

General Instructions


The instructions included in the collection are general instructions. For demonstration purposes, a sample design that best demonstrates the technique is shown. **Design PK10079-05 is shown.** Fabric and thread requirements will vary by design, but the general technique is the same.

NOTE: Some thread colors in the instructions have been changed or digitally enhanced for better visibility.

These gift card holders require two designs (front and back of gift card holder) to complete. Make sure you embroider the front of the gift card holder first!

Step 1

Cut OESD Start Here Greeting Cards, size A7 (5" x 7") into (2) 5" x 7" pieces






Step 2

• Hoop 1 layer of OESD Medium Weight TearAway.



Step 3

- · Load selected design into the machine.
- Example design is PK10079-05.
- · Thread the machine per the thread chart.
- Place the hoop on the machine.
- Stitch Machine Step 1, Card Stock Placement Stitch.



Step 4

- Remove the hoop from the machine, but NOT the project from the hoop.
- Place the hoop on a flat surface.
- Place one piece of cardstock within the placement stitch.
 - NOTE: Carefully align the top and left edges of the cardstock with the placement stitch.
- Tape in place with OESD Expert Embroidery Tape TearAway to secure.





Step 5

- Return the hoop to the machine.
- Stitch the remaining machine steps per the thread chart.



Step 6

- Remove the hoop from the machine and the project from the hoop.
- On a flat surface, fold the stabilizer back and carefully cut the stabilizer away, inside of the stitching.

Note: Cutting away the excess TearAway stabilizer prevents bending or creasing the cardstock.










Step 7

Hoop 1 layer of Medium Weight TearAway.



Step 8

- Load selected design into the machine.
- Example design PK10079-06.
- Thread the machine per the thread chart.
- Place the hoop on the machine.
- Stitch Machine Step 1, Card Stock Placement Stitch.



Step 9

- Remove the hoop from the machine, but NOT the project from the hoop.
- Place the hoop on a flat surface.
- Place the second piece of cardstock within the placement stitch.
 - NOTE: Carefully align the top and left edges of the cardstock with the placement stitch.
- Tape in place to secure.





Step 10

- Place the embroidered cardstock within the placement stitch, over the blank card, right side up.
- Note: Carefully align the top and left edges of the cardstock with the placement stitch.
- Tape in place to secure.



Step 11

- Return the hoop to the machine.
- Stitch the remaining machine steps per the thread chart.



ASSEMBLY



Step 12

- Remove the hoop from the machine and the project from the hoop.
- Trim just inside the Cut Guide stitching.



Step 13

• Gently remove the excess stabilizer from the back, being careful not to bend or crease the pieces.



ASSEMBLY



Step 14

- Place a gift card in the holder and give to your favorite person.
- The project is complete. Enjoy!
