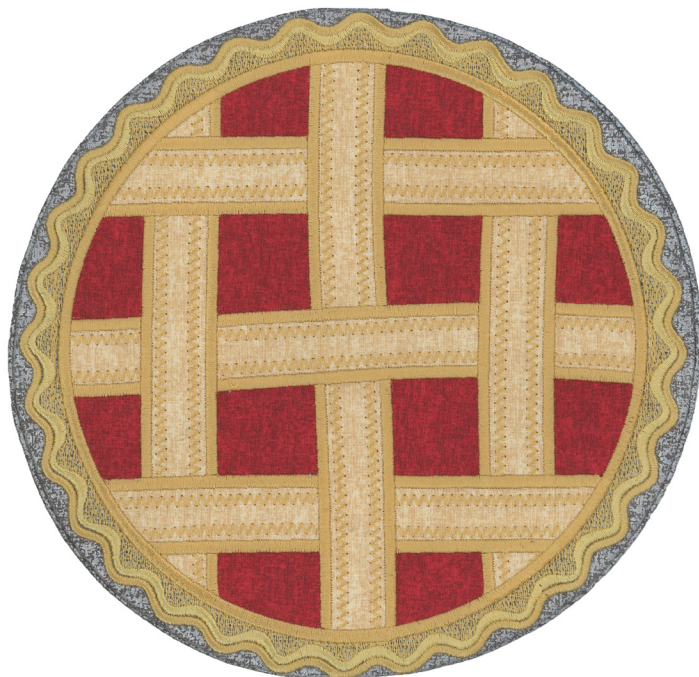

# MATERIALS



## Stabilizers

- OESD Fuse and Fleece

## Fabrics/Textiles

- Silver/Gray quilter's cotton- (4) 10" squares
- Blueberry, cherry, or peach quilter's cotton- (1) 8" square
- Tan quilter's cotton- (1) 8" square

## Notion & Tools

- OESD Expert Embroidery Tape TearAway
- OESD Expert Point and Press Tool
- OESD Perfect Embroidery Press Cloth
- OESD Grippy Grid
- Embroidery Needle Sharp 75/11
- Water soluble marking pen
- Scissors

# EMBROIDERY



## General Instructions

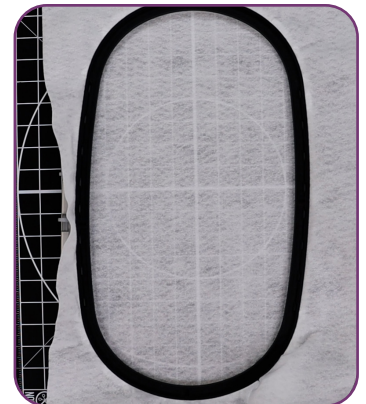
The applique instructions, included in the collection, are general instructions. For demonstration purposes, a sample design that best demonstrates the technique is shown.

Fabric and thread requirements will vary by design, but the general technique is the same.

Note: Some thread colors in instructions have been changed or digitally enhanced for better visibility.

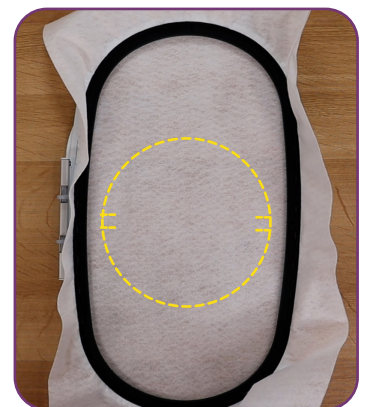
### □ Step 1

- Hoop one layer of Fuse and Fleece with the fusible (shiny side) down.



### □ Step 2

- Load the selected design into the machine.
- Design in the example is 51309-02.
- Thread the machine per the thread chart.
- Stitch Machine Step 1, Silver Fabric Placement Stitch.



# EMBROIDERY



## Step 3

- Remove the hoop from the machine, but NOT the project from the hoop.
- Place the hoop on a flat surface.
- Use a water-soluble marking pen or pencil and extend the placement stitches on either side of the circle.
- Place one piece of Fuse and Fleece, fusible (shiny side) up, and one piece of silver fabric (right side up), completely covering the placement stitch.
- Tape in place to secure.



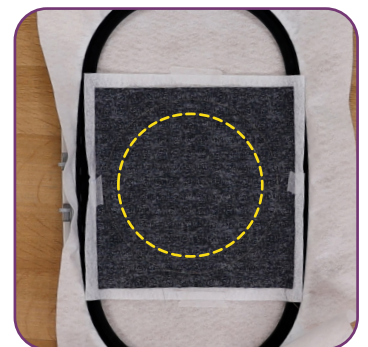
## Step 4

- Return the hoop to the machine.
- Stitch Machine Step 2, Fabric Tackdown.



## Step 5

- Stitch Machine Step 3, Blue Fabric Placement Stitch.

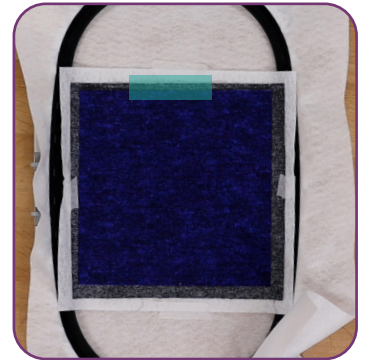

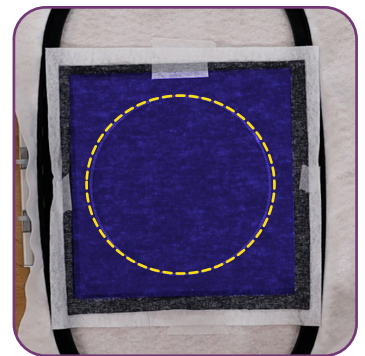
## □ Step 6

- Remove the hoop from the machine, but NOT the project from the hoop.
- Place the hoop on a flat surface.
- Place the blue fabric right side up, over the placement stitch, covering entirely.
- Tape in place to secure.



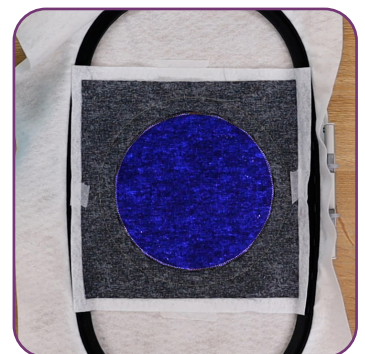
## □ Step 7

- Return the hoop to the machine.
- Stitch Machine Step 4, Cut Line and Tackdown.



## □ Step 8

- Remove the hoop from the machine, but NOT the project from the hoop.
- Place on a flat surface.
- Trim the excess fabric as close to the cut line as possible. If the outermost stitches (cut line) are cut, the inner stitches (tackdown) will hold the applique in place.



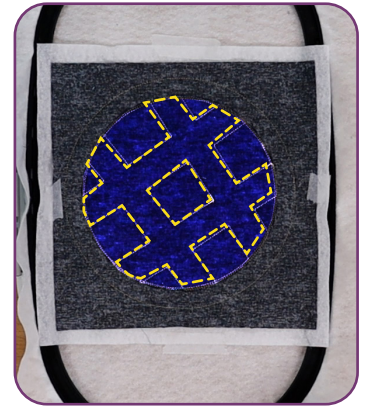


# EMBROIDERY



## □ Step 9

- Return the hoop to the machine.
- Stitch Machine Step 5, Tan Fabric Placement Stitch.



## □ Step 10

- Remove the hoop from the machine, but NOT the project from the hoop.
- Place the hoop on a flat surface.
- Place the tan fabric right side up, over the placement stitch, covering entirely.
- Tape in place to secure.



## □ Step 11

- Return the hoop to the machine.
- Stitch Machine Step 6, Cut Line and Tackdown.

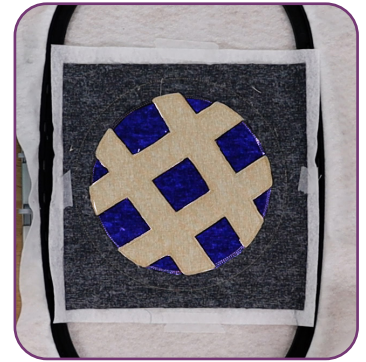


# EMBROIDERY



## □ Step 12

- Remove the hoop from the machine, but NOT the project from the hoop.
- Place on a flat surface.
- Trim the excess fabric as close to the cut line stitching as possible.



## □ Step 13

- Return the hoop to the machine.
- Stitch Steps 7-9 per the thread chart.
- STOP before the final machine step.



## □ Step 14

- Remove the hoop from the machine, but NOT the project from the hoop.
- Turn the hoop over and place one silver 10" square, right side up, completely covering the placement stitch.
- Tape the corners to secure.



# EMBROIDERY



## □ Step 15

- Turn the hoop back to the front and use a water-soluble marking pen or pencil and transfer the extended placement stitches on either side of the circle to the top fabric.



## □ Step 16

- Fold two squares of 10" silver fabric in half, wrong sides together.
- Press.
- Position the first folded fabric over the bottom of the design, aligning the folded edge with the upper placement line as shown.
- Tape in place to secure.



## □ Step 17

- Position the second folded fabric over the top of the design aligning the folded edge with the lower placement line so that the two fabrics overlap.
- Tape in place to secure.
- Note: Overlapping the two fabrics in the listed order will prevent the embroidery foot from catching on the overlapped edge of the fabric.

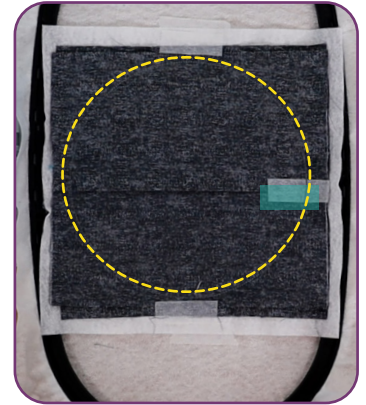


# EMBROIDERY



## □ Step 18

- Return the hoop to the machine.
- Stitch Machine Step 10, Seam.



## □ Step 19

- Remove the project from the hoop and trim approximately 1/4" from the outermost stitching line.
- With the lining side up, press to fuse the lining to the Fuse and Fleece.
- Tip: Use steam to create a stronger fuse.



# EMBROIDERY



## □ Step 20

- Turn project right side out.
- Use the Expert Point and Press Tool to push out the seams.
- Press right side down on a Perfect Embroidery Press Cloth.



## □ Step 21

- The project is complete. Enjoy.

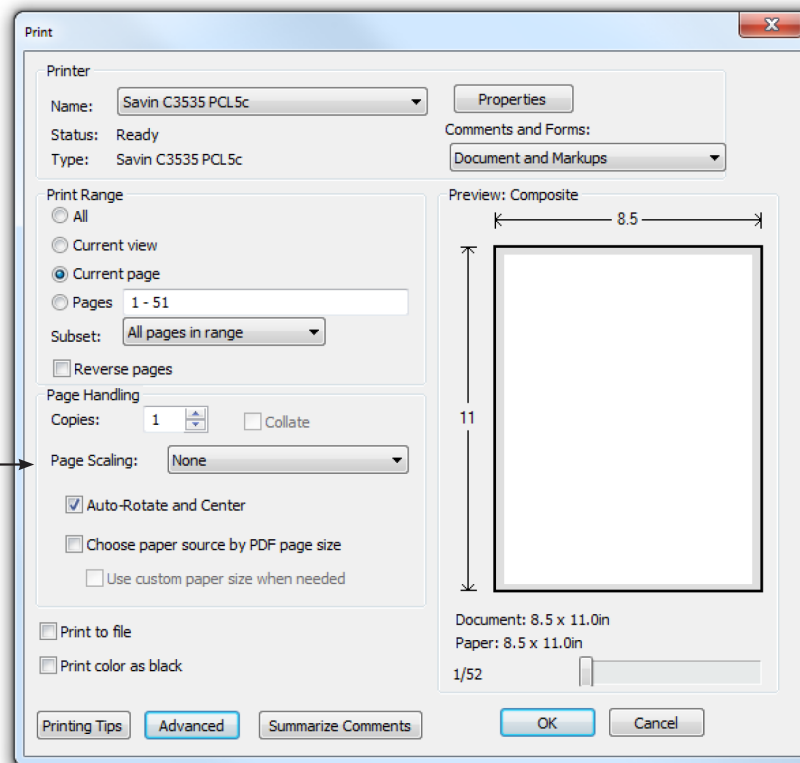
