

DOUBLE SIDED FREESTANDING APPLIQUE



General Instructions

The freestanding applique instructions, included in the collection, are general instructions. For demonstration purposes, a sample design that best demonstrates the technique is shown. Fabric and thread requirements will vary by design, but the general technique is the same. All designs are stitched with matching thread, top and bottom.

Note: Some thread colors in the instructions have been changed or digitally enhanced for better visibility.

Step 1

- Print the mirrored version of the templates (at 100% scale or 1:1 ratio) onto the paper side of Applique Fuse and Fix.
- Cut approximately 1/4" 1/2" outside the printed applique templates.





- Cut the Fiber Form 1/4" 1/2" larger than the applique templates that are included at the end of the instructions.
- Fuse the trimmed templates to the back of the Fiber Form with the paper side of the printed template up. Hold the iron on the template for 10 - 15 seconds for a secure fuse.





Step 3

- Trim the Fiber Form on the edge of the black outline.
- Set aside.






- Cut the applique fabrics 1/4" 1/2" larger than the templates that are included at the end of the instructions.
- Adhere one layer of StabilStick CutAway to the wrong side of the applique fabrics to provide stiffness to the finished sign.






Step 5

 Hoop one layer of AquaMesh and one layer of BadgeMaster for all designs.





- Load selected design into the machine.
- Example design is PK10075-04.
- Thread the machine per the thread chart.
- Match the bobbin thread to the top thread.
- Place the hoop on the machine.
- Stitch Machine Step 1, Fiber Form/Front and Back Brown Fabric Placement Stitch.



Step 7

- Remove the hoop from the machine, but NOT the project from the hoop.
- Place the hoop on a flat surface.
- On the back of the Fiber Form, use the OESD Perfect Scoring Tool to score and remove the paper backing to reveal the adhesive surface.
- Place the Fiber Form within the placement stitching.
- Finger press to secure. Tip: Applique Fuse and Fix is repositionable.









- Completely cover the Fiber Form with the prepared brown applique fabric.
- Tape in place to secure.



Step 9

- Turn the hoop over and place the prepared brown applique fabric, right side up, completely covering the placement stitch.
- · Carefully tape to secure.
- Tip: Avoid pushing too hard on the stabilizer to prevent it from dislodging from the hoop.



___ Step 10


- Return the hoop to the machine.
- Stitch Machine Step 2, Cut Line and Tackdown.





- Remove the hoop from the machine, but NOT the project from the hoop.
- · Place the hoop on a flat surface.
- Trim the excess fabric as close to the cut line stitching as possible. If the outermost stitches (cut line) are cut, the inner stitches (tackdown) will hold the applique in place.

Tip: If the stabilizer is cut or a hole is created while trimming the fabric, use OESD Expert Embroidery Tape WashAway as a patch.



Step 12

• Turn the hoop over and trim the excess fabric as close to the cut line as possible.



Step 13

- Return the hoop to the machine.
- Stitch Machine Step 3, Fiber Form/Front and Back Pink Fabric Placement Stitch.





- Remove the hoop from the machine, but NOT the project from the hoop.
- · Place the hoop on a flat surface.
- On the back of the Fiber Form, score and remove the paper backing to reveal the adhesive surface.
- · Place the Fiber Form within the placement stitching.
- Finger press to secure.



Step 15

- Completely cover the placement stitch with the prepared pink applique fabric.
- Tape in place to secure.



Step 16

- Turn the hoop over and place the prepared pink applique fabric, right side up, completely covering the placement stitch.
- Carefully tape to secure.





- Return the hoop to the machine.
- Stitch Machine Step 4, Cut Line and Tackdown



Step 18

- Remove the hoop from the machine, but NOT the project from the hoop.
- Place the hoop on a flat surface.
- Trim the excess fabric as close to the cut line as possible.



Step 19

Turn the hoop over and trim the excess fabric as close to the cut line as possible.





- · Return the hoop to the machine.
- Stitch the remaining machine steps, changing threads per the thread chart.



Step 21

• When the design is complete, remove the project from the hoop and trim the stabilizer 1/4" - 1/2" outside the design.


Step 22

- Rinse each piece in warm running water until the design is only slightly tacky.
- · Place right side down on a non-stick surface to dry. This will help prevent curling.
- Parchment paper or a cooling rack work well to keep the design from sticking to the surface.
- Dry completely.
- Once dry, press right side down on a Perfect Embroidery Press Cloth.




Step 23

Line up the 2 Cookie Box Right & Left Side FSA (PK10075-04), right side up, on opposite sides of the right side up Cookie Box Base FSA (PK10075-06).



Step 24

- Line up the 2 Cookie Box Front & Back FSA (PK10075-05), right side up, on the other 2 sides of the Cookie Box Base FSA.
- Thread the sewing machine with matching thread on the top and bobbin.
- Stitch together, around the base, using a multi-step zigzag stitch.
- Back stitch at the beginning and end to secure.
- Trim thread tails.
- Fold and press into shape.




ASSEMBLY



Step 25

 Match the eyelets on the Cookie Box Right & Left Sides to the buttonettes on the Cookie Box Front & Back. Pull each buttonette through the corresponding eyelet. If needed, attach a button clip to temporarily hold the buttonette in place.



Step 26

 To close the lid, fold the two rounded tops of the Cookie Box Front & Back inward.

Step 27

• Fold the two cookie halves of the Cookie Box Right & Left Sides inward, bending slightly to slide the pair together.






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TO SAVE PAPER

Only print the desired image by navigating to the image's page, go to File > Print and select "Current page" in the print dialog box. Repeat for each desired image.






PK10075-01 Fiber Form & Front Fabric





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


