

General Instructions

The instructions included in the collection are general instructions. For demonstration purposes, a sample design that best demonstrates the technique is shown. Fabric and thread requirements will vary by design, but the general technique is the same.

Note: Some thread colors in the instructions have been changed or digitally enhanced for better visibility.

Step 1

- Print the mirrored version of the templates (at 100% scale or 1:1 ratio) onto the paper side of Applique Fuse and Fix.
- Cut approximately ¼" ½" outside the printed applique templates.



Step 2

- Cut the fabric ¼" ½" larger than the applique templates.
- Fuse the trimmed templates to the back of the fabric with the paper side of the printed template up. Hold the iron on the template for 10-15 seconds for a secure fuse.






Step 3

- Trim the fabric on the edge of the black outline.
- Set aside.



Step 4

 Hoop one layer of Light Weight TearAway for all designs.



Step 5

- · Load selected design into the machine.
- Example design is PK10067-01.
- Thread the machine per the thread chart.
- Place the hoop on the machine.
- Stitch Machine Step 1, Tan Felt Placement Stitch.





Step 6

- Remove the hoop from the machine, but NOT the project from the hoop.
- Place the hoop on a flat surface.
- · Completely cover the placement stitch with brown felt.
- Tape in place to secure.



Step 7

- Return the hoop to the machine.
- Stitch Machine Step 2, Orange Fabric Placement Stitch.



Step 8

- Remove the hoop from the machine, but NOT the project from the hoop.
- Place the hoop on a flat surface.
- On the back of the applique fabric, use the OESD Perfect Scoring Tool to score and remove the paper backing to reveal the adhesive surface.
- Place the applique fabric within the placement stitching.
- Finger press to secure.





Step 9

- Return the hoop to the machine.
- Stitch Machine Step 3, Tackdown.



Step 10

• Stitch Machine Step 4, White Fabric Placement Stitch.



Step 11

- Remove the hoop from the machine, but NOT the project from the hoop.
- Place the hoop on a flat surface.
- On the back of the applique fabric, use the OESD Perfect Scoring Tool to score and remove the paper backing to reveal the adhesive surface.
- · Place the applique fabric within the placement stitching.
- Finger press to secure.





Step 12

- Return the hoop to the machine.
- Stitch Machine Steps 5 6.



Step 13

- Remove the hoop from the machine, but NOT the project from the hoop.
- Turn the hoop over and place the brown felt completely covering the placement stitch.
- · Carefully tape to secure.
- Tip: Avoid pushing too hard on the stabilizer to prevent it from dislodging from the hoop.



Step 14

- Return the hoop to the machine.
- Change bobbin to match the top thread.
- Stitch Machine Step 7, Seam.





Step 15

- When the design is complete, remove the project from the hoop.
- Trim excess stabilizer and felt 1/8" to 1/4" from the seam lines.



Step 16

• Pull ribbon through the channel as shown.



Step 17

• The project is complete. Enjoy!





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
TO SAVE PAPER

Only print the desired image by navigating to the image's page, go to File > Print and select "Current page" in the print dialog box. Repeat for each desired image.




