# MATERIALS

# MATERIALS



## Stabilizers

- OESD AquaMesh WashAway
- OESD BadgeMaster WashAway

## Fabrics/Textiles

- OESD Clear Vinyl- 1 roll
- Organza 1/4 yard

Note: Fabric sizes are estimates and may result in overage.

## Notion & Tools

- Expert Embroidery Tape TearAway
- Expert Embroidery Tape WashAway
- OESD Perfect Embroidery Press Cloth
- Grippy GRID
- Embroidery Needle Sharp 75/11
- Suction cup hooks for hanging

## Isacord Thread Colors

- Per thread chart
- All designs are stitched with matching thread, top and bobbin.





## General Instructions

The freestanding applique instructions, included in the collection, are general instructions. For demonstration purposes, a sample design that best demonstrates the technique is shown. Fabric and thread requirements will vary by design, but the general technique is the same.

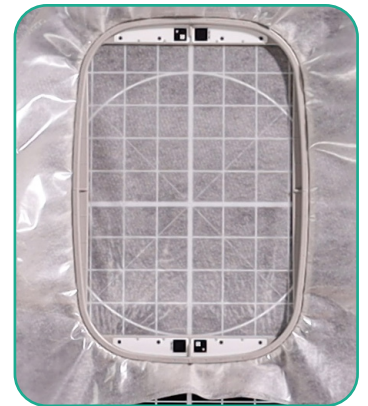
**The design used in the embroidery instructions are from PK10018, Stain Glass Folk Flowers, which used the same applique technique.**

All designs are stitched with matching thread in the top and bobbin.

Note: Some thread colors in the instructions have been changed or digitally enhanced for better visibility.

### Step 1

- Hoop one layer of AquaMesh and one layer of BadgeMaster for all designs.



### Step 2

- Load selected design into the machine.
- Example design is PK10018-01.
- Thread the machine per the thread chart.
- Place hoop on the machine.
- Stitch Machine Step 1, Clear Vinyl Placement Stitch.





## □ Step 6

- Remove the hoop from the machine, but NOT the project from the hoop.
- Place the hoop on a flat surface.
- Trim the excess organza as close to the cut line stitching as possible.
- Trim the excess vinyl as close to the cut line stitching as possible.
- If the outermost stitches (cut line) are cut, the inner stitches (tackdown) will hold the applique in place.  
Tip: If the stabilizer is cut or a hole is created while trimming the fabric, use Expert Embroidery Tape WashAway as a patch.



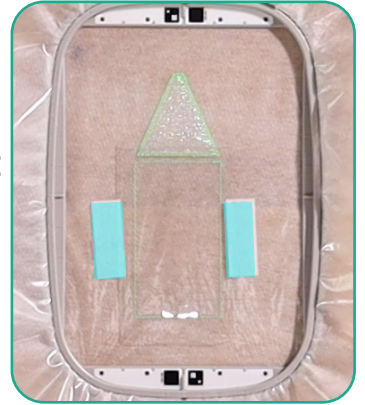
## □ Step 7

- Return the hoop to the machine.
- Stitch Machine Step 3, Clear Vinyl Placement Stitch.



## □ Step 8

- Remove the hoop from the machine, but NOT the project from the hoop.
- Place the hoop on a flat surface.
- Place the clear vinyl, completely covering the placement stitch.
- Tape in place to secure.



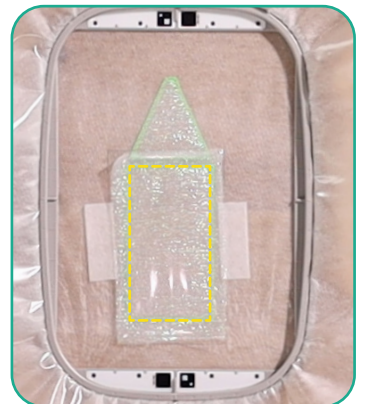
## □ Step 9

- Place the organza, completely covering the placement stitch.
- Tape in place to secure.



## □ Step 10

- Return the hoop to the machine.
- Stitch Machine Step 4, Cut Line and Tackdown.









# ASSEMBLY

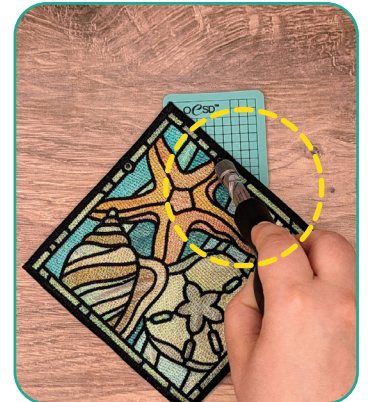
## □ Step 14

- Rinse each piece in warm running water until the design is only slightly tacky.
- Place right side down on a non-stick surface to dry. Parchment paper or a cooling rack work well to prevent curling. Dry completely.
- Once dry, press right side down on a Perfect Embroidery Press Cloth.
- Tip: Clear vinyl is safe to press on low heat.



## □ Step 15

- Before assembly, use the OESD Mini MAT and Punch Tool with the 3 mm attachment to create the eyelets indicated in the Punch Tool Guide on page 10.



## □ Step 16

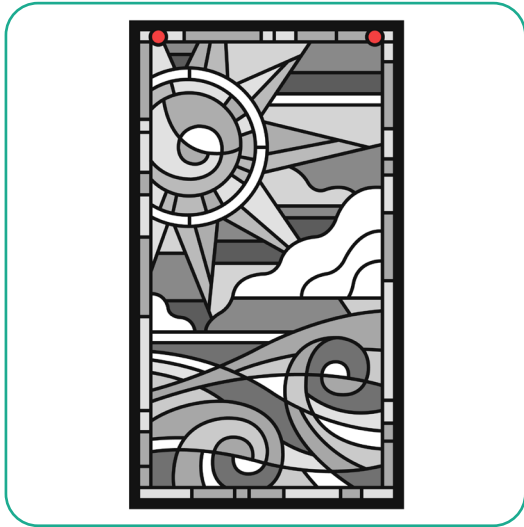
- Slide the suction cup hooks through the eyelets and attach to a window.



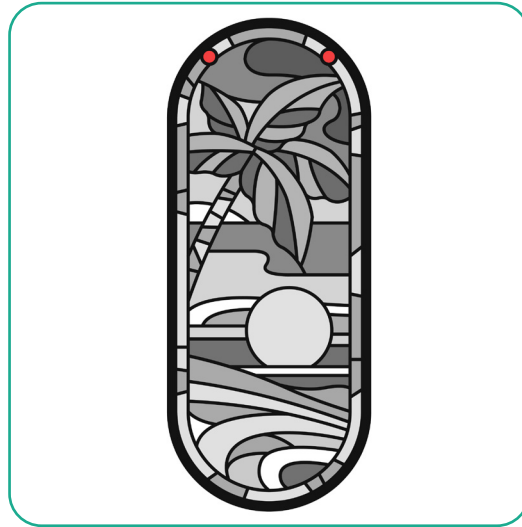

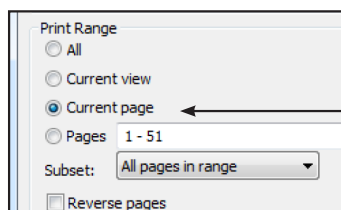
## ATTENTION

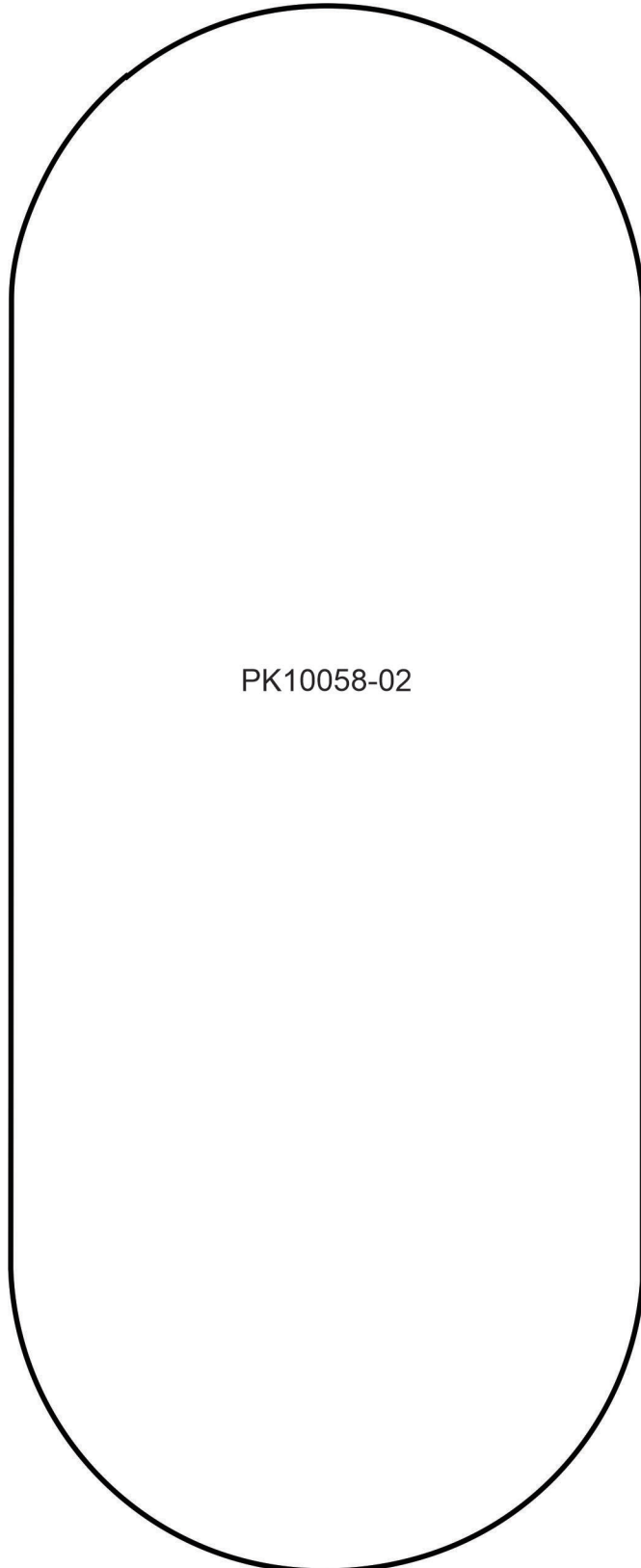

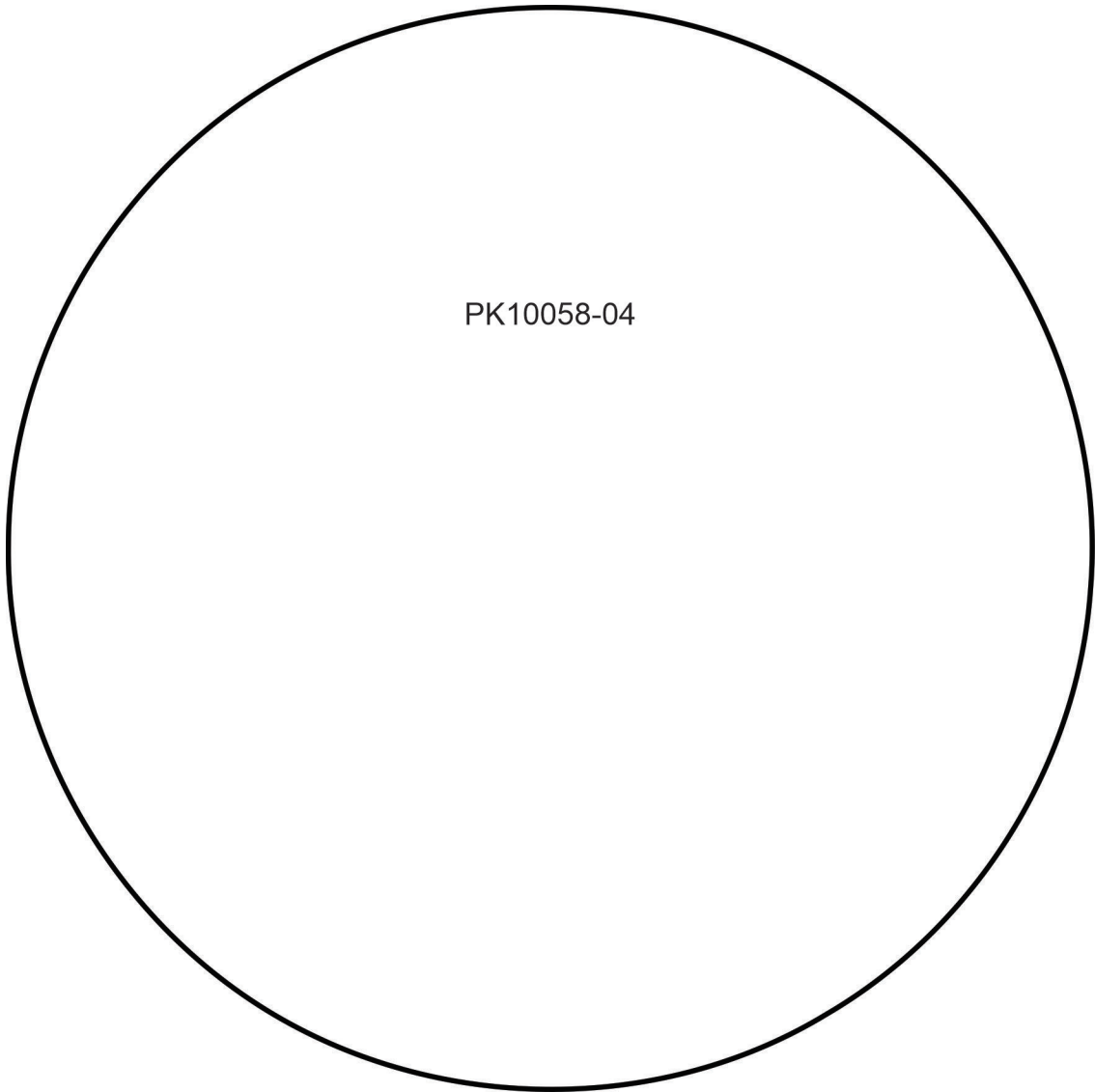

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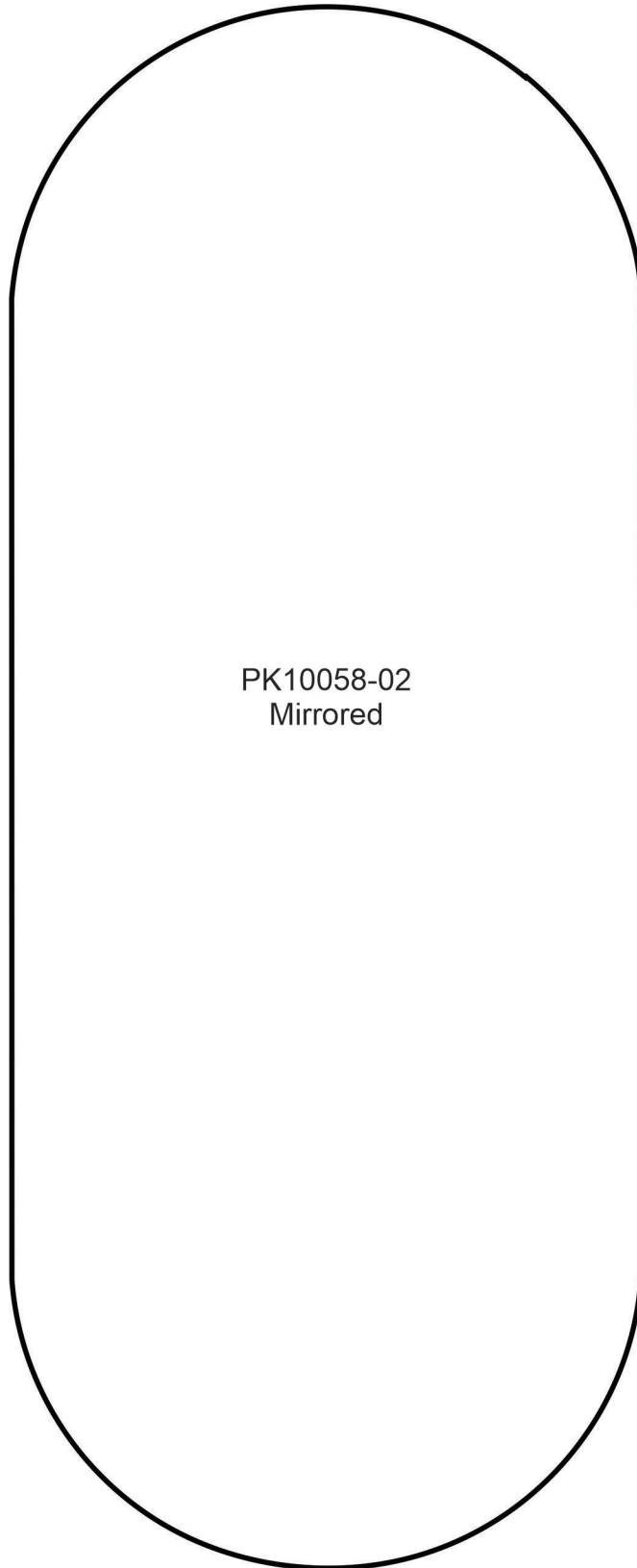

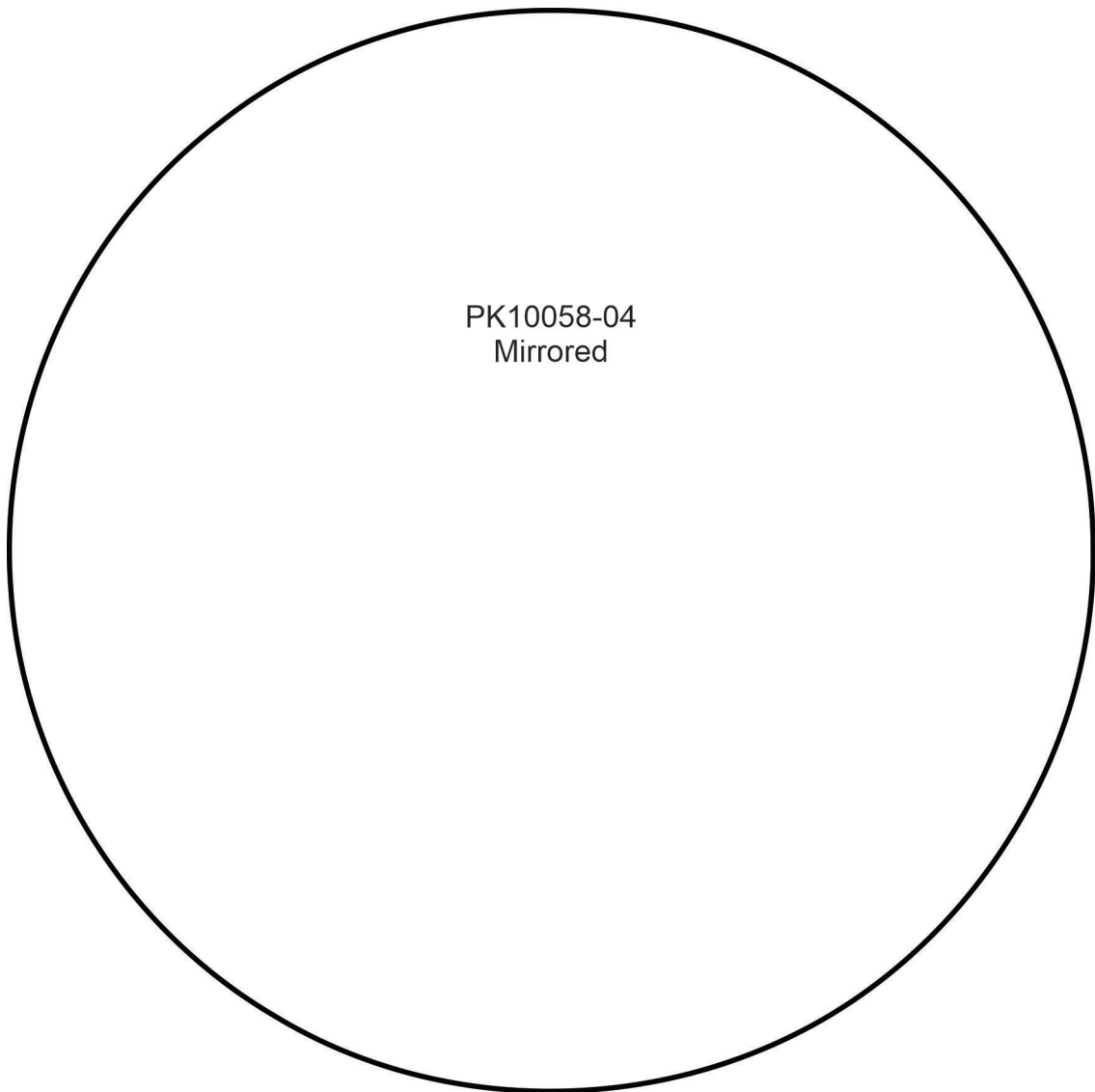
