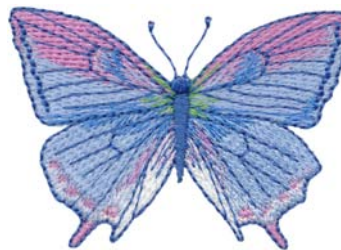

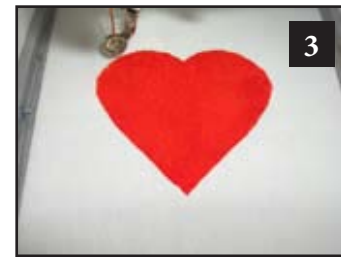
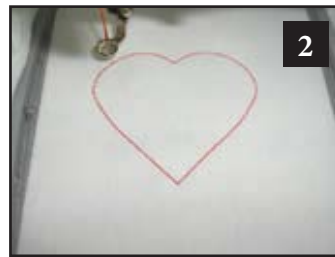
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1. Print out the necessary pages from the PDF of the appliqué pattern(s).
2. Mark the right side of the pattern pieces so you'll know which direction to lay the pattern on the fabric.
3. Lightly spray the wrong side of the pattern pieces with temporary adhesive spray and allow it to set for a few minutes.
4. Place the pattern pieces on the right side of the fabric and carefully cut them out. **PHOTO 1**
5. Sew the placement stitch on your hooped fabric. **PHOTO 2**
6. With the paper still stuck to the right side of the appliqué fabric, spray the wrong side of the fabric with temporary spray adhesive.
7. Place the fabric inside the sewing placement stitch so that it matches the stitching line, and then remove the paper pattern. **PHOTO 3**
8. Sew the tackdown. **PHOTO 4**
9. Sew the remainder of the design and repeat for any remaining pieces. **PHOTO 5**

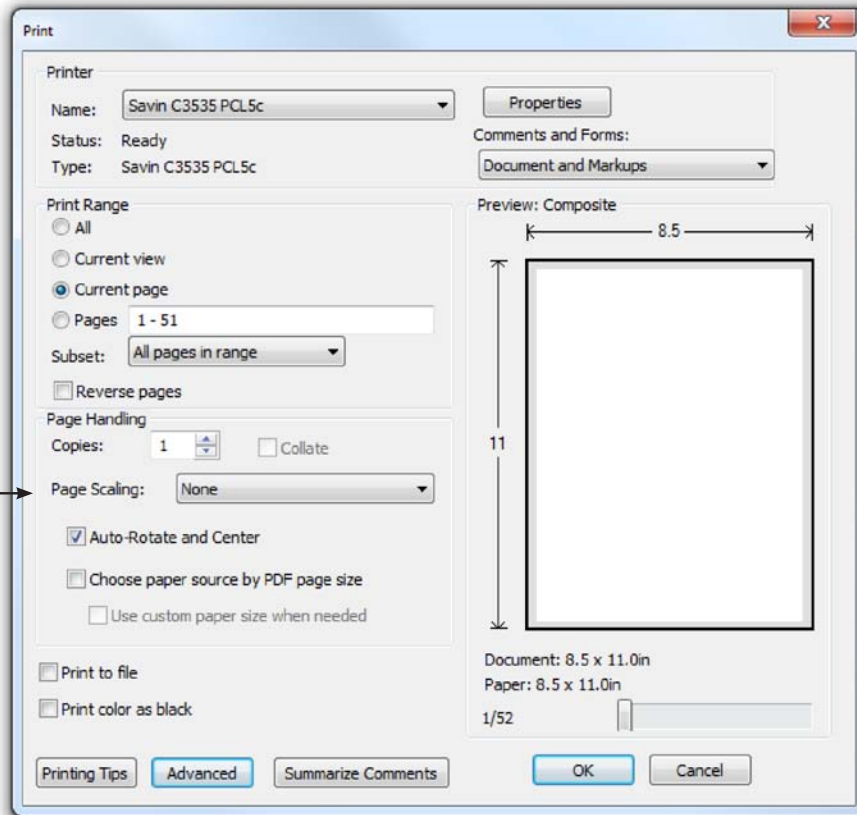
NOTE: The patterns are sized for the designs as they were made. If you resize the design, you will need to resize the pattern the same amount. You can print out the pattern at the normal size then copy it on a copy machine at the changed size. For example, resize the designs to 80%, resize the printed pattern to 80%.

TIP: When Printing the patterns, make sure that the “Fit to page” option is **UNCHECKED** in the Print Dialog Box. If this option is checked the printed patterns will not be actual size.



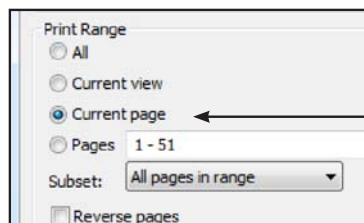

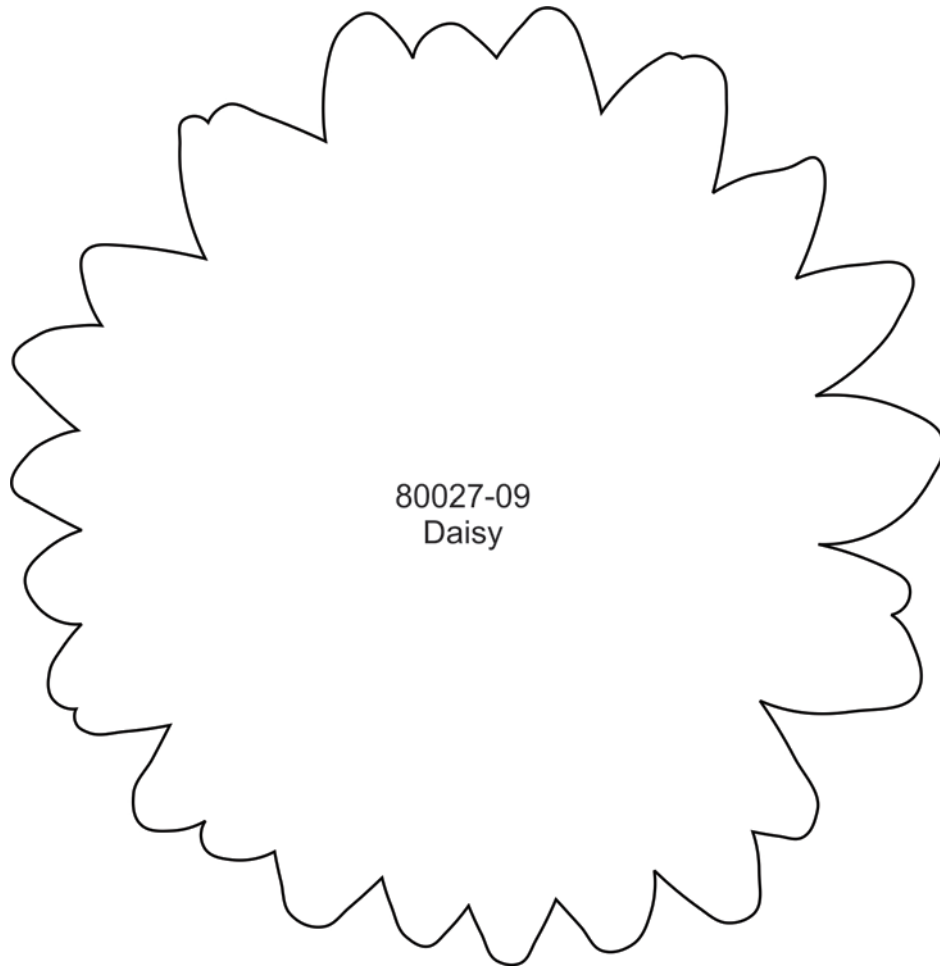


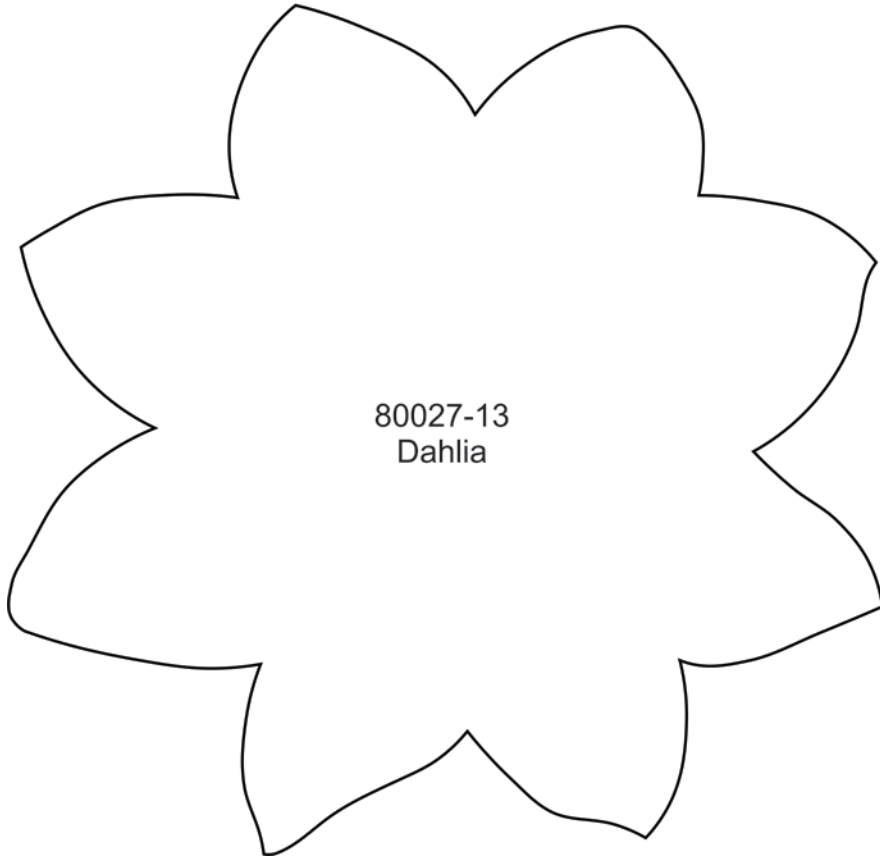
TO SAVE PAPER

Only print the desired image by navigating to the image's page, go to File > Print and select "Current page" in the print dialog box. Repeat for each desired image.

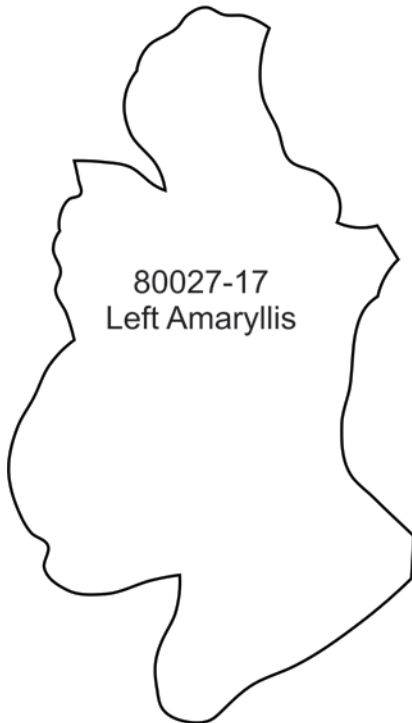




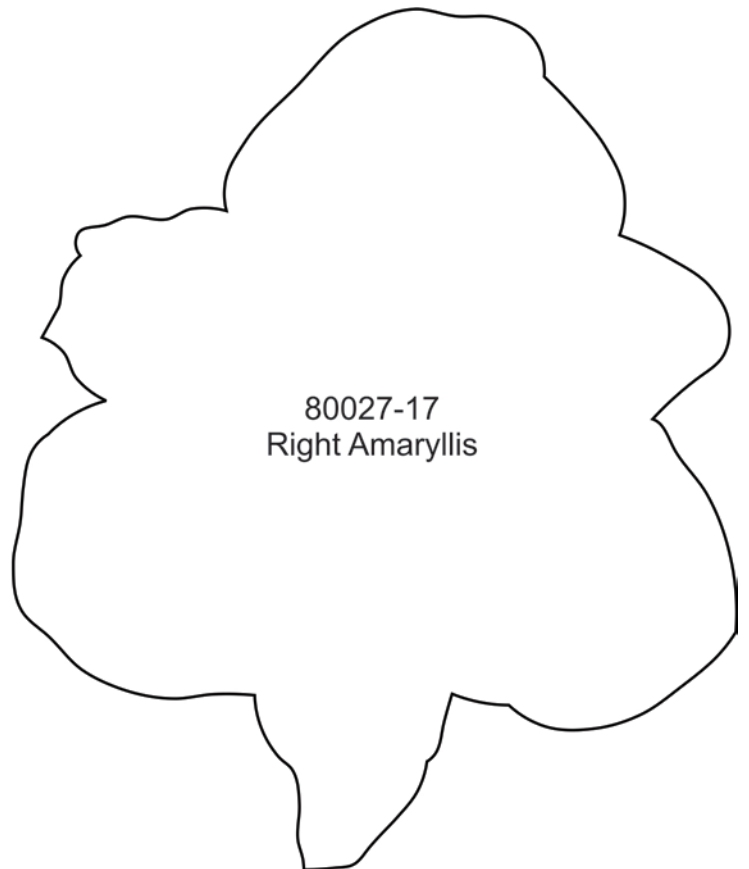

BOTANICAL INSPIRATIONS MINI QUILT



Make this adorable mini quilt to celebrate a beautiful summer flower - the Dahlia. The designs in this project are from a [Botanical Inspirations by Jane Shasky](#). The collection contains sets of designs, with each set having a flower, the flower's name, a butterfly (or moth), and an inspirational quote. The project can easily be adapted to the other sets by adjusting the colors - make one for every season! You can display them on [this beautiful table-top quilt stand](#) and easily switch them out so you always have a fresh display.



FABRIC:

- 1/2 yard cream cotton
- Borders – Fat Quarter or scraps of blue, pink, green, and purple cotton
- Backing – 12 1/2" square
- Low Loft Batting – 12 1/2" square

- Embroidery Thread
- Heavy Weight Cut Away Stabilizer

EMBROIDERY DESIGNS:

[Botanical Inspirations #80027.](#)

Designs Included in this quilt: #80027-13, #80027-14, #80027-15, and #80027-16

CUT AND PREPARE FABRIC:

1. Cut 1, cream fabric and Heavy Weight Cut Away Stabilizer 10" x 14", to fit Large hoop.
2. Cut 3, cream fabric and Heavy Weight Cut Away Stabilizer 8" x 9", to fit Medium hoop.
3. Cut the following:

Blue Borders:

- (1) 1 1/2" x 11 1/2"
- (1) 1 1/2" x 5 1/2"
- (1) 1 1/2" x 11 1/2"

Green Borders:

- (1) 1 1/2" x 12 1/2"
- (1) 1 1/2" x 4 1/2"
- (1) 1 1/2" x 6 1/2"

Purple Borders:

- (1) 1 1/2" x 4 1/2"
- (1) 2 1/2" x 4 1/2"

Pink Borders:

- (2) 6 1/2" x 1 1/2"
- (1) 1 1/2" x 5 1/2"
- (1) 1 1/2" x 11 1/2"

EMBROIDERY:

1. Use temporary adhesive spray to join the 10" x 14" cream fabric to Heavy Weight Cut Away Stabilizer.
2. Hoop in the large hoop & stitch Design #80027-13, using recommended thread colors. Complete the appliqué according to the instructions include with the Botanical Inspirations collection.
3. Use temporary adhesive spray to join 1 piece of 8" x 9" cream fabric to Heavy Weight Cut Away Stabilizer.
4. Hoop in the medium hoop & stitch Designs #80027-14
5. Repeat steps 3 and 4 with Designs #80027-15, and #80027-16, using recommended thread colors.



CUT AND SEW EMBROIDERED BLOCKS:

When embroidery is finished cut blocks to:

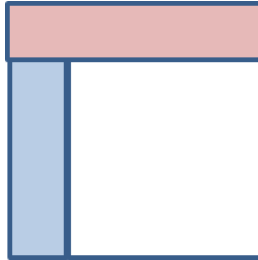
- 5 1/2" x 5 1/2" – Design #80027-13
 - 6 1/2" x 3 1/2" – Design #80027-14
 - 4 1/2" x 3 1/2" – Design #80027-15
 - 4 1/2" x 4 1/2" – Design #80027-16
1. Lay out blocks in two columns. The first row will have designs: #80027-13, and #80027-14. The second row will have designs: #80027-15, and #80027-16.
 2. Attach patchwork foot. Using a 1/4" seam allowance, seam the blocks with the **right sides** together.

*Note: Piecing diagrams are used as a reference and not necessarily created to scale.

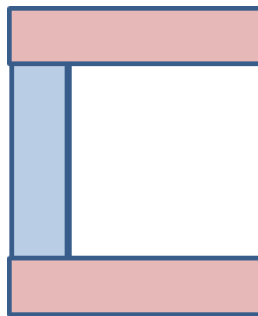
3. Piece blue border (1 1/2" x 5 1/2") to the left side of embroidered Dahlia Appliqué (80027-13) design block (5 1/2" x 5 1/2").



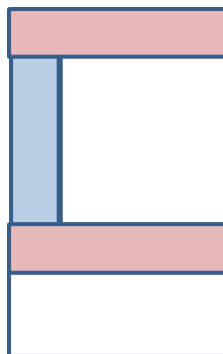
4. Piece 1 1/2" x 6 1/2" pink border to the top of the finished block.



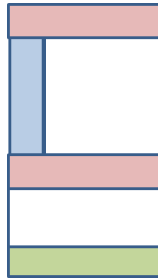
5. Piece 1 1/2" x 6 1/2" pink border to the bottom of the finished block.



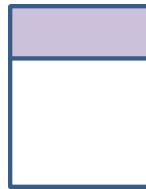
6. Piece embroidered Dahlia (80027-14) design block (6 1/2" x 3 x 1/2") to bottom of finished block.



7. Piece $1\frac{1}{2}$ " x $6\frac{1}{2}$ " green border to the bottom of finished block.



8. You have completed first column and it should measure $6\frac{1}{2}$ " x $11\frac{1}{2}$ ".
 9. Piece purple border ($1\frac{1}{2}$ " x $4\frac{1}{2}$ "") to top of embroidered Pink & White Butterfly (80027-15) design block ($4\frac{1}{2}$ " x $3\frac{1}{2}$ "").



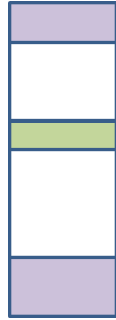
10. Piece $1\frac{1}{2}$ " x $4\frac{1}{2}$ " green border to bottom of finished block.



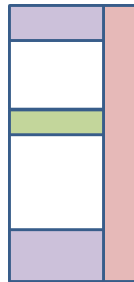
11. Piece embroidered Lose Yourself in Nature (800027-16) design block ($4\frac{1}{2}$ " x $4\frac{1}{2}$ "") to the bottom of finished block.



12. Piece $2\frac{1}{2}$ " x $4\frac{1}{2}$ " purple border to the bottom of finished block.



13. Piece pink border ($1\frac{1}{2}$ " x $11\frac{1}{2}$ ") to right side of finished block.

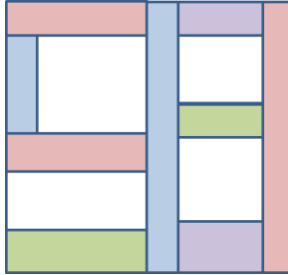


14. You have completed second row and it should measure $5\frac{1}{2}$ " x $11\frac{1}{2}$ ".

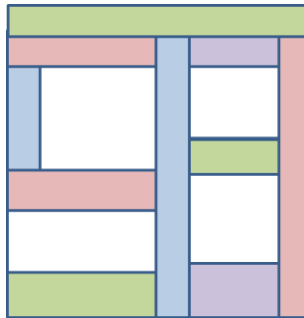
15. Piece row 1 to blue border ($1\frac{1}{2}$ " x $11\frac{1}{2}$ ").



16. Piece the left hand column to the first column, ensuring that the blue border is between the two rows. Your finished block should now measure $12\frac{1}{2}$ " x $11\frac{1}{2}$ ".



17. Sew green border ($1\frac{1}{2}$ " x $12\frac{1}{2}$ "") to top of finished block.



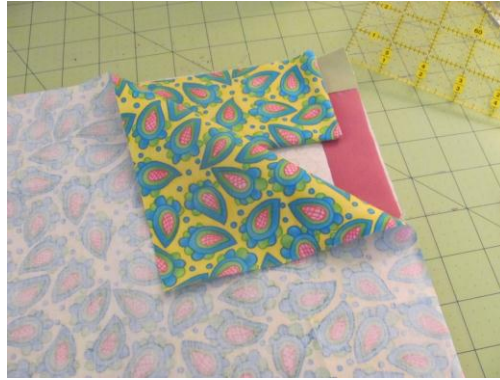
18. Your completed mini-quilt top should measure $12\frac{1}{2}$ x $12\frac{1}{2}$ ".

ASSEMBLE THE MINI QUILT

- Optional: Make a quilt hanger by sewing two 9" x 5" fabric strips right-sides together down both short sides, using a $\frac{1}{4}$ " seam. Turn right sides out, and press in half so your folded piece measures $9\frac{1}{2}$ x $2\frac{1}{2}$ ".
- Lay the top of quilt right side up on top of batting. Layer quilt hanger between top and backing.



3. Place backing right side facing batting.



4. Sew a 1/4" all round quilt. Carefully cut a 5" opening in at the top of the backing, approximately 1" down from the top. The quilt hanger will cover it this opening.



5. Trim quilt corners.
6. Turn inside out. Press. Hand stitch opening closed. Hand stitch bottom of quilt hanger to back of quilt. Hang and enjoy!
