# MATERIALS



#### **Stabilizers**

- OESD Heavy Weight TearAway
- OESD Ultra Clean and Tear Tear Away
- OESD SoftWeb (paper backed fusible web)

#### Fabrics/Textiles

Example Includes:

- · White quilter's cotton
- · White Shimmer Organza
- Note: This design can be placed on woven or stretch fabrics. Stabilizers will vary.

- OESD Grippy GRID
- OESD Perfect Scoring Tool
- OESD Expert Embroidery Tape TearAway
- OESD Perfect Embroidery Press Cloth
- Embroidery Needle Sharp 75/11
- Non-stick applique pressing cloth (or parchment paper)

#### **General Instructions**


The applique instructions included in the collection are general instructions. For demonstration purposes, a sample design that best demonstrates the technique is shown. Fabric and thread requirements will vary by design, but the general technique is the same.

Note: Some thread colors in instructions have been changed or digitally enhanced for better visibility.

These instructions are for Designs PK10054-01, PK10054-03, and PK10054-04, following the thread charts for color changes. For design PK10054-02 stitch Machine Steps 1-8 per the thread chart. Place and press the organza prior to Machine Steps 10 and 11. Finish the machine steps per the thread chart.

### Step 1

- Print the mirrored version of the applique template onto regular paper.
- Trace the templates onto the paper side of the SoftWeb.
- **Note:** SoftWeb will be fused to the back side of the organza. SoftWeb is very sheer, so it won't affect the see through properties of the organza. It will also keep the organza from fraying around the outer edges.
- A non-stick pressing surface (such as freezer paper or parchment paper) will need to be placed under the SoftWeb and organza while fusing it to the organza. If one isn't used, the applique will stick to the ironing board.





#### Step 2

- Cut approximately 1/2" outside the traced applique templates.
- Place a non-stick pressing surface on the ironing board.
- Fuse the trimmed templates to the back of the organza with the paper side of the template face up. Use a medium temperature for the iron.
- **Note:** SoftWeb fuses very quickly to the organza.



#### Step 3

- Trim the organza on the outer edge of the outline.
- · Set aside.



#### Step 4

 Hoop one layer of Heavy Weight TearAway, one layer of Ultra Clean and Tear TearAway and fabric.





#### Step 5

- · Load selected design into the machine.
- Example design is PK10054-04.
- Thread the machine per the thread chart.
- Place the hoop on the machine.
- Stitch Machine Steps 1-3, Sticks, Stick Detail, and Organza Placement Fill, changing colors, per the thread chart.



#### Step 6

- · Remove the hoop from the machine, but NOT the project from the hoop.
- Place the hoop on a flat surface.
- On the back of the SoftWeb, use the OESD Perfect Scoring Tool to score and remove the paper backing.
- · Completely cover the placement fill with the prepared organza.
- · Cover with a non-stick pressing cloth and press to fuse to the embroidery.









### Step 7

- Return the hoop to the machine.
- Stitch Machine Step 4, Tackdown and Top.



## Step 8

· Stitch Machine Step 5, Organza Placement Fill.





### Step 9

- Remove the hoop from the machine, but NOT the project from the hoop.
- Place the hoop on a flat surface.
- On the back of the SoftWeb, use the OESD Perfect Scoring Tool to score and remove the paper backing.
- · Completely cover the placement fill with the prepared organza.
- · Cover with a non-stick pressing cloth and press to fuse to the embroidery.





### Step 10

- · Return the hoop to the machine.
- Stitch Machine Step 6, Tackdown and Top.





#### Step 11

• Stitch Machine Steps 7-12, following Steps 9 and 10 of the instructions.



## Step 12

• Stitch the remaining Machine Steps per the thread chart.





### Step 13

- When the design is complete, remove the hoop from the machine and the design from the hoop.
- Gently tear away the excess stabilizer.
- Press right side down on a Perfect Embroidery Press Cloth.
- Your design is complete. Enjoy!




