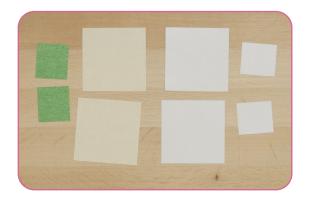
General Instructions

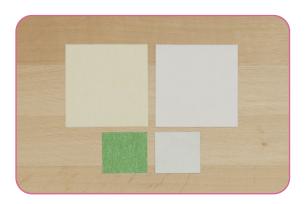
The coaster instructions, included in the collection, are general instructions. For demonstration purposes, a sample design that best demonstrates the technique is shown. Design PK10100-02 is shown here. Fabric and thread requirements will vary by design, but the general technique is the same.

NOTE: Some thread colors in the instructions have been changed or digitally enhanced for better visibility.

Step 1

- Cut the applique fabrics 1/4" 1/2" larger than the applique patterns or as listed in the cutting summary. The applique patterns are included at the end of the instructions.
- Adhere one layer of StabilStick CutAway to the wrong side of all applique fabrics to provide stiffness to the finished coaster.







Step 2

 Using the OESD Grippy Grid, hoop one layer of Aquamesh and one layer of BadgeMaster for all designs.



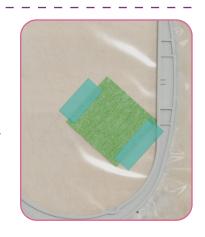
Step 3

- Load the selected design into the machine.
- Example design is PK10100-02.
- Thread the machine per the thread chart.
- Place the hoop on the machine.
- Stitch Machine Step 1, Green Fabric Placement Stitch.



Step 4

- Remove the hoop from the machine, but NOT the project from the hoop.
- Place the hoop on a flat surface.
- Completely cover the placement stitch with the prepared green applique fabric.
- Tape in place with OESD Expert Embroidery Tape TearAway to secure.





Step 5

- Return the hoop to the machine.
- Stitch Machine Step 2, Cut Line and Tackdown.



Step 6

- Remove the hoop from the machine, but NOT the project from the hoop.
- Trim the excess fabric as close to the cut line as possible. If the outermost stitches (cut line) are cut, the inner stitches (tackdown) will hold the applique in place.
- Tip: If the stabilizer is cut or a hole is created while trimming the fabric, use OESD Expert Embroidery Tape WashAway as a patch.



Step 7

- Return the hoop to the machine.
- Stitch Machine Step 3, Yellow Fabric Placement Stitch.





Step 8

- Remove the hoop from the machine, but NOT the project from the hoop.
- Place the hoop on a flat surface.
- Completely cover the placement stitch with the prepared yellow applique fabric.
- Tape in place to secure.



Step 9

- · Return the hoop to the machine.
- Stitch Machine Step 4, Cut Line and Tackdown.



Step 10

- Remove the hoop from the machine, but NOT the project from the hoop.
- Trim the excess fabric as close to the cut line as possible.





Step 11

- Return the hoop to the machine.
- Stitch Machine Steps 5 9.



Step 12

- Remove the hoop from the machine, but NOT the project from the hoop.
- Turn the hoop over and place the prepared green applique fabric, right side up, completely covering the placement stitch.
- · Carefully tape to secure.
- Tip: Avoid pushing too hard on the stabilizer to prevent it from dislodging from the hoop.



Step 13

- Return the hoop to the machine.
- Stitch Machine Step 10, Cut Line and Tackdown.





Step 14

- Remove the hoop from the machine, but NOT the project from the hoop.
- Turn the hoop over.
- Trim the excess fabric as close to the cut line as possible.



Step 15

- · Return the hoop to the machine.
- Match the bobbin thread to the top thread.
- Stitch Machine Step 11, Cover Stitch.



Step 16

- Match the bobbin thread to the top thread.
- Stitch Machine Step 12, Yellow Fabric Placement Stitch.





Step 17

- Remove the hoop from the machine, but NOT the project from the hoop.
- Turn the hoop over and place the prepared yellow applique fabric, right side up, completely covering the placement stitch.
- · Carefully tape to secure.
- Tip: Avoid pushing too hard on the stabilizer to prevent it from dislodging from the hoop.



Step 18

- · Return the hoop to the machine.
- Stitch Machine Step 13, Cut Line and Tackdown.



Step 19

- Remove the hoop from the machine, but NOT the project from the hoop.
- Turn the hoop over.
- Trim the excess fabric as close to the cut line as possible.





Step 20

- Return the hoop to the machine.
- Match the bobbin thread to the top thread.
- Stitch Machine Step 14, Cover Stitch.



Step 21

- When the design is complete, remove the project from the hoop.
- Trim the stabilizer 1/4" 1/2" outside the design.



FINISHING TOUCHES



Step 22

- Rinse the coaster in warm running water until the design is only slightly tacky.
- Place right side down on a non-stick surface to dry.
 Parchment paper or a cooling rack work well. Dry completely.
- Once dry, press right side down on an OESD Perfect Embroidery Press Cloth.
