General Instructions

The instructions, included in the collection, are general instructions. For demonstration purposes, sample designs that best demonstrate the techniques are shown. Designs PK10149-09 and PK10149-03 are shown here.

The Freestanding Lace (FSL) ornamentations must be embroidered before the Flip Flop Applique design.

Any of the Freestanding Lace ornaments in this collection can be attached to any of the Flip Flop Applique designs allowing for copious combinations.

Fabric and thread requirements will vary by design, but the general technique is the same. Applique technique shown is cut in place. Pre-cut applique patterns are included at the end of the instructions.

The instructions show embroidering the design on a cotton base. The stabilizer selected is partially dependent on base fabric and might change when embroidering the design on a different fabric type.

 **Note: Some thread colors in the instructions have been changed or digitally enhanced for better visibility.**

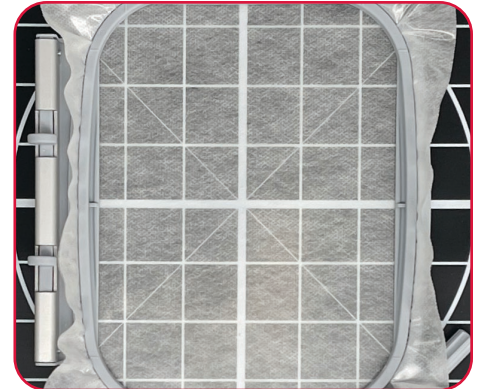


EMBROIDERY- FSL ORNAMENT



□ Step 1

- Using the OESD Grippy Grid, hoop one layer of AquaMesh and one layer of BadgeMaster.



□ Step 2

- Load the selected design into the machine.
- Example design is PK10149-09.
- Thread the machine per the thread chart.
- Place the hoop on the machine.
- Stitch Machine Steps 1 - 3 **with matching bobbin thread.**



✍ **Note:** For additional instructions and tips on embroidering Freestanding Lace (FSL), refer to the General Freestanding Lace Guide at the end of the instructions.



□ Step 3

- When the design is complete, remove the project from the hoop.
- Trim the stabilizer 1/4" - 1/2" outside the design.



□ Step 4

- Rinse the ornament in warm running water until the design is only slightly tacky.
- Place right side down on a non-stick surface to dry. Parchment paper or a cooling rack work well. Dry completely.
- Once dry, press right side down on an OESD Perfect Embroidery Press Cloth.



✓ Note: Using the Perfect Embroidery Press Cloth when pressing your design helps prevent the stitches from becoming crushed and absorbs steam for a perfectly pressed finish.

Embroidery - Flip Flop Applique

- Flip Flop Applique 1 PK10149-01
- Flip Flop Applique 2 PK10149-02
- Flip Flop Applique 3 PK10149-03

□ Step 5

- Apply OESD Fusible Woven to the back of the background fabric, per the product directions.



Step 6

- Cut the applique fabrics 1/4" - 1/2" larger than the applique patterns. The applique patterns are included at the end of the instructions.
- Fuse one layer of SoftWeb to the wrong side of all applique fabrics to provide body to the fabric.



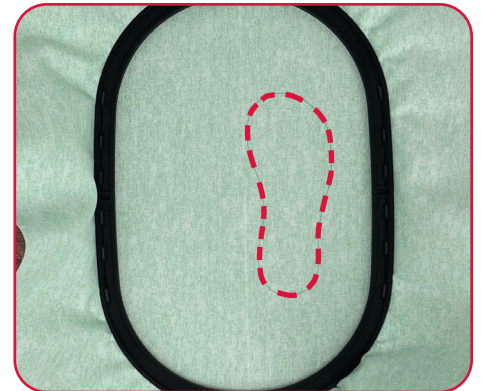
Step 7

- Using the OESD Grippy Grid, hoop background fabric with one layer of Medium Weight Tear Away.



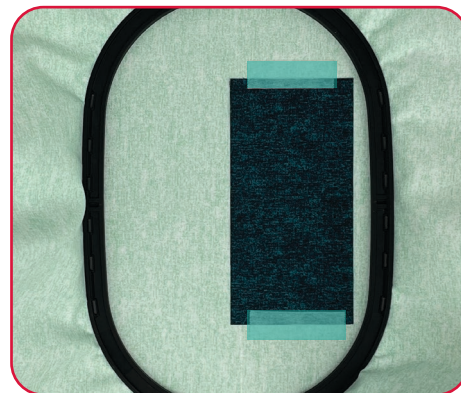
Step 8

- Load the selected design into the machine.
- Example design is PK10149-03.
- Thread the machine per the thread chart.
- Place the hoop on the machine.
- Stitch Machine Step 1, Right Flop Blue Fabric Placement Stitch.



Step 9

- Remove the hoop from the machine, but NOT the project from the hoop.
- Place the hoop on a flat surface.
- Remove the paper backing off the SoftWeb on the blue applique fabric.
- Completely cover the placement stitch with the prepared blue applique fabric.
- Tape in place with OESD Expert Embroidery Tape TearAway to secure.



□ Step 10

- Return the hoop to the machine.
- Stitch Machine Step 2, Cut Line and Tackdown.



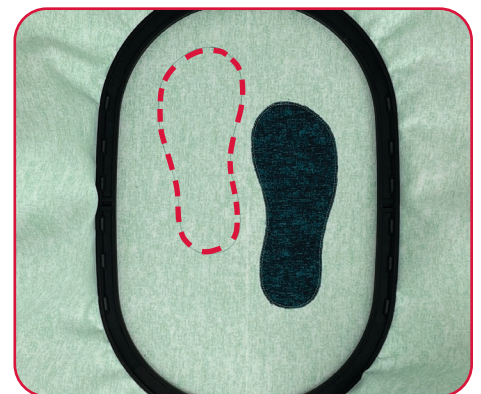
□ Step 11

- Remove the hoop from the machine, but NOT the project from the hoop.
- Trim the excess fabric as close to the cut line as possible. If the outermost stitches (cut line) are cut, the inner stitches (tackdown) will hold the applique in place.



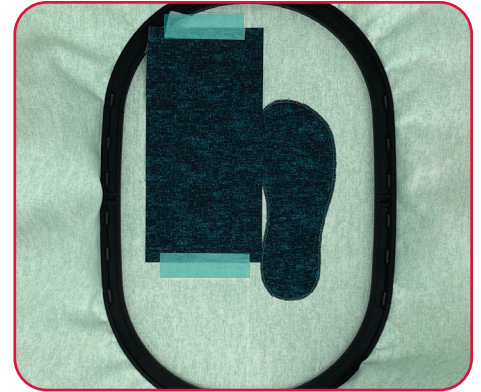
□ Step 12

- Return the hoop to the machine.
- Stitch Machine Step 3, Left Flop Blue Fabric Placement Stitch.



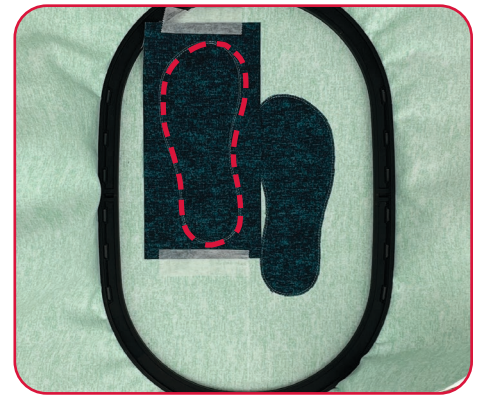
□ Step 13

- Remove the hoop from the machine, but NOT the project from the hoop.
- Place the hoop on a flat surface.
- Remove the paper backing off the SoftWeb on the blue applique fabric.
- Completely cover the placement stitch with the prepared blue applique fabric.
- Tape in place to secure.



□ Step 14

- Return the hoop to the machine.
- Stitch Machine Step 4, Cut Line and Tackdown.



□ Step 15

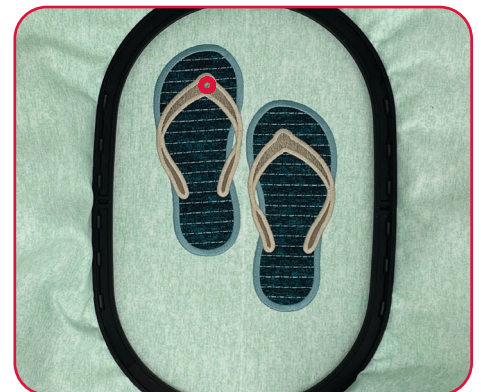
- Remove the hoop from the machine, but NOT the project from the hoop.
- Trim the excess fabric as close to the cut line as possible.



□ Step 16

- Return the hoop to the machine.
- Stitch Machine Steps 5 - 7.
- Stitch Machine Step 8, Left Lace Placement/ Match Lace.

Tip: For Machine Steps 8 - 10, use a thread color that is used in the freestanding lace ornament. Shown here is Isacord 5450.



□ Step 17

- Remove the hoop from the machine, but NOT the project from the hoop.
- Place the hoop on a flat surface.
- Center the other freestanding lace ornament over the placement stitch as desired.
- Tape in place to secure.



□ Step 18

- Return the hoop to the machine.
- Stitch Machine Step 9, Lace Tackdown/Match Lace.



□ Step 19

- Stitch Machine Step 10, Right Lace Placement/Match Lace.



□ Step 20

- Remove the hoop from the machine, but NOT the project from the hoop.
- Place the hoop on a flat surface.
- Center one of the freestanding lace ornaments over the placement stitch as desired.
- Tape in place to secure.



Step 21

- Return the hoop to the machine.
- Stitch Machine Step 11, Lace Tackdown/Match Lace.



Step 22

- When the design is complete, remove the project from the hoop.



Step 23

- Finish the project as desired. Here it was made into a beach bag using the Summertime Beach Tote Bag tutorial from OESD's Project Hub.

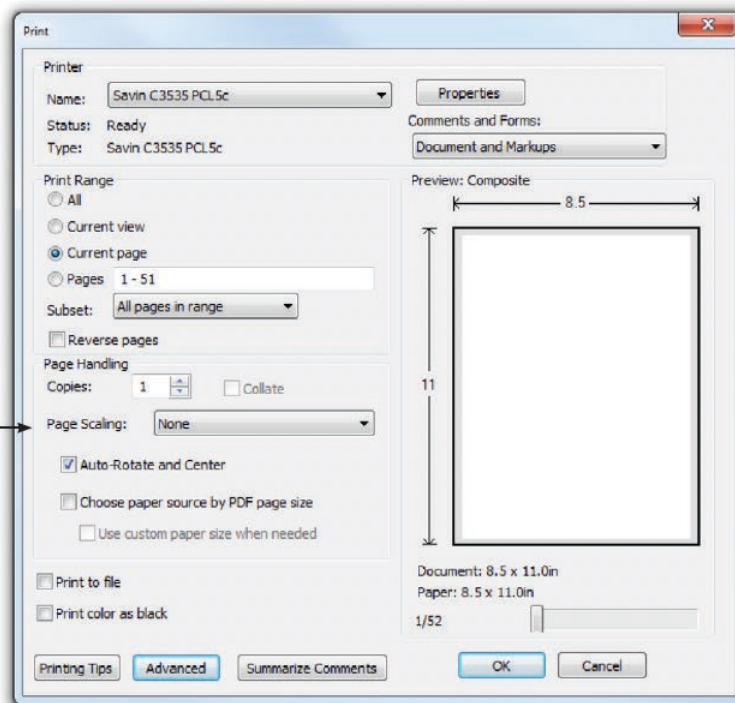

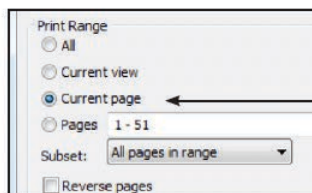
ATTENTION

TO SAVE PAPER

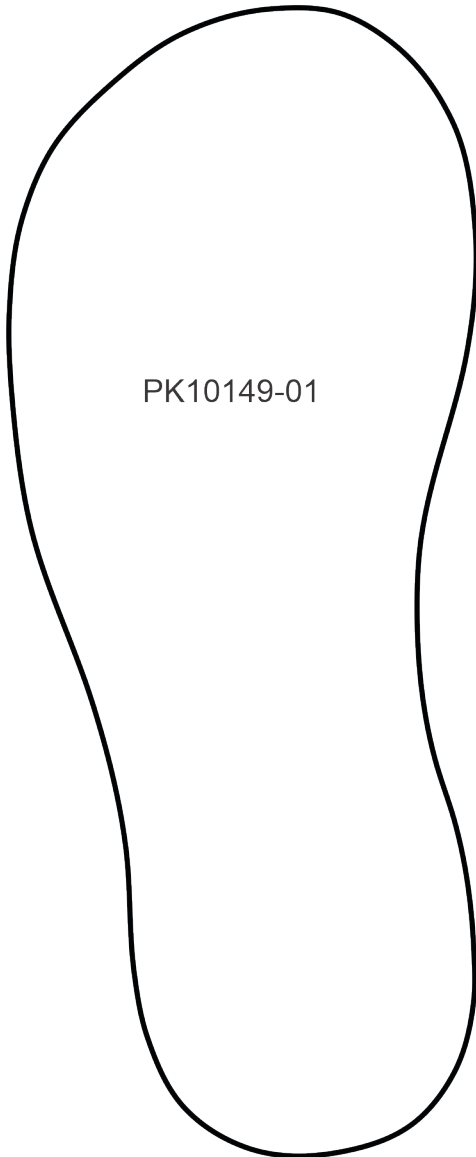
Only print the desired image by navigating to the image's page, go to File > Print and select "Current page" in the print dialog box. Repeat for each desired image.



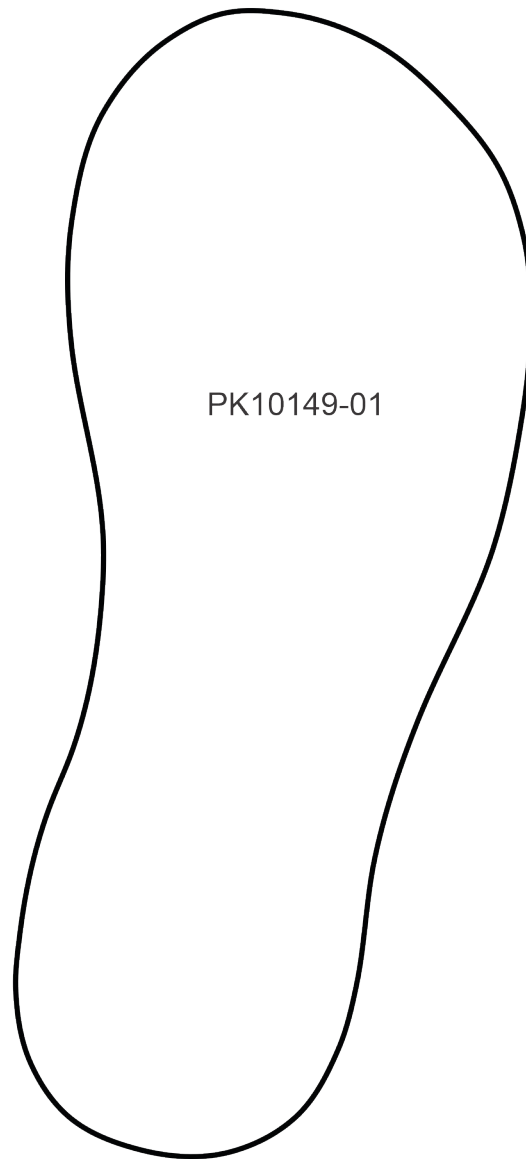

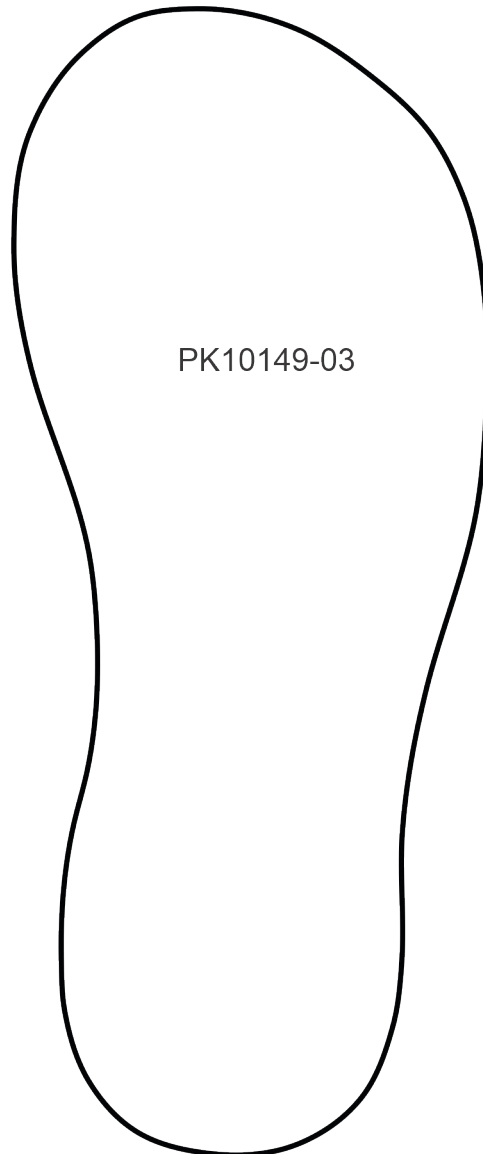

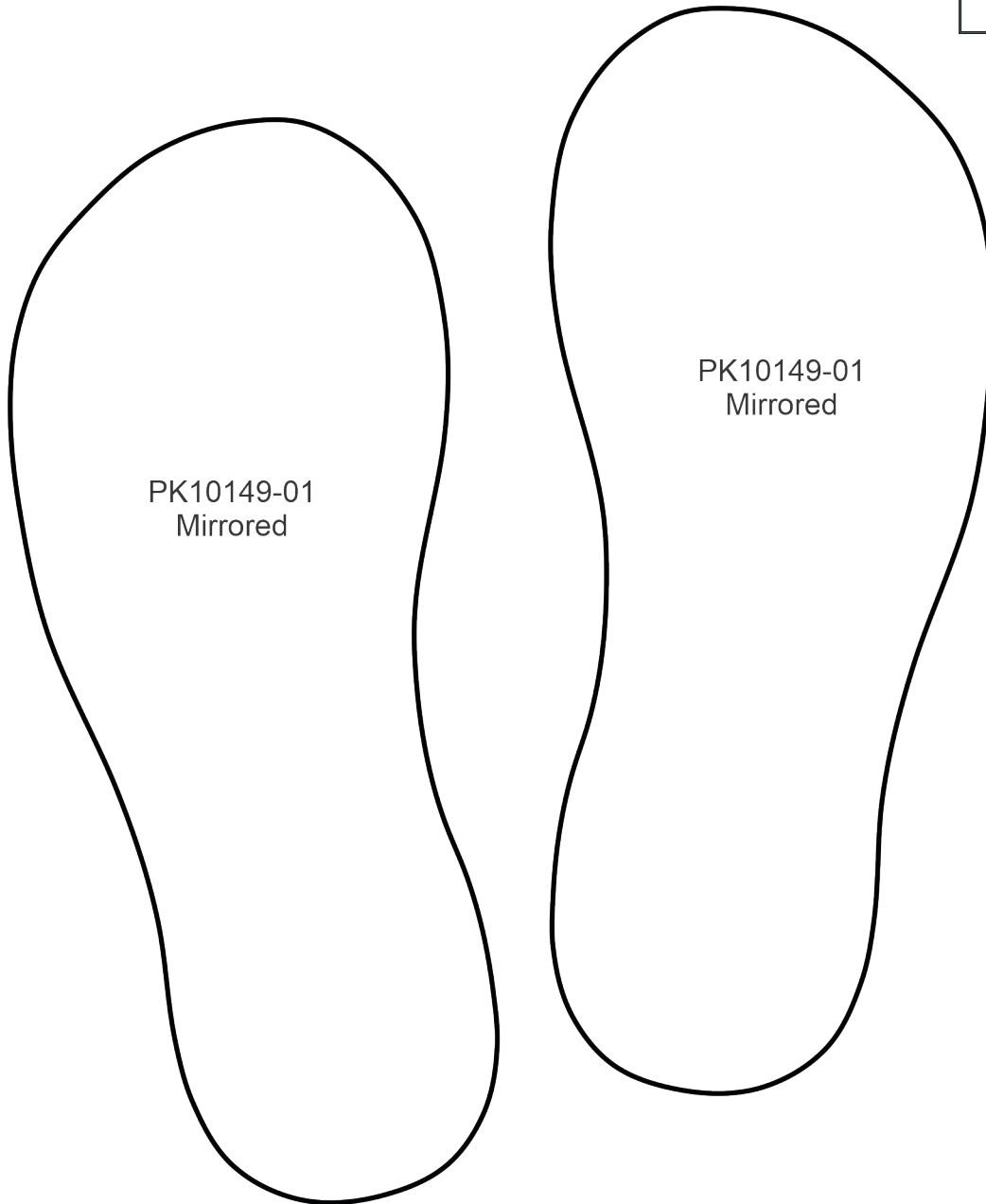

MIRRORED PATTERNS



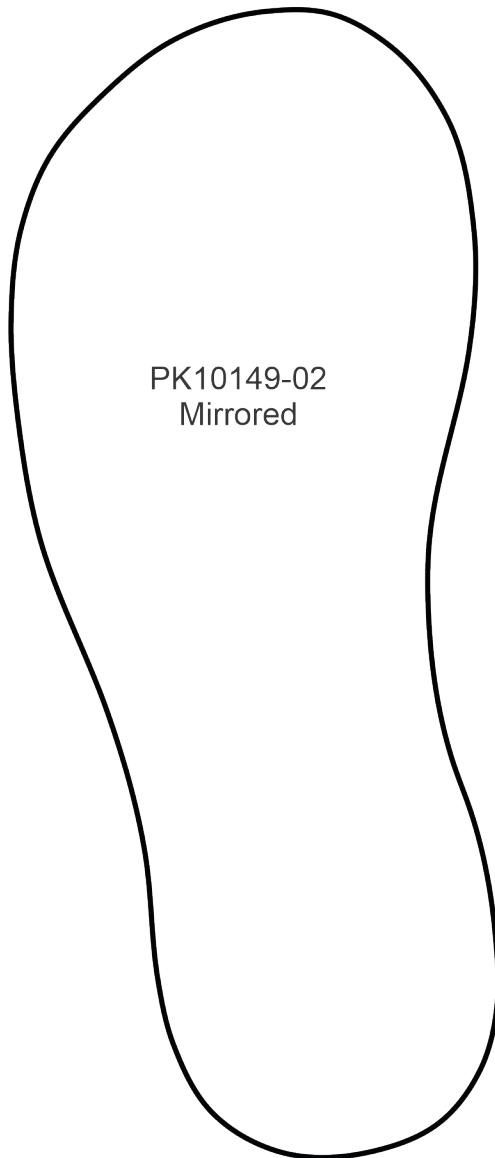

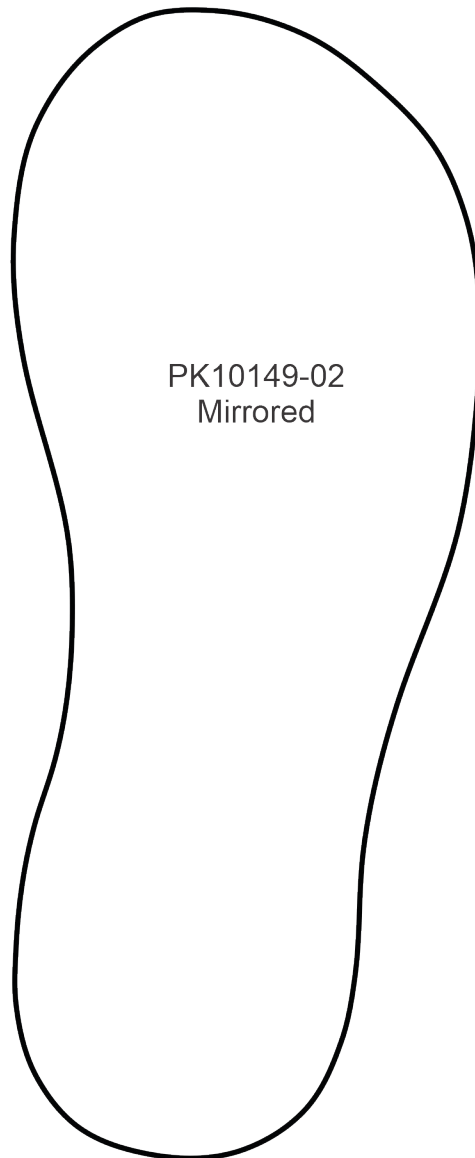
