












EMBROIDERY



General Instructions

The instructions, included in the collection, are general instructions. For demonstration purposes, a sample design that best demonstrates the technique is shown. Design PK10103-04 is shown here. Fabric and thread requirements will vary by design, but the general technique is the same. The instructions show embroidering the design on a hand towel. The stabilizer selected is partially dependent on base fabric and might change when embroidering the design on a different fabric type.

Note: Some thread colors in the instructions have been changed or digitally enhanced for better visibility.

Step 1

 Using the OESD Grippy Grid hoop one layer of Ultra Clean and Tear Plus paper (shiny) side up.

Step 2

- Use the OESD Perfect Scoring Tool to score and remove the paper to reveal the adhesive surface.
- Place a towel on the stabilizer.
- Finger press to secure.
- Tip: The Grippy Grid lines can assist with placement.





Step 3

- Cover the towel with a piece of StitcH2O WashAway.
- Tape in place with OESD Expert Embroidery Tape TearAway to secure.
- Note: The StitcH2O is used to hold the pile of the towel in place while the design is embroidering.

Step 4

- · Load the selected design into the machine.
- Example design is PK10103-04.
- · Thread the machine with the desired thread color.
- Place the hoop on the machine.
- · Stitch Machine Step 1, Globe and Stand.
- Note: Thread shown is KingStar Metallic Gold MG2.



Step 5

- Stitch Machine Step 2, Design.
- Note: Thread shown is Isacord 0101.



FINISHING TOUCHES



Step 6

- When the design is complete, remove the project from the hoop.
- Tear away the excess stabilizer, both top and bottom.
- Tip: Use the tip of the Perfect Scoring Tool to assist in tearing away the stabilizer from the center. If some of the Ultra Clean and Tear Plus is left after tearing it away, it will soften and break down with every wash.



Step 7

- Remove the excess StitcH2O with water.
- Press gently right side down on an OESD Perfect Embroidery Press Cloth.



Step 8

· The project is complete. Enjoy!
