

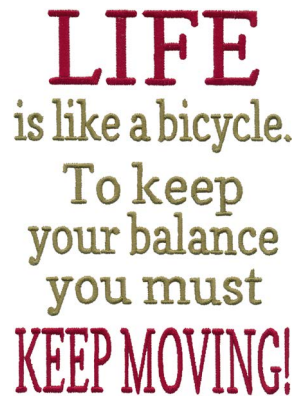

Supplies

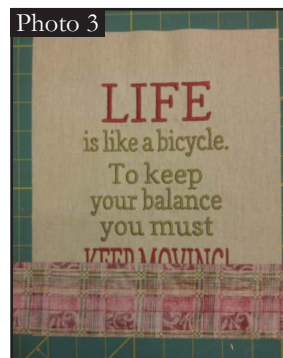
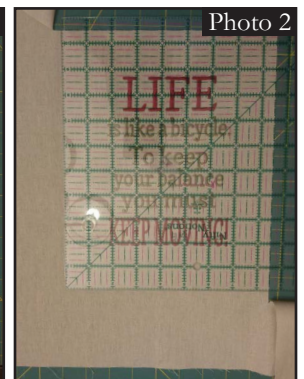
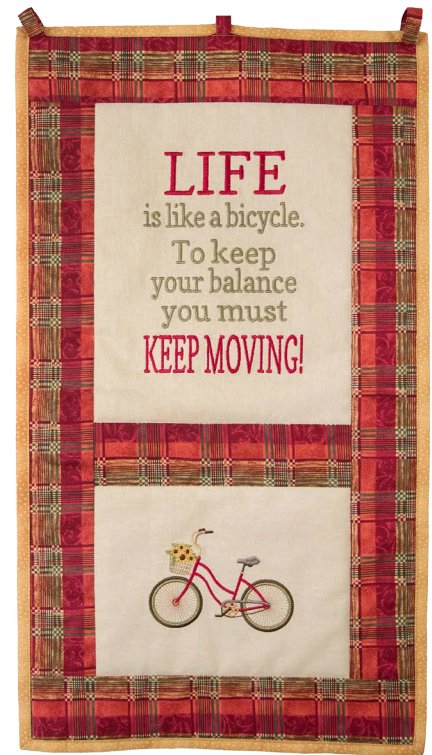
- OESD embroidery collection Home by Angela Anderson #80134
- Fabrics:
 - ½ yard solid fabric for embroidery
 - ½ yard fabric for backing
 - ¼ yard fabric for sashing, borders and hang tabs
- 18" x 25" piece of batting
- OESD Ultra Clean TearAway stabilizer
- OESD Light Weight TearAway stabilizer
- Temporary spray adhesive
- Embroidery thread
- Embroidery machine

Cut

- Cut solid fabric 12" x 16". Cut another piece of the solid fabric 10" x 12".
- Cut 2 - 2 ½" strips of the sashing fabric the width of the fabric. Cut 1 - 2" strip - 14" long.

Embroider

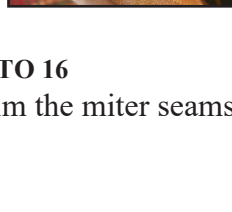
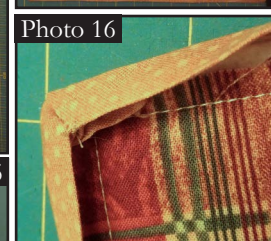
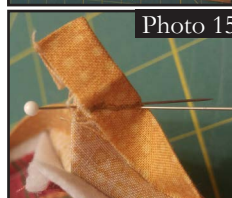
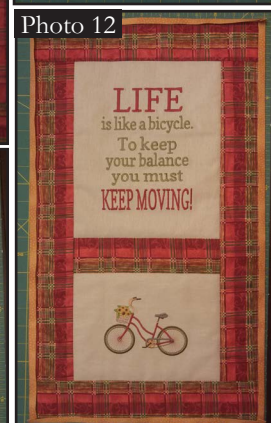
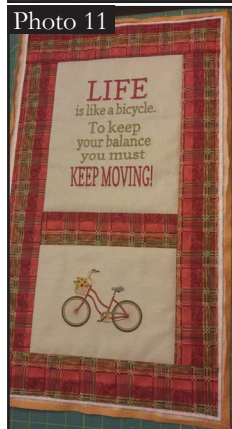
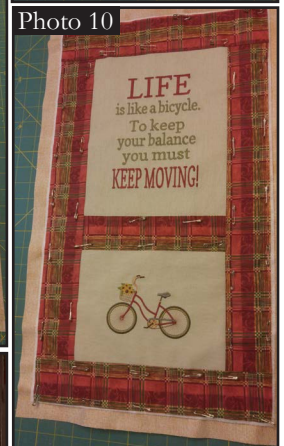
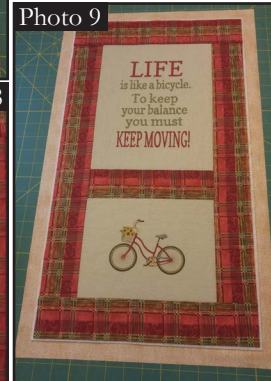
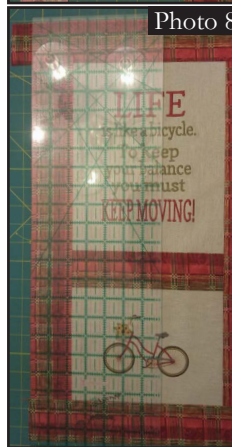
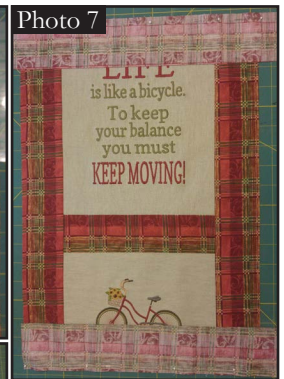
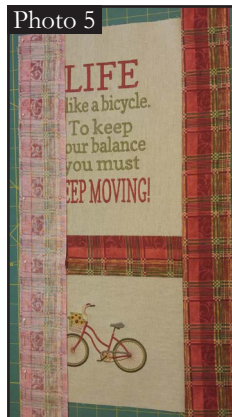
- Lightly spray together two layers of OESD Ultra Clean TearAway stabilizer cut large enough to accommodate a large hoop. Lightly spray one side of OESD Light TearAway stabilizer with temporary spray adhesive and attach to the two layers prepared. Spray the other side of the Ultra Clean TearAway with spray adhesive and attach to the 12" x 16" piece of solid fabric. Center the hoop on the fabric and hoop the fabric and stabilizer. **PHOTO 1**
- The first motif used for this project is #80134-03. Attach the hoop to the machine and stitch the design.
- Repeat the process for the 10" x 12" fabric piece using a hoop to accommodate design #80134-04.
- Remove excess stabilizer and trim loose threads.



Wall Hanging Construction

- Centering the designs, trim the larger piece to 8 ½" x 10 ½" – trim the smaller piece to 8 ½" x 6 ½". **PHOTO 2**
- Lay a 2 ½" strip face down at the bottom of the larger embroidered piece, raw edges even. Stitch a ¼" seam. For all other seams, continue to use a ¼" seam.
- Press the seam to one side and trim the ends of the strip even with the sides of the embroidered piece. **PHOTO 3**
- Lay the top of the smaller embroidered piece face down on the lower edge of the strip just sewn and stitch together. Press. **PHOTO 4**

- Divide the second 2 ½" strip into two equal pieces and stitch to each side of the embroidered unit. Press and trim ends extending past the solid fabrics. **PHOTOS 5 & 6**
- Divide the remainder of the first 2 ½" strip into two equal pieces and stitch to the top and bottom of the unit. Press and trim the ends. **PHOTOS 7 & 8**
- Place the unit on top of the batting piece and trim the batting, leaving ¼" of batting around the entire unit.
- Using another area of flat surface, place the backing piece face down and smooth. Carefully move the batting and wall hanging and center them over the backing piece with the batting side down.
- Trim the backing, leaving 1" of backing beyond the wall hanging on all sides (¾" beyond the batting). **PHOTO 9**
- Pin together the layers as desired. For the sample we stitched in the ditch around the embroidered rectangles. **PHOTO 10**
- Stitch around the entire wall hanging, stitching a ¼" inside the raw edge of the wall hanging unit.
- Fold and press ⅜" all around the raw edge of the backing to the front side. **PHOTO 11**
- Then fold and press toward the front so the folded edges of the backing lie just inside the stitching line around the edge of the wall hanging. **PHOTO 12**
- To miter corners, at each corner mark the folded edge where the stitching line intersects for each side of the corner. **PHOTOS 13 & 14**
- Fold each corner right sides together and sew from the marked intersection lines to the outer corner. **PHOTO 15**
- To check that the stitching correctly miter the corner, fold the corner right side out. **PHOTO 16**
- When satisfied that the corners are mitered, trim the miter seams and then carefully press them open. **PHOTO 17**



Making Hang Tabs and Finishing

- Fold the 2" strip in half lengthwise and press. Fold the raw edges to the center fold and press, then fold and press the two long pressed edges together. **PHOTO 18**
- Edge stitch both long edges of the strip.
- Insert one strip into the folded edge of the wall hanging at each top corner just inside the outside binding edges and pin in place. Insert the 3rd piece into the folded edge at the center of the top and pin in place.

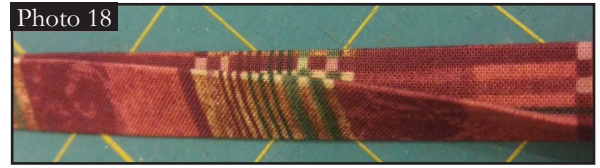

- Stitch the folded edge down all the way around the edge of the wall hanging.
- To attach the hang tabs to the back, fold the raw edges of each to the back $\frac{1}{8}$ " beyond the stitching line on the back. Pin in place from the front. Insert the machine presser foot just inside the loop from the front and stitch in the ditch. A narrow presser foot will allow you to stitch the width of the loop if you are very careful. **PHOTOS 20 & 21**
