Note: One spool of 1000 meter thread is adequate for the project unless otherwise noted.

MATERIALS



Example Stabilizers

- OESD Fusible Woven CutAway White
- OESD Fusible Woven CutAway Black
- OESD StabilStick CutAway
- OESD StabilStick Template Sheets

Example Fabrics/Textiles

- Start Here by OESD Garden Flag Black
 - Magenta quilter's cotton 3" x 3"
 - Yellow quilter's cotton 5" x 5"
 - Red quilter's cotton 3 1/2" x 3"
 - Tan quilter's cotton 2 1/2" x 3"
 - White quilter's cotton 3" x 3"
- Note: Fabric sizes are estimates and may result in overage.

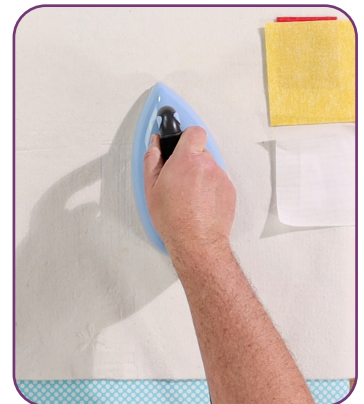
General Instructions

The applique instructions included in the design pack are general instructions for the collection. For demonstration purposes, a sample design that best represents the entire collection is shown. Fabric and thread requirements will vary by design, but the general technique will be the same.

Note: Some thread colors in instructions have been changed or digitally enhanced for better visibility.

□ Step 1

- Apply one layer of Fusible Woven to the wrong side of the applique fabrics.



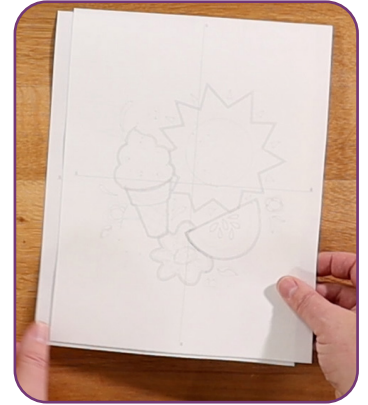
□ Step 2

- Apply one layer of Fusible Woven to the wrong side of the garden flag blank.



□ Step 3

- Print designs on StabilStick Template Sheets.



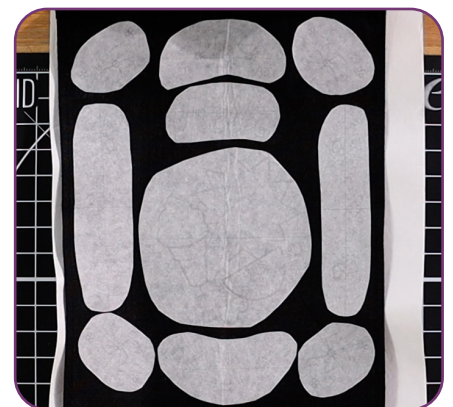
□ Step 4

- Cut approximately 1/4" - 1/2" outside the printed design templates.



□ Step 5

- Arrange templates on the garden flag blank.
- Peel the paper backing from the template.
Note: Press template on clothes to remove excess tackiness.
Tip: Save the paper to put the template back onto.
The templates are reusable.
- Affix the templates.

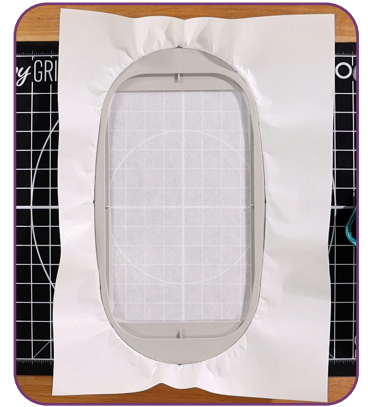


EMBROIDERY



□ Step 6

- Hoop StabilStick CutAway with the paper (shiny) side up.
- Score and remove paper to reveal the adhesive surface.



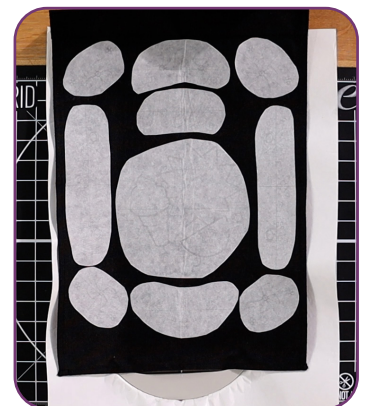
□ Step 7

- With templates attached, completely open the garden flag.
- Fold in half lengthwise and finger press.



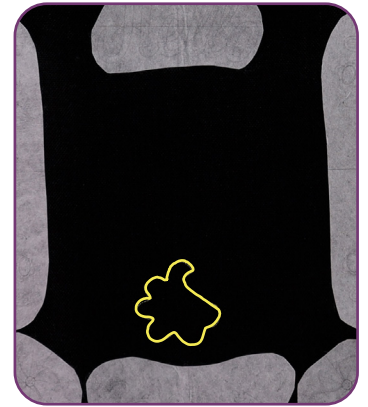
□ Step 8

- Center and place the folded garden flag along the center markings of the embroidery hoop.
- Unfold the garden flag and finger press to the stabilizer.



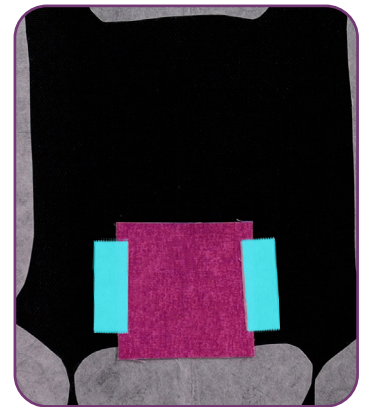
□ Step 9

- Load selected design into the machine.
- Example design is PK10019-01.
- Thread the machine per the thread chart.
- Place the hoop on the machine.
- Use the placement tools on the machine to align the design with the template.
- Remove the template from the garden flag before stitching.
- Stitch Machine Step 1, Magenta Fabric Placement Stitch.



□ Step 10

- Remove the hoop from the machine, but NOT the project from the hoop.
- Place the hoop on a flat surface.
- Completely cover the placement stitch with the prepared applique fabric.
- Tape in place to secure.



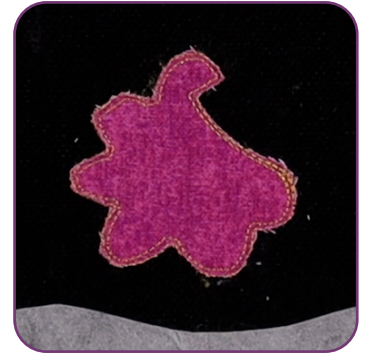
□ Step 11

- Return the hoop to the machine.
- Stitch Machine Step 2, Cut Line and Tackdown.



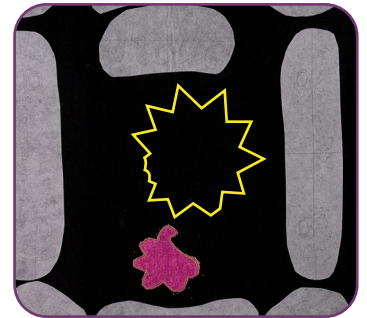
□ Step 12

- Remove the hoop from the machine, but NOT the project from the hoop.
- Trim the excess fabric as close to the cut line as possible. If the outermost stitches (cut line) are cut, the inner stitches (tackdown) will hold the applique in place.



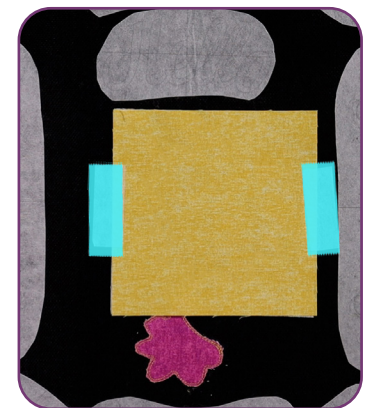
□ Step 13

- Return the hoop to the machine.
- Stitch Machine Step 3, Yellow Fabric Placement Stitch.



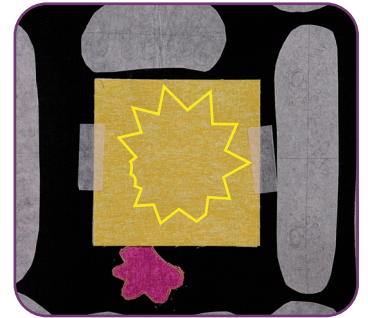
□ Step 14

- Remove the hoop from the machine, but NOT the project from the hoop.
- Place the hoop on a flat surface.
- Completely cover the placement stitch with the prepared applique fabric.
- Tape in place to secure.



□ Step 15

- Return the hoop to the machine.
- Stitch Machine Step 4, Cut Line and Tackdown.



□ Step 16

- Remove the hoop from the machine, but NOT the project from the hoop.
- Trim the excess fabric as close to the cut line as possible.



□ Step 17

- Repeat applique process three more times.



□ Step 18

- Return the hoop to the machine and stitch the remaining machine steps, per the thread chart.



□ Step 19

- When the center design is complete, remove the project from the hoop and trim the stabilizer 1/4" - 1/2" outside the design.



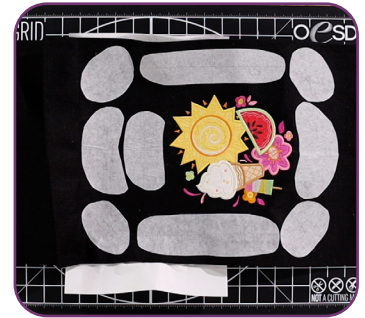
□ Step 20

- Hoop StabilStick CutAway with the paper (shiny) side up.
- Score and remove paper to reveal the adhesive surface.



□ Step 21

- Place the garden flag with the next design centered in the embroidery hoop.
- Finger press to the stabilizer.



□ Step 22

- Thread the machine per the thread chart.
- Place the hoop on the machine.
- Use the placement tools on the machine to align the design with the template.
- Remove the template from the garden flag before stitching.
- Stitch the design per the thread chart.



□ Step 23

- When the design is complete, remove the project from the hoop and trim the stabilizer 1/4" - 1/2" outside the design.



Step 24

- Continue until all designs have been stitched.



Step 25

The project is complete. Enjoy!





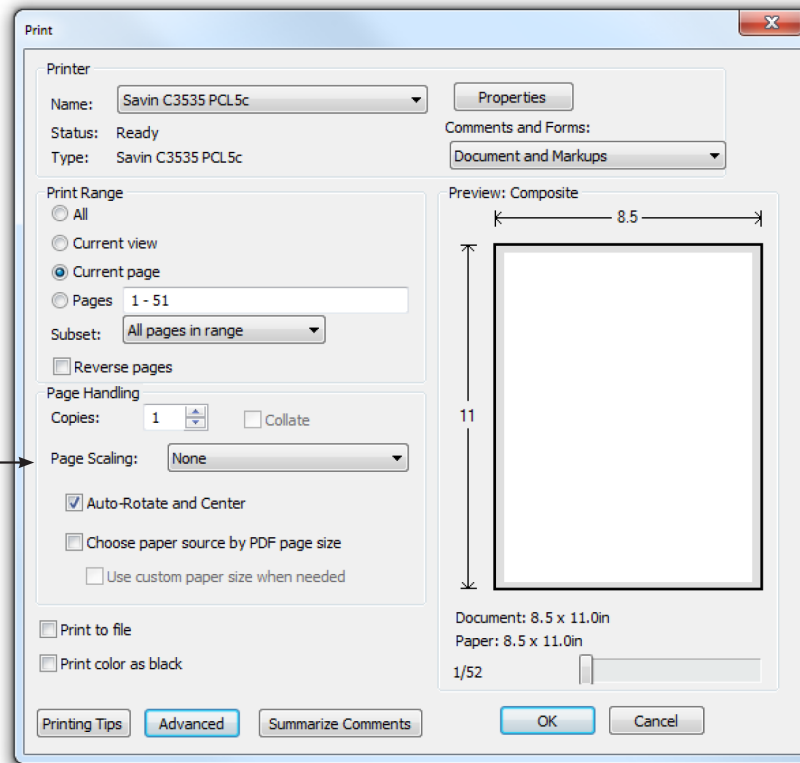

PRINTING INSTRUCTIONS

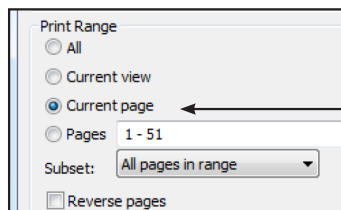
ATTENTION

When printing this document, any page scaling or page fitting options in your print dialog box must be turned OFF or set to NONE so that your files will print out at their actual size. Images not printed at actual size will not function as intended.



TO SAVE PAPER

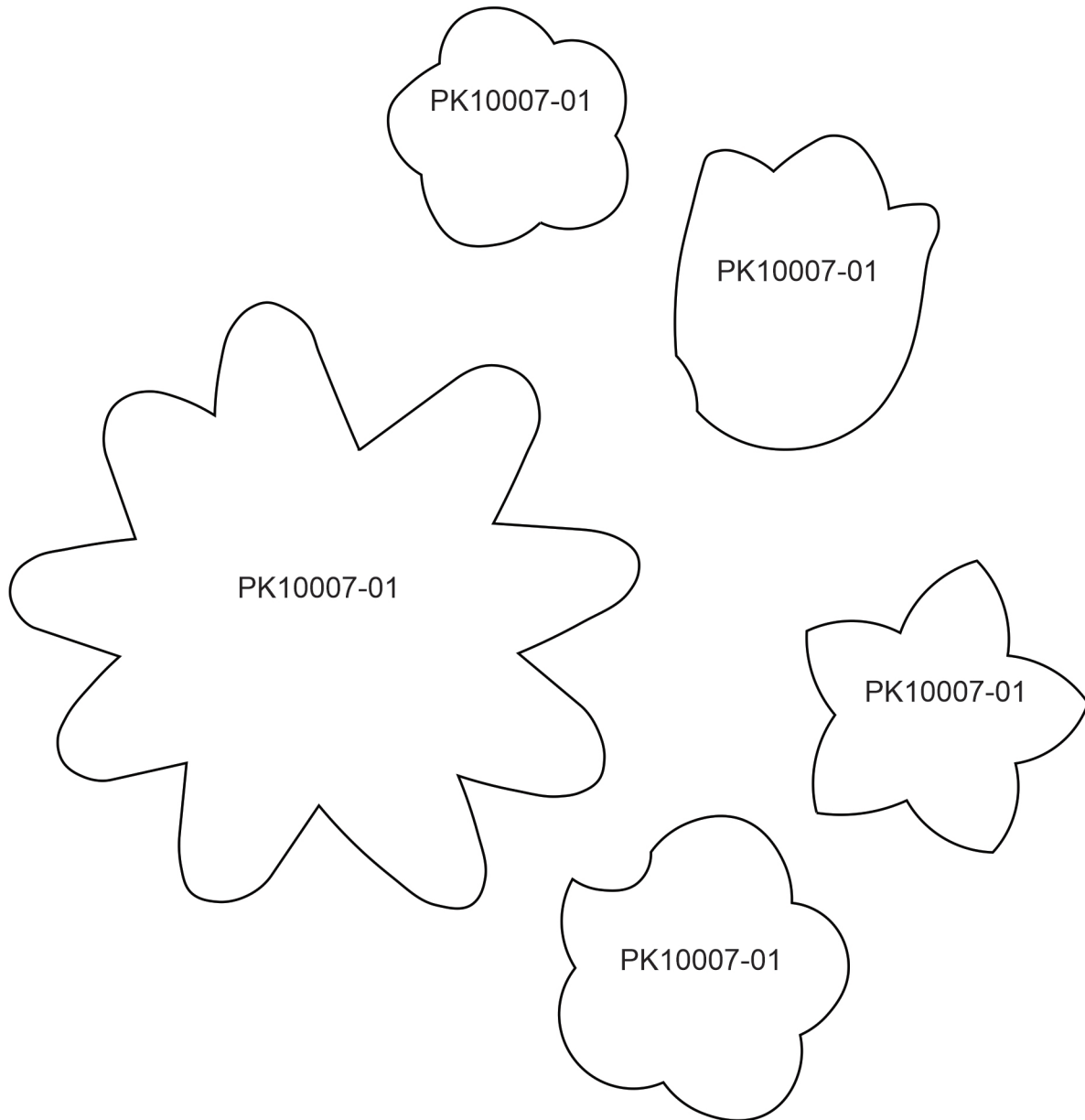
Only print the desired image by navigating to the image's page, go to File > Print and select "Current page" in the print dialog box. Repeat for each desired image.



APPLIQUE PATTERNS



Print at 100%. No scaling. This box measures 1" x 1". Use the box as an accuracy guide when printing templates.

Print at 100%. No scaling. This box measures 1" x 1". Use the box as an accuracy guide when printing templates.
